



Materials

1/4 yard	Medallions - White/Red (A)	2701-18
1/4 yard	Folio - Wine (B)	7755-89
1/8 yard	Tiny Lattice - Red (C)	2703-88
1/4 yard	Tiny Vines - Red (D)	2702-88
1/4 yard	Tiny Lattice - White/Red (E)	2703-18
1/3 yard	Scarlet Vines - Red (F)	2699-88
5/8 yard	Medallions - White/Gray (G)	2701-11

You will also need:

• 5/8 yard Fusible Fleece

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Medallions - White/Red (A), cut:

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 6 ½" x 18 ½" strips.

From the Folio - Wine (B), cut:

• (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 1 ½" x 18 ½" strips.

From the Tiny Lattice - Red (C), cut:

• (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 ½" x 18 ½" strips.

From the Tiny Vines - Red (D), cut:

• (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 3 ½" x 7" strips.

From the Tiny Lattice - White/Red (E), cut:

• (1) 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3 ½" x 7" strips and (4) 2" x 7" strips.

From the Scarlet Vines - Red (F), cut:

• (2) 4" x WOF strips.

From the Medallions - White/Gray (G), cut:

• (1) 17" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 17" x 18 ½" strips.


From the Fusible Fleece, cut:

- (1) 18 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 17" x 18 ½" strips.
- (2) 1" x WOF strips.


Tote Assembly

Note: Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.


1. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strips to the top and to the bottom of (1) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A strip. Sew (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to the top of the newly sewn strip to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 1). Repeat to make a second Unit 1 strip.



2. Sew together (3) 3 ½" x 7" Fabric D strips and (2) 3 ½" x 7" Fabric E strips, alternating them from left to right. Sew (1) 2" x 7" Fabric E strip to each end of the newly sewn strip to make (1) Unit 2 strip (Fig. 2). Repeat to make a second Unit 2 strip.



3. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to the top of (1) Unit 2 strip to make the Outer Bag Front (Fig. 3). Repeat to make the Outer Bag Back.





Outer Bag Front/Back


- 4. Press (1) 17" x 18 ½" Fusible fleece onto the back side of the Outer Bag Front and quilt as desired. Repeat to with the Outer Bag Back.
- 5. Place the (2) 17" x 18 ½" Fabric G pieces right sides together. Stitch down the two short sides and across the bottom, leaving a 4" opening for turning to create the lining.
- 6. Measure in from the side edge 1 ½" and up from the bottom edge, 1 ½" at each bottom corner. Cut out the square of fabric (Fig. 4). Open the cut bottom and align the bottom edge with the side edge and sew the two edges together (Fig. 5). Repeat with the other bottom corner to make the box bottom on the Lining.





7. Place the Outer Bag Front and Outer Bag Back right sides together. Stitch down the two short sides and across the bottom to make the outer bag

- 8. Repeat Step 6 to create a box corner on each bottom corner of the Outer Bag.
- 9. Fold (1) 4" x WOF Fabric F strip in half lengthwise and press (Fig. 6). Open the folded fabric and fold each long edge to the creased center line and press (Fig. 7).
- 10. Fold the pressed fabric in half again and press to make one 1" x WOF strip (Fig. 8). Slide (1) 1" strip of fusible fleece into the handle and press. Top stitch down both long sides 1/8" in from the edge to make (1) Strap (Fig. 9).
- 11. Repeat Steps 9-10 to make a second strap.
- 12. Trim the straps to the desired length.



13. Position and pin one end of a strap to the bag front 2 ½" from the left side seam, aligning the raw edge of the strap with the top of the bag. Pin and sew in place using 1/8" seam allowance. Repeat with the other end of the strap and the right side of the bag front (Fig. 10). Repeat on the other side of the bag with the second strap.

14. Place the Outer Bag, right sides together with the lining, aligning the top raw edges of the bag and lining with the strap between the layers and pin together. Sew the lining

and bag together. Turn the bag and lining right side out through the opening in the lining. Press as needed and top stitch the opening closed. Put the lining into the bag, aligning the sides and bottom.


