



# SILENT NIGHT Quilt 1

## SILENT NIGHT

#### Materials

- panel Silent Night Joy Peace Panel Midnight (A)
   2505PM-77
   panel Silent Night Song Panel Midnight (B) 2506PM-77
- 1 yardArabesque Blue (C)2510M-77\*1 ½ yardsFoulard Stars Midnight (D)2509M-772 ½ yardsMini Stars Midnight (Backing)2514M-77

\*Includes binding

#### **Cutting Instructions**

*Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric* (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Silent Night Joy Peace Panel - Midnight (A):

• Fussy cut (4) 9 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 21 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips, each centered on a word.

#### From the Silent Night Song Panel - Midnight (B):

• Fussy cut (5) 6 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 21 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips, each centered on a scenic view.

#### From the Arabesque - Blue (C), cut:

- (4) 3" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3" x 67 ½" strips.
- (2) 2" x 26 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" WOF strips.
- (6) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Foulard Stars - Midnight (D), cut:


(4) 5 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 70 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.
(2) 5 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 36 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" WOF strips.

#### From the Mini Stars - Midnight (Backing), cut:

• (1) 88" x WOF strip for the backing.

#### **Block Assembly**

1. Sew (5) 6 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 21 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Fabric B strips and (4) 9 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 21 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Fabric A strips together lengthwise and alternating them to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).



#### **Quilt Top Assembly**


(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 2. Sew (1) 3" x 67  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 26  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

3. Sew (1) 5  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 70  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

4. Layer and quilt as desired.

5. Sew the (6)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

6. Bind as desired.
