Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Banner Panel 24-in - Teal (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 23 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 43 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle, centered on the panel.

From the Small Floral - Red (B), cut:

- (3) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 43 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 27 $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
- (3) 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 30 $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.

From the Camping Site - Gray (C), cut:

- (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Starry Basics - Orange (D), cut:

- (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Green (E), cut:

- (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Water Lily - Light Teal (F), cut:

- (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Starry Basics - Brown (G), cut:

- (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Firefly - Navy (H), cut:

- (1) 2 $\frac{5}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 $\frac{5}{8}$ " squares.
- (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and (4) 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " squares.
- (1) 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 4" strips.
- (2) 1 $\frac{3}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 $\frac{3}{8}$ " x 9 $\frac{1}{4}$ " strips.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Red (I), cut:

- (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Pawprint - Gray (J), cut:

- (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Starry Basics - Gold (K), cut:

- (2) 2 $\frac{5}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (22) 2 $\frac{5}{8}$ " squares.
- (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Camping Words - Red (L), cut:

- (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Starry Basics - Red (M), cut:

- (2) 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 9 $\frac{1}{4}$ " strips.
- (3) 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 10 $\frac{3}{4}$ " strips.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Orange (N), cut:

- (1) 2 $\frac{5}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 $\frac{5}{8}$ " squares.
- (1) 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " squares.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Gold (O), cut:

- (1) 2 $\frac{5}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 2 $\frac{5}{8}$ " squares.

From the Border Stripe - Teal (P), cut:

- (2) 10" x 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) 10" x 30 $\frac{1}{2}$ " LOF strips.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Brown (Q), cut:

- (7) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

Critters Tossed Allover - Gray (Backing), cut:

- (2) 59" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 59" x 79" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 43 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the 23 1/2" x 43 1/2" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 27 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 26 1/2" x 46 1/2".**

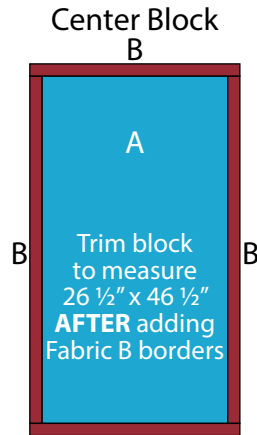

2. Follow Figure 2 and sew together (23) assorted 2 1/2" squares to make the Inner Left Side Border.
3. Follow Figure 3 and sew together (23) assorted 2 1/2" squares to make the Inner Right Side Border.

4. Follow Figure 4 and sew together (15) assorted 2 1/2" squares to make the Inner Top Border.

5. Follow Figure 5 and sew together (15) assorted 2 1/2" squares to make the Inner Bottom Border.

6. Place (1) 2 5/8" Fabric K square on top of (1) 2 5/8" Fabric H square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 6). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 6). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 7) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 2 1/4" to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (16) Unit 1 squares total.

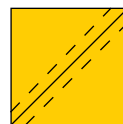

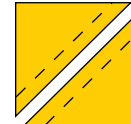

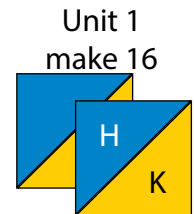

7. Repeat Step 6 and refer to Figures 9-11 for fabric identification and placement to make (12) Unit 2 squares, (16) Unit 3 squares and (8) Unit 4 squares.

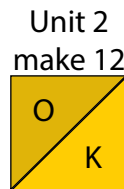

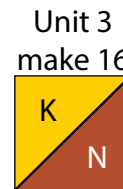

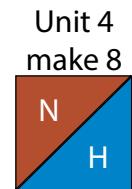

8. Follow Figure 12 and sew together (2) 2 ¼" x 4" Fabric H strips, (1) 2 ¼" Fabric H square, (4) Unit 1 squares, (3) Unit 2 squares, (4) Unit 3 squares, (2) Unit 4 squares and (2) 2 ¼" Fabric N squares to make (1) 7 ½" x 9 ¼" Unit 5 rectangle. Repeat to make (4) Unit 5 rectangles total.

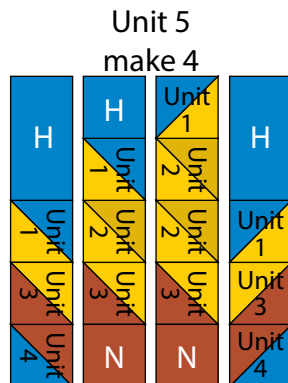

9. Sew (1) 1 3/8" x 9 ¼" Fabric H strip to each side of (1) Unit 5 rectangle to make (1) 9 ¼" square (Fig. 13). Repeat to make (4) Unit 6 squares total.

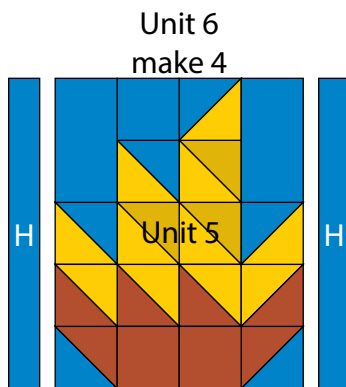

10. Sew (1) 1 ¼" x 9 ¼" strip to each side of (1) Unit 6 square. Sew (1) 1 ¼" x 10 ¾" Fabric M strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 6 square to make (1) 10 ¾" Block One square (Fig. 14). Repeat to make (4) Block One squares total.

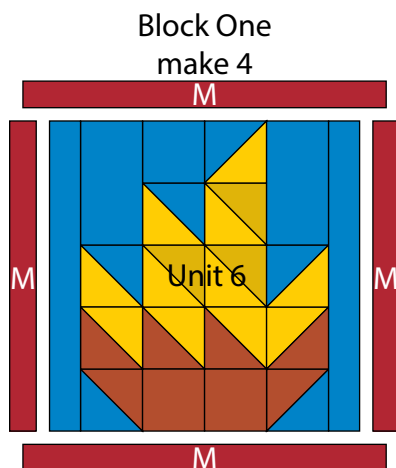

11. Sew (1) 1 ¼" x 30 ½" Fabric B strip to the bottom of (1) 10" x 30 ½" Fabric P strip lengthwise. Sew (1) Block One square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Outer Top Border (Fig. 15).

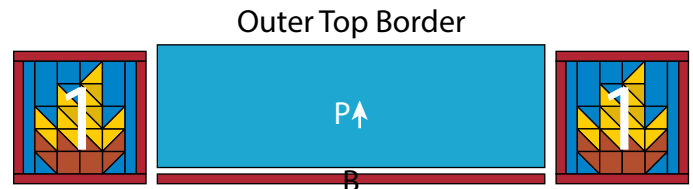

12. Sew (1) 1 ¼" x 30 ½" Fabric B strip to the top of (1) 10" x 30 ½" Fabric P strip lengthwise. Sew (1) Block One square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Outer Bottom Border (Fig. 16).

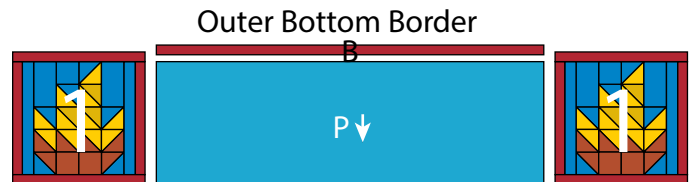

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

13. Sew the Inner Left Side Border and Inner Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.

14. Sew the Inner Top Border and Inner Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

15. Sew (1) 1 ¼" x 50 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block.

16. Sew (1) 10" x 50 ½" Fabric P strip to each side of the Center Block.

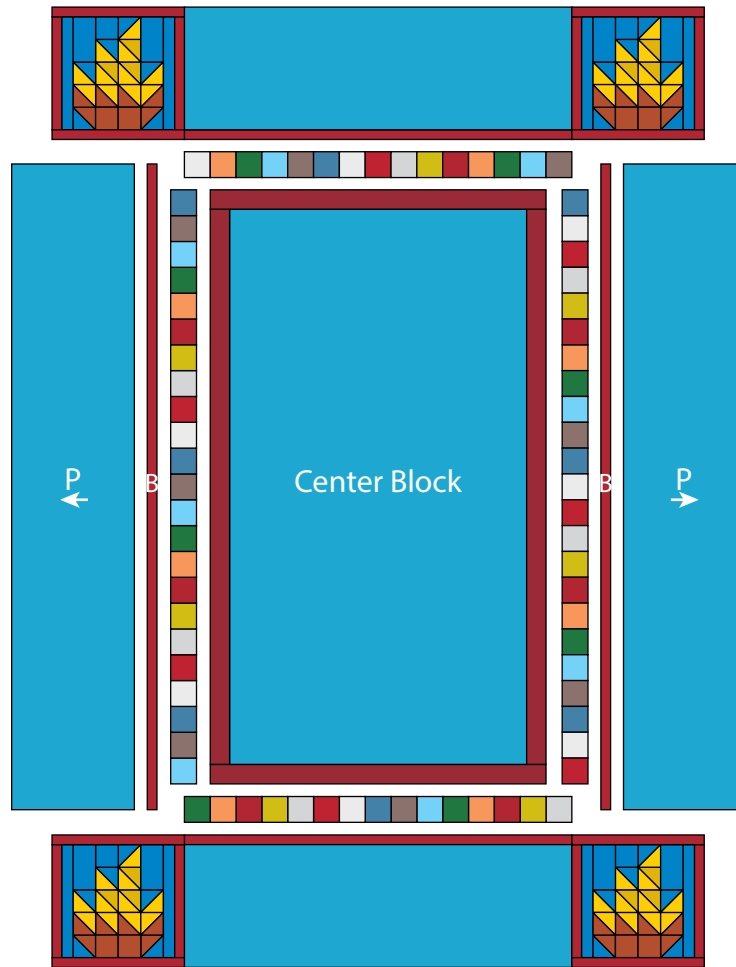
17. Sew the Outer Top Border and Outer Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

18. Layer and quilt as desired.

19. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric Q strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

20. Bind as desired.
