### Topper Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Large Blocks Panel - Multi (A):

- Fussy cut (4) 9" squares each centered on a block.

#### From the Modern Melody Basics - Dark Gray (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2" x 9" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2" x 12" strips.
- (2) 1 1/2" x 40" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 1/2" x 38" WOF strips.
- (4) 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 1/4" x 16 1/2" strips.

#### From the Modern Melody Basics - Lime (C), cut:

- (2) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips.
- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" strips.
- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.

#### From the Tossed Cats - Purple (D), cut:

- (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.

#### From the Spiderwebs - Black (E), cut:

- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.

#### From the Spiders - Orange (F), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 1/2" squares.

#### From the Small Tossed Pumpkins - Black (G), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.

#### From the Small Town Scenery - Gray (H), cut:

- (1) 5 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5 1/2" squares and (4) 4 1/2" squares.

#### From the Packed Pumpkins - Orange (I), cut:

- (1) 6" square.

#### From the Border Stripe - Multi (J):

- Fussy cut (4) 5 1/2" x 40" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.

#### From the Modern Melody Basics - Orange (K), cut:

- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Large Town Scenery - Multi (Backing), cut:

- (2) 58" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 58" x 58" for the back.

### Topper Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Sew (1) 2" x 9" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 9" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x 12" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). Trim the unit to measure 10 1/2" square. Repeat to make (4) Unit 1 squares total.
2. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (4) Unit 2 squares total.

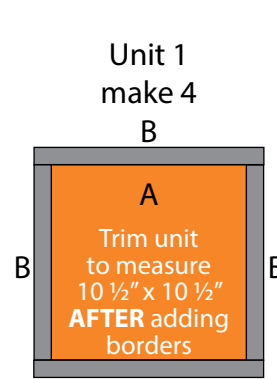

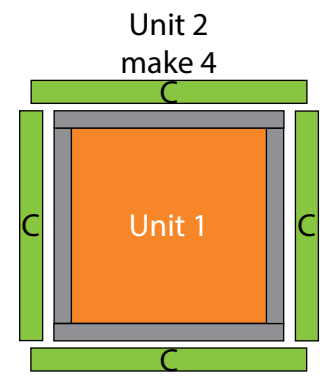

3. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric E strip to each end of (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric D strip to make (1) Unit 3 strip (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (16) Unit 3 strips total.

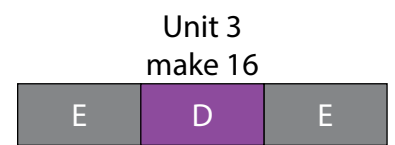

4. Sew (1) 2 1/2" Fabric F square to each end of (1) Unit 3 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 3 strip to each side of (1) Unit 2 square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (4) Block One squares total.

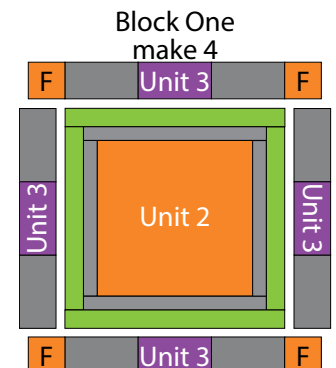

## Table Set

5. Sew together (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric G strip, (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric D strip, (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric C strip, (1) 4 1/2" Fabric H square, (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric C strip, (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric D strip and (1) (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric G strip lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom. Sew (1) 1 1/4" x 16 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the newly sewn strip to make (1) Unit 4 strip (Fig. 5). Repeat to make a second Unit 4 strip.

6. Sew together (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric G strip, (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric D strip, (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric C strip, (1) 4 1/2" Fabric H square, (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric C strip, (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric D strip and (1) (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric G strip lengthwise and in that order from left to right. Sew (1) 1 1/4" x 16 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the newly sewn strip to make (1) Unit 5 strip (Fig. 6). Repeat to make a second Unit 5 strip.

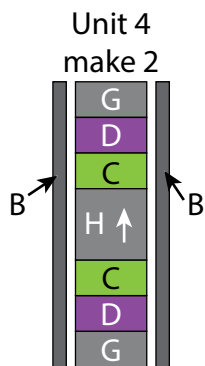

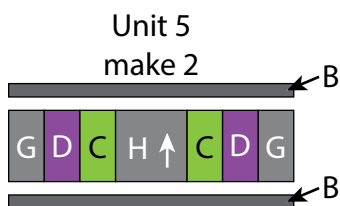

### Topper Assembly

(Follow the Topper Layout while assembling the Topper.)

7. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of (1) Unit 4 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row.

8. Sew (1) Unit 5 strip to each side of (1) 6" Fabric I square to make the middle row.

9. Sew the (3) rows from Steps 7-8 together to make the Center Block.

10. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 38" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 40" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

11. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 40" Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 1/2" Fabric H square to each end of (1) 5 1/2" x 40" Fabric J strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the Topper.

12. Layer and quilt as desired.

13. Sew the (6) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric K strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

14. Bind as desired.

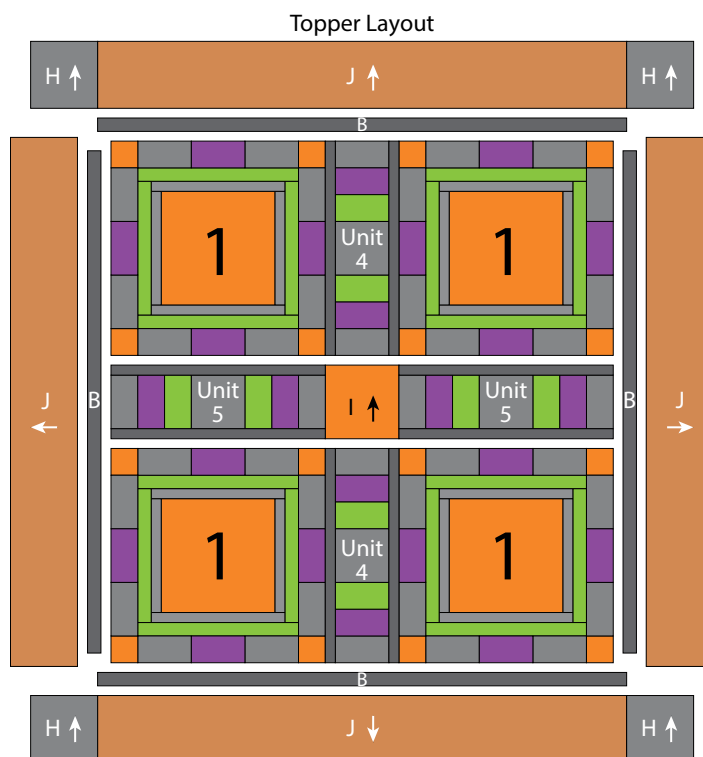

### Place Mat Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Large Block Panel - Multi (A):

- Fussy cut (4) 9" squares each centered on a block.

#### From the Modern Melody Basics - Dark Gray (B), cut:

- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2" x 9" strips.
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 2" x 12" strips.
- (8) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Tossed Cats - Purple (C), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 2 1/2" x 15 1/2" strips.
- (8) Template 1 triangles.
- (8) Template 2 triangles.

#### From the Spiderwebs - Black (D), cut:

- (16) Template 1 triangles.
- (16) Template 2 triangles.

#### From the Modern Melody Basics - Lime (E), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 3" squares.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2" x 9" strips.
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 2" x 12" strips.

#### From the Packed Pumpkins - Orange (F), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 2 1/2" x 15 1/2" strips.

#### From the Party Skeletons - Orange (G), cut:

- (8) Template 1 triangles.
- (8) Template 2 triangles.

#### From the Spiders - Orange (H), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 3" squares.

#### From the Halloween Honeycomb - Multi (Backing), cut:

- (2) 23" x Length of Fabric (LOF) strips. Sub-cut (4) 23" x 19" strips for the backs.

### Place Mat Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Sew (1) 2" x 9" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 9" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x 12" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square. Trim the block to measure 10 1/2" square to make (1) Unit 6 square (Fig. 8). Repeat to make a second Unit 6 square.

2. Sew (1) 2" x 9" Fabric E strip to each side of (1) 9" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x 12" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square. Trim the block to measure 10 1/2" square to make (1) Unit 7 square (Fig. 9). Repeat to make a second Unit 7 square.

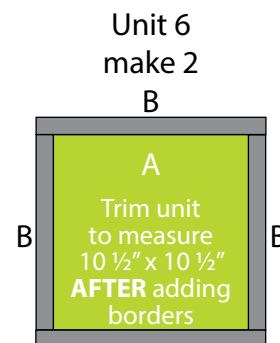

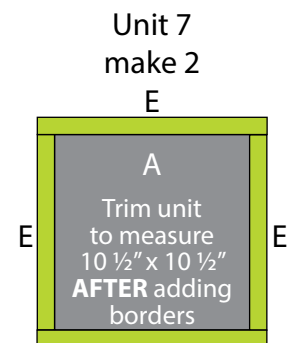

3. Sew together (1) Fabric D-Template 1 triangle and (1) Fabric C-Template 1 triangle along the long sides to make (1) Unit 8 rectangle (Fig. 10). The unit should measure 3" x 5 1/2". Repeat to make (8) Unit 8 rectangles total.

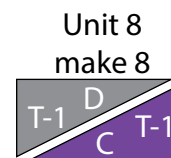

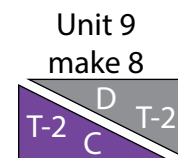

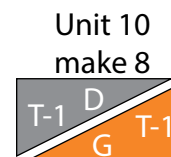

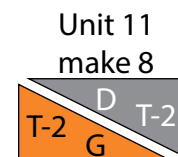

4. Repeat Step 3 and refer to Figures 11-13 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (8) Unit 9 rectangles, (8) Unit 10 rectangles and (8) Unit 11 rectangles.

5. Sew (1) Unit 8 rectangle to the left end of (1) Unit 9 rectangle at the Fabric C ends to make (1) Unit 12 strip (Fig. 14). Repeat to make (8) Unit 12 strips total.

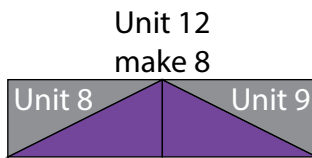

6. Sew (1) Unit 10 rectangle to the left end of (1) Unit 11 rectangle at the Fabric G ends to make (1) Unit 13 strip (Fig. 15). Repeat to make (8) Unit 13 strips total.

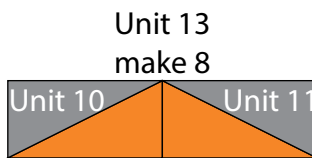

### Place Mat Assembly

*(Follow the Place Mat Layouts while assembling the Place Mat tops.)*

7. Sew (1) Unit 12 strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) Unit 6 square. Sew (1) 3" Fabric E square to the top and to the bottom of (1) Unit 12 strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of the Unit 6 square.

8. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 15 1/2" Fabric F strip to each side of the block from Step 7 to make (1) Place Mat 1 top (Fig. 16). Repeat to make a second Place Mat 1 top.

9. Repeat Steps 7-8 and refer to Figure 17 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (2) Place Mat 2 tops.

### Place Mat Layout 1 make 2

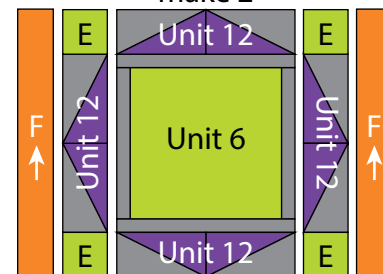

### Place Mat Layout 2 make 2

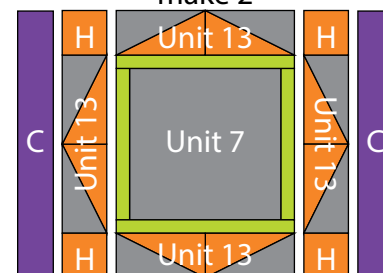


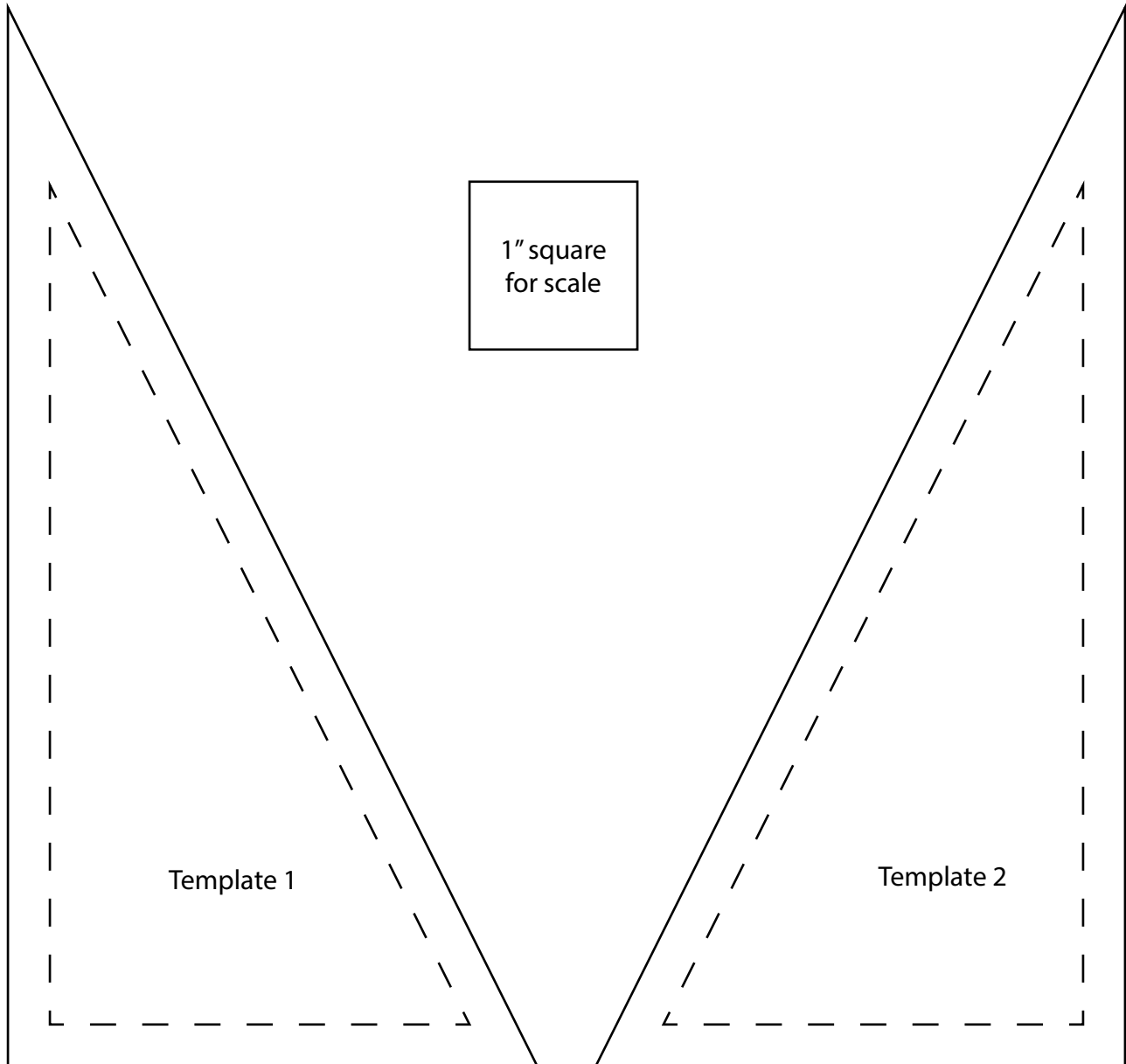

10. Layer and quilt as desired.

11. Sew the (8) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press. Cut the strip into (4) equal strips.

12. Bind as desired.
