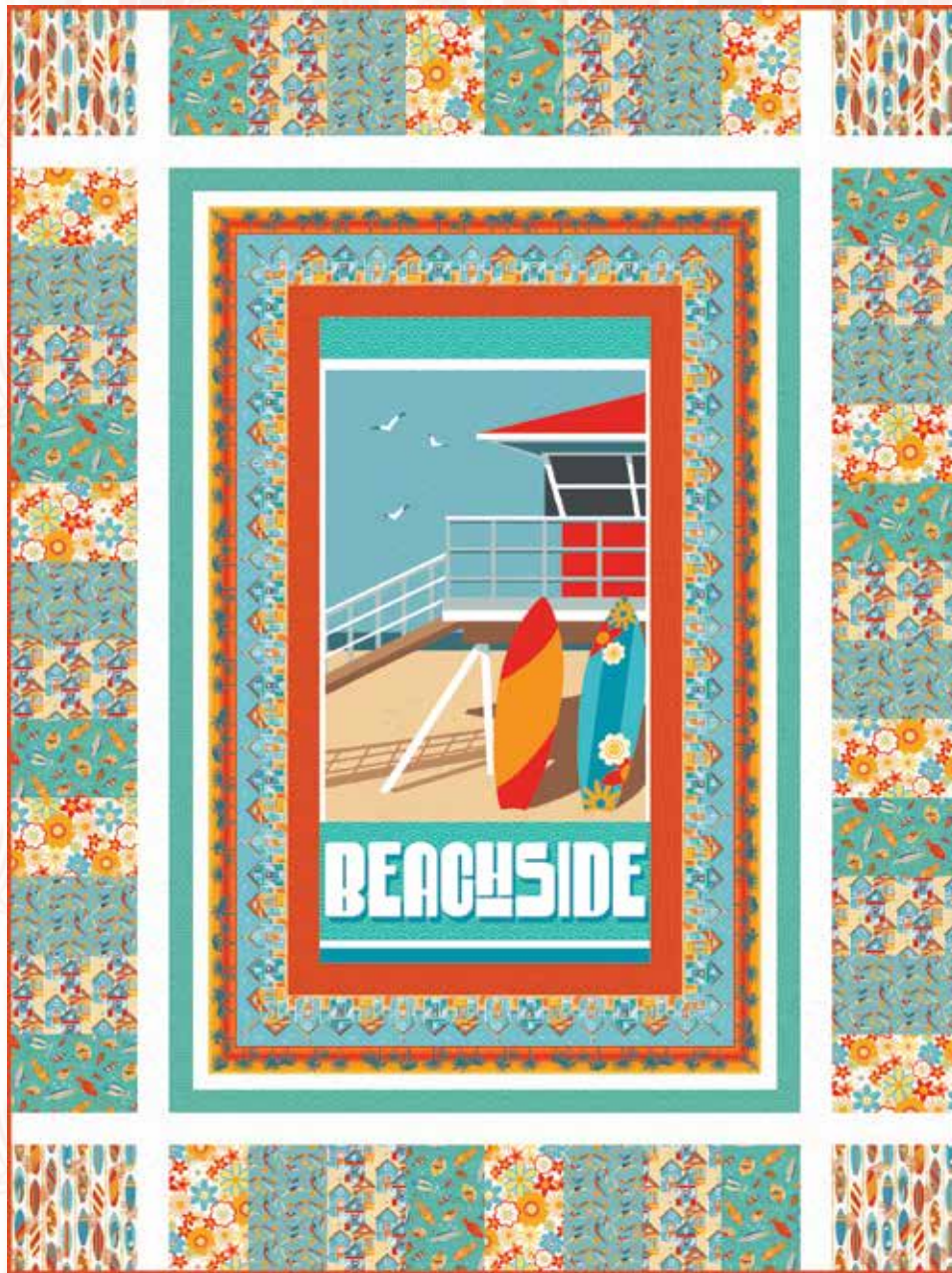

3/8 yard (0.35m)	Modern Melody Basics - Teal (D) 1063-61
5/8 yard (0.58m)	Fish - Teal (E) 1162-60
2/3 yard (0.61m)	Beach Cottages - Multi (F) 1159-41
5/8 yard (0.58m)	Swimmers - Blue (G) 1164-11
5/8 yard (0.58m)	Modern Floral - Multi (H) 1161-18
1/3 yard (0.31m)	Surf Boards - Multi (I) 1158-18
1 3/4 yards (1.61m)	Beach Cottage Novelty Stripe - Multi (J) 1166-18
5 yards (4.58m)	Seagulls - Blue (Backing) 1160-11

### Cutting Instructions

*Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.*

#### From the 24 Inch Beach Panel - Multi (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 21 1/2" x 41 1/2" rectangle, centered on the panel.

#### From the Modern Melody Basics - Chili (B), cut:

- (2) 3" x 41 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 3" x 26 1/2" WOF strips.
- (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Folio Basics — White on White (C), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 1/2" x 60 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 1/2" x 44 1/2" strips.
- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 55 1/2" strips.
- (2) 1 1/2" x 37 1/2" WOF strips.

#### From the Modern Melody Basics - Teal (D), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 57 1/2" strips.
- (2) 2" x 40 1/2" WOF strips.

#### From the Fish - Teal (E), cut:

- (3) 5 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips.

#### From the Beach Cottages - Multi (F), cut:

- (1) 8 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 8 1/2" x 5 1/2" strips.
- (2) 5 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips.

#### From the Swimmers - Blue (G), cut:

- (3) 5 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips.

#### From the Modern Floral - Multi (H), cut:

- (3) 5 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips.

#### From the Surf Boards - Multi (I), cut:

- (1) 8 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 8 1/2" squares.

#### From the Beach Cottage Novelty Stripe - Multi (J), cut:

- (2) 5 1/2" x 59" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) 5 1/2" x 39" LOF strips.

#### From the Seagulls - Blue (Backing), cut:

- (2) 88" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 68" x 88" back.

### Block Assembly

*Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.*

1. Sew (1) 3" x 41 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the 21 1/2" x 41 1/2" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 3" x 26 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 25 1/2" x 45 1/2"**.
2. Follow Figure 2 and sew together (2) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric C strips, (3) 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric H strips, (3) 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric G strips, (3) 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric E strips and (3) 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric F strips lengthwise to make the Left Side Border.

3. Repeat Step 2 and refer to Figure 3 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make the Right Side Border.

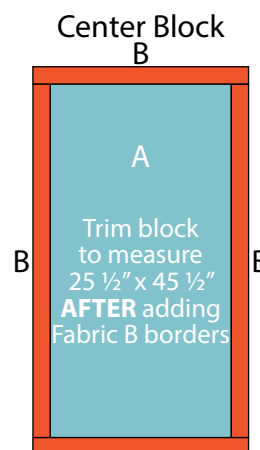

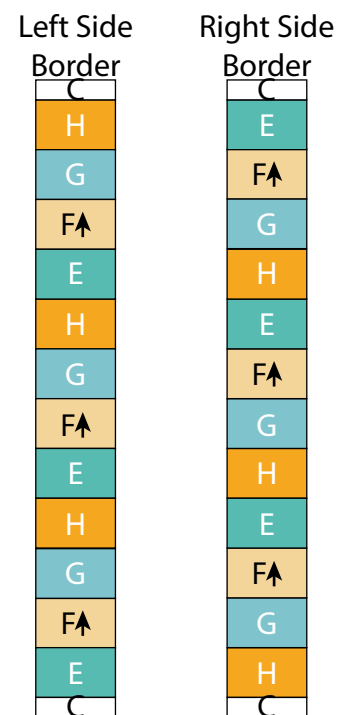

4. Follow Figure 4 and sew together (2) 8 ½” Fabric I squares, (2) 2 ½” x 8 ½” Fabric C strips, (2) 5 ½” x 8 ½” Fabric E strips, (2) 8 ½” x 5 ½” Fabric F strips, (2) 5 ½” x 8 ½” Fabric G strips and (2) 5 ½” x 8 ½” Fabric H strips lengthwise to make the Top Border.

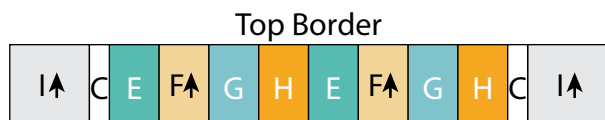

5. Repeat Step 4 and refer to Figure 5 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make the Bottom Border.

### Quilt Top Assembly

*(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)*

6. Center (1) 5 ½” x 59” Fabric J strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a ¼” from the top edge of the block and stop a ¼” from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.

7. Repeat Step 6 to sew (1) 5 ½” x 39” Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start ¼” away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 6).

8. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 6), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a ¼” seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners.

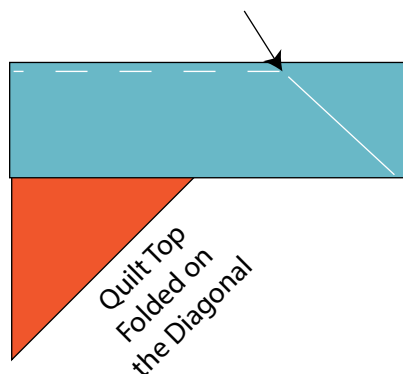

9. Sew (1) 1 ½” x 55 ½” Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½” x 37 ½” Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

10. Sew (1) 2” x 57 ½” Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2” x 40 ½” Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

11. Sew (1) 2 ½” x 60 ½” Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 ½” x 44 ½” Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

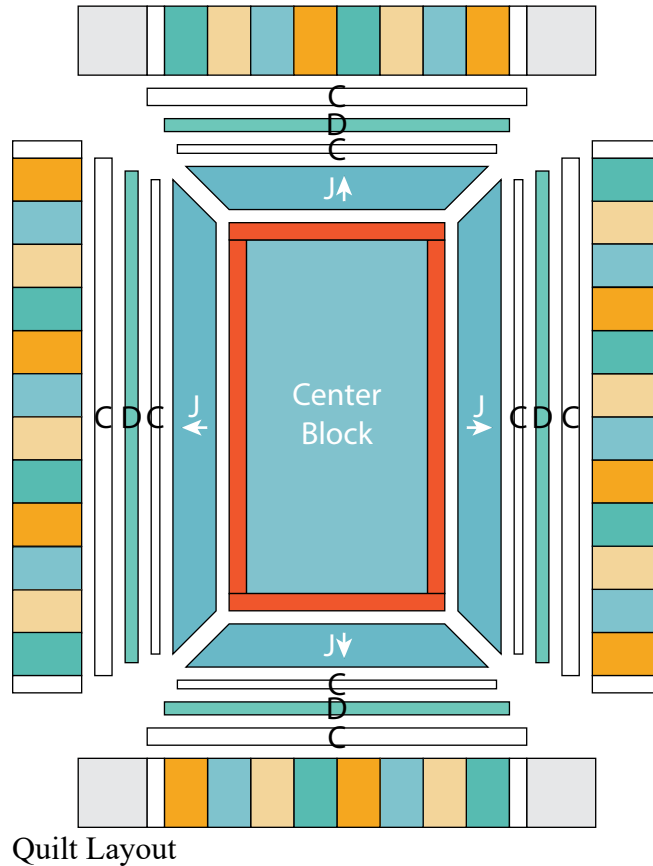
12. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.

13. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

14. Layer and quilt as desired.

15. Sew the (7) 2 ½” x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

16. Bind as desired.



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
