## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 24 Inch Beach Panel - Multi (A):

- Fussy cut (1) $21 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 41 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ rectangle, centered on the panel.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Chili (B), cut:

- (2) 3 " $\times 41 \frac{1}{2} "$ WOF strips.
- (2) 3 " $\times 261 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
- (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.

From the Folio Basics - White on White (C), cut:

- (2) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $21 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $21 / 2 " \times 601 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $21 / 2 " \times 441 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 55 \frac{1}{2} "$ strips.
- (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " $\times 371 / 2 "$ WOF strips.


## From the Modern Melody Basics - Teal (D), cut:

-(3) $2 "$ x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $2 " \times 571 / 2 "$ strips.
-(2) $2 " \times 401 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
From the Fish - Teal (E), cut:

- (3) $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) $51 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Beach Cottages - Multi (F), cut:

- (1) $81 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $5 \frac{1}{2} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) $5 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 81 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Swimmers - Blue (G), cut:

- (3) $5 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) $51 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ strips.


## From the Modern Floral - Multi (H), cut:

- (3) $51 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) $51 / 2 "$ x $81 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Surf Boards - Multi (I), cut:

- (1) $8 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $81 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Beach Cottage Novelty Stripe - Multi (J), cut:

- (2) $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 59$ " Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) $51 / 2 " \times 39 "$ LOF strips.

From the Seagulls - Blue (Backing), cut:
-(2) $88 "$ x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $68 " \times 88^{\prime \prime}$ back.

## Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ "seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) $3 " \times 41 \frac{1}{2} "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the $21 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " x $41 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 3" x $261 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure $251 / 2 "$ x 45 1/2".
2. Follow Figure 2 and sew together (2) $21 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric C strips, (3) $5 \frac{1}{2} " \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric H strips, (3) $51 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric G strips, (3) $51 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric E strips and (3) $51 / 2 " \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F strips lengthwise to make the Left Side Border.
3. Repeat Step 2 and refer to Figure 3 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make the Right Side Border.

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4. Follow Figure 4 and sew together (2) $81 / 2$ " Fabric I squares, (2) $21 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric C strips, (2) $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 8 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strips, (2) $81 / 2 " \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F strips, (2) $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric G strips and (2) $51 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric H strips lengthwise to make the Top Border.

5. Repeat Step 4 and refer to Figure 5 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make the Bottom Border.

## Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
6. Center (1) $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 59 " Fabric J strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a $1 / 4$ " from the top edge of the block and stop a $1 / 4$ " from the bottom edge. DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS. Repeat with the opposite side.
7. Repeat Step 6 to sew (1) $51 / 2 " \times 39 "$ Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start $1 / 4 "$ away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 6).
8. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 6), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners.

9. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 55 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 371 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
10. Sew (1) 2 " $x 571 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $2 " \times 401 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
11. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 601 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 441 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
12. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.
13. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
14. Layer and quilt as desired.
15. Sew the (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
16. Bind as desired.


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
