## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

## From the 24 Inch Party Panel - Multi (A):

- Fussy cut (1) $221 / 2 " \times 401 / 2 "$ rectangle, centered on the panel.

From the Dots - Royal (B), cut:

- (2) $21 / 2 " \times 401 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
- (2) 2 " $\times 26 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips.

From the Tossed Birthday Cakes - Green (C), cut:
-(2) $41 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ WOF strips, piece as needed.

- (2) $31 / 2 " \times 331 / 2 "$ WOF strips.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Crimson Red (D), cut:

- (3) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime} \times 481 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- (2) $11 / 2$ " $\times 351 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
- (3) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2} " \times 601 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 471 / 2 "$ strips.
-(7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Dots - Yellow (E), cut:
- (2) $61 / 4 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (9) $61 / 4 "$ squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (36) $61 / 4$ " triangles. Note: You will only use (34) $6 \frac{1}{4}$ "' triangles.


## From the Number Candles - Royal (F), cut:

-(3) $61 / 4 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (17) $61 / 4 "$ squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (68) $61 / 4 "$ triangles.

## From the Confetti - Multi (G), cut:

- (2) $61 / 4 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (9) $61 / 4 "$ squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (36) $61 / 4$ " triangles. Note: You will only use (34) 6 1/4" triangles.
- (1) $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $51 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Party Hats - Aqua (H), cut:
-(4) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $41 / 2 " \times 621 / 2 "$ strips.
-(3) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $41 / 2 " \times 551 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Words of Celebration - Multi (Backing), cut:
-(2) $63 "$ x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 63 " x $78 "$ back.

## Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 40 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the $221 / 2 " \times 401 / 2 "$ Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2 " x $261 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure $251 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$.

2. Sew together (1) $6 \frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric F triangle and (1) $6 \frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric G triangle along short sides. Sew together (1) $6 \frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric F triangle and (1) $61 / 4$ " Fabric E triangle along short sides. Sew together the (2) newly sewn triangles along their long sides to make (1) $51 / 2 "$ Block One square (Fig. 2.)
Repeat to make (34) Block One squares total.

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3. Sew together (10) Block One squares along the Fabric F sides to make the Left Side Border (Fig. 3). Repeat to make the Right Side Border (Fig. 4).

4. Sew together (7) Block One squares along the Fabric F sides. Sew (1) $51 / 2 "$ Fabric G square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Top Border (Fig. 5). Repeat to make the Bottom Border (Fig. 6).

## Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 5. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block.
6. Sew (1) $31 / 2 " \times 331 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
7. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 48^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 351 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
8. Sew the Left Side Border and the Right Side Border to the left and right sides of the Center Block.
9. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
10. Sew (1) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 601 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 471 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
11. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 621 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 551 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
12. Layer and quilt as desired.
13. Sew the (7) $21 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF Fabric D strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
14. Bind as desired.
