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Materials

1 panel	24 Inch Panel - Royal (A)	540P-77
1 3/8 yards	Modern Melody Basics - Crimson Red (B)	1063-88*
5/8 yard	Badges - Navy (C)	536-78
5/8 yard	Caduceus - White (D)	531-1
1/4 yard	Star - Navy (E)	535-78
1 1/4 yards	Tossed Firetruck and Dalmatian - Black (F)	538-99
1/2 yard	Modern Melody Basics - Silver Gray (G)	1063-90
2/3 yard	EMT Star - Silver (H)	534-90
1 panel	4 Pillow Block 36 Inch Panel - Royal (I)	539P-77
5 1/4 yards	Mobile Police Unit - Blue (Backing)	537-11

*Includes binding

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 24 Inch Panel - Royal (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 22 1/2" x 42 1/2" rectangle, centered on the panel

From the Modern Melody Basics - Crimson Red (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x 42 1/2" WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (2) 2" x 25 1/2" WOF strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2" x 16 1/2" strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2" x 19 1/2" strips.
- (8) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Badges - Navy (C), cut:

- (4) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Caduceus - White (D), cut:

- (4) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (28) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Star - Navy (E), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips.

From the Tossed Firetruck and Dalmatian - Black (F), cut:

- (2) 8 1/2" x 24 1/2" WOF strips.
- (3) 8 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 8 1/2" x 44 1/2" strips.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Silver Gray (G), cut:

- (4) 1 1/2" x 24 1/2" WOF strips.
- (5) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) 1 1/2" x 44 1/2" strips.

From the EMT Star - Silver (H), cut:

- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 1/2" x 80 1/2" strips.
- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 1/2" x 64 1/2" strips.

From the 4 Pillow Block 36 Inch Panel - Royal (I):

- Fussy cut (4) 16 1/2" squares, each centered on a block.

From the Mobile Police Unit - Blue (Backing), cut:

- (2) 92" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 72" x 92" back.

Block Assembly

Note: Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2" x 42 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the 22 1/2" x 42 1/2" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 25 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 24 1/2" x 44 1/2".**



2. Sew together (6) 4 1/2" Fabric C squares and (5) 4 1/2" Fabric D squares, alternating them from top to bottom, to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (4) Unit 1 strips total.



3. Sew together (1) 4 1/2" Fabric C square, (1) 4 1/2" Fabric D square, (1) 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric E strip, (1) 4 1/2" Fabric D square and (1) 4 1/2" Fabric C square, in that order from left to right, to make (1) Unit 2 strip (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (4) Unit 2 strips total.






4. Sew (1) 2" x 16 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 16 1/2" Fabric I square. Sew (1) 2" x 19 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric I square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 4). **Trim the block to measure 18 1/2" x 18 1/2"**. Repeat to make (4) Block One squares total.




5. Sew together (1) Unit 2 strip, (1) 1 1/2" x 24 1/2" Fabric G strip, (1) 8 1/2" x 24 1/2" Fabric F strip, (1) 1 1/2" x 24 1/2" Fabric G strip and (1) Unit 2 strip, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make (1) Block Two rectangle (Fig. 5). Repeat to make a second Block Two rectangle.



6. Sew together (1) Unit 1 strip, (1) 1 1/2" x 44 1/2" Fabric G strip, (1) 8 1/2" x 44 1/2" Fabric F strip, (1) 1 1/2" x 44 1/2" Fabric G strip and (1) Unit 1 strip, lengthwise and in that order from left to right, to make (1) Side Border (Fig. 6). Repeat to make a second Side Border.



7. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of (1) Block Two rectangle to make the Top Border (Fig. 7). Repeat to make the Bottom Border.



Quilt Top Assembly


(Follow the *Quilt Layout* while assembling the quilt top.)

8. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block.
9. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
10. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 80 1/2" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 64 1/2" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
11. Layer and quilt as desired.
12. Sew the (8) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
13. Bind as desired.
