



Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 10 Honeycomb Blocks 18in x 44in - Multi (A):

• Fussy cut (15) 8" squares, each centered on a block.

From the Plaid - Multi (B), cut:

- (6) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) 2" x 8" strips.
- (10) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) 2" x 11" strips.

From the Packed Bunnies - Multi (C), cut:

• (1) 9 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 9 ½" x 3 ½" strips and (2) 3 ½" x 9 ½" strips.

From the Tossed Carrots - Orange (D), cut:

• (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 3 ½" squares.

From the Tossed Watercolor Flowers - Cream (E), cut:

• (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 3 ½" squares.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Silver Gray (F), cut:

- (2) 1 ½" x 27 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 29 ½" WOF strips.
- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Tossed Bunnies - Multi (G), cut:

- (1) 5" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5" x 10 ½" strips.
- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 4 ½" x 5" strips and (4) 4" x 5" strips.

From the Folio Basic - Cerulean Blue (H), cut:

- (2) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1" x 10 ½" strips.
- (1) 1" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 1" x 4 ½" strips.
- (1) 1" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 1" x 4" strips.

From the Tossed Accessories - Multi (I), cut:

- (2) 2 ¹/₄" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2 ¹/₄" x 10 ¹/₂" strips.
- (1) 2 ½" WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- (1) 2 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 1/4" x 4" strips.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Orange (J), cut:

- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 47 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ¹/₄" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ¹/₄" x 49" strips.

From the Border Stripe - Multi (K), cut:

• (4) 5" x 62" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.

From the Patchwork - Multi (Backing), cut:

• (2) 66" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 66" x 66" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2" x 8" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 8" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x 11" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure** 9 ½" x 9 ½". Repeat to make (15) Block One squares total.






2. Sew (1) 3 ½" Fabric D square to each side of (1) 3 ½" Fabric E square to make the top row. Sew (1) 3 ½" Fabric E square to each side of (1) 3 ½" Fabric D square to make the bottom row. Sew the top row to the top of (1) 3 ½" x 9 ½" Fabric C strip lengthwise and the bottom row to the bottom of the Fabric C strip to make (1) 9 ½" Unit 1 square (Fig. 2).




3. Repeat Step 2 and refer to Figures 3-5 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (1) Unit 2 square, (1) Unit 3 square and (1) Unit 4 square.




- 4. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of the Unit 1 square to make the top row (Fig. 6).
- 5. Sew together the Unit 3 square, (1) Block One square and the Unit 4 square, in that order from left to right, to make the middle row (Fig. 6).
- 6. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of the Unit 2 square to make the bottom row (Fig. 6).
- 7. Sew together the (3) rows from Steps 4-6 lengthwise to make the 27 ½" x 27 ½" Center Block (Fig. 6).




8. Sew together (1) 2 1/4" x 4" Fabric I strip (1) 1" x 4" Fabric H strip, (1) 4" x 5" Fabric G strip, (1) 1" x 4" Fabric H strip and (1) 2 1/4" x 4" Fabric I strip, in that order from left to right, to make (1) 9 ½" x 4" Unit 5 strip (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (4) Unit 5 strips total.



9. Sew together (1) 2 1/4" x 4 1/2" Fabric I strip (1) 1" x 4 1/2" Fabric H strip, (1) 4 1/2" x 5" Fabric G strip, (1) 1" x 4 1/2" Fabric H strip and (1) 2 1/4" x 4 1/2" Fabric I strip, in that order from left to right, to make (1) 9 ½" x 4 ½" Unit 6 strip (Fig. 8). Repeat to make a second Unit 6 strip.




10. Sew together (1) 2 1/4" x 10 1/2" Fabric I strip, (1) 1" x 10 1/2" Fabric H strip, (1) 5" x 10 ½" Fabric G strip, (1) 1" x 10 ½" Fabric H strip and (1) 2 1/4" x 10 1/2" Fabric I strip, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make (1) 10 ½" x 9 ½" Unit 7 rectangle (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (4) Unit 7 rectangles total.



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11. Sew together (1) Unit 5 strip, (1) Block One square, (1) Unit 6 strip, (1) Block One square and (1) Unit 5 strip, in that order from top to bottom. to make (1) Side Border (Fig. 10). Repeat to make a second Side Border.



12. Sew together (3) Block One squares and (2) Unit 7 rectangles, end to end and alternating them from left to right, to make the Top Border (Fig. 11). Repeat to make the Bottom Border.

Top/Bottom Border make 2 Unit 7 Unit 7 Fig. 11

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 13. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 27 ½" Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 29 ½" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

- 14. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 15. Sew (1) 1 1/4" x 47 1/2" Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 1/4" x 49" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

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- 16. Center (1) 5" x 62" Fabric K strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a ¹/₄" from the top edge of the block and stop a ¹/₄" from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.
- 17. Repeat Step 16 to sew (1) 5" x 62" Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start ¼" away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 12).
- 18. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 12), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a ¼" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the quilt top.




- 19. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 20. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric F strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 21. Bind as desired.



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
