Wall Hanging Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Panel 24 In x 44 In - Burgundy Multi (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle, centered on the panel.

From the Packed Leave - Burgundy Multi (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x 30 $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x 25 $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 54 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) 2" x 35 $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
- (6) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Tossed Butterflies - Cream Multi (C), cut:

- (2) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 32 $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
- (4) 2" x 32 $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
- (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Tossed Pumpkins and Acorn - Burgundy Multi (D), cut:

- (1) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Packed Pumpkins and Flowers - Orange Multi (E), cut:

- (1) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Twinkle - Golden Yellow (F), cut:

- (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Border Stripe - Burgundy Multi (G), cut:

- (2) 6" x 72" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) 6" x 50" LOF strips.

From the Tossed Leaves and Acorn - Cream Multi (Backing), cut:

- (2) 54" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 54" x 76" back.

Wall Hanging Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2" x 30 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 25 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Wall Hanging Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 32 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

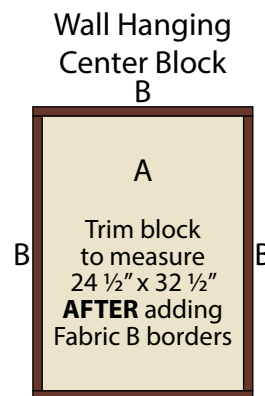

2. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to each side of (1) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric D square to make (1) 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Block One square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (4) Block One squares total.

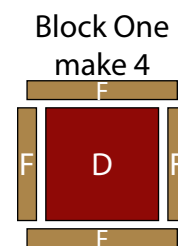

3. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to each end of (1) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric E strip to make (1) 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Block Two rectangle (Fig. 3). Repeat to make a second Block Two rectangle.

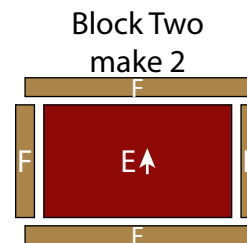

4. Sew together (1) 1 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric C strip, (1) Block One square, (1) 1 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric C strip, (1) Block Two rectangle, (1) 1 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric C strip, (1) Block One square and (1) 1 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric C strip, in that order from left to right, to make the Top Border (Fig. 4). Repeat to make the Bottom Border.

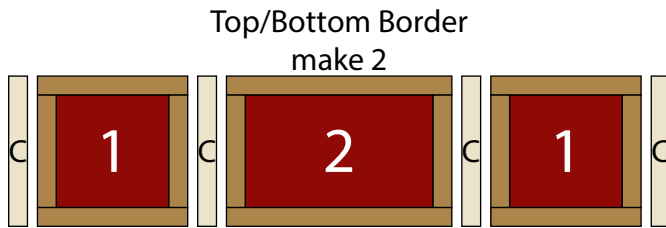

Wall Hanging Assembly

(Follow the Wall Hanging Layout in Figure 6 while assembling the wall hanging top.)

5. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 32 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 32 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

6. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

7. Sew (1) 2" x 32 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

8. Sew (1) 2" x 54 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 35 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

9. Center (1) 6" x 72" Fabric G strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a ¼" from the top edge of the block and stop a ¼" from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.

10. Repeat Step 9 to sew (1) 6" x 50" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start ¼" away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 5).

11. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 5), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a ¼" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the Wall Hanging top.

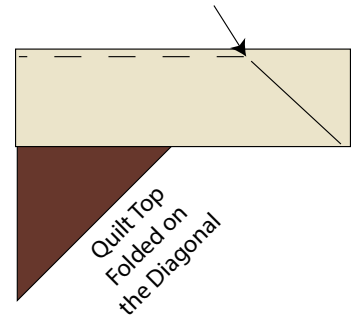

12. Layer and quilt as desired.

13. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

14. Bind as desired.

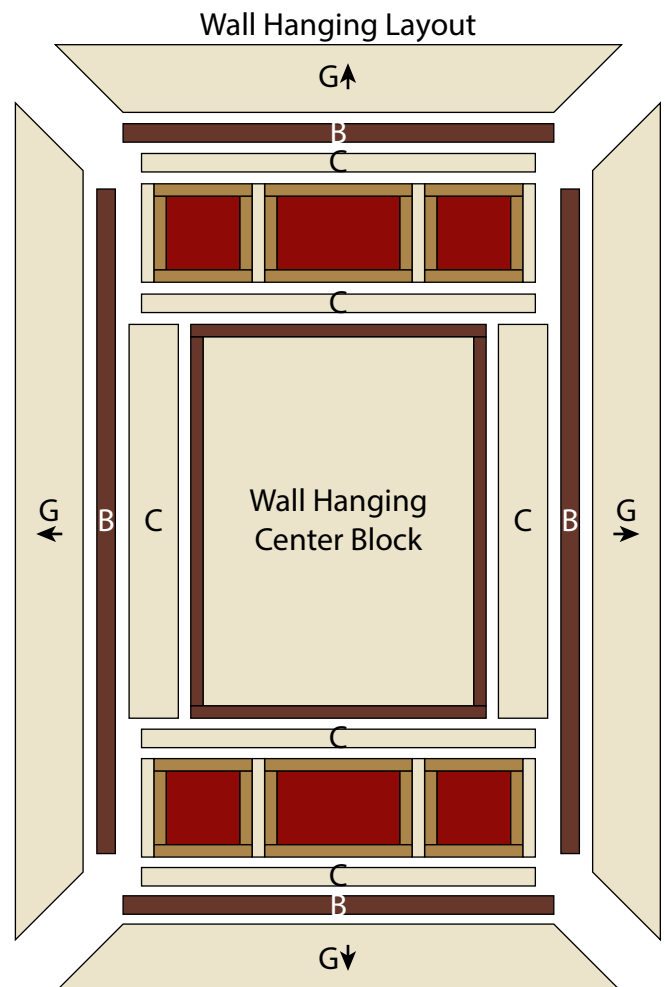

Runner Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 5 Block Panel 24 In x 44 In - Burgundy Multi (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 21 1/2" x 13 1/2" rectangle, centered on the large block.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Brown (B), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 1/2" x 13 1/2" strips.
- (2) 2" x 25 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 1 1/4" x 12 1/2" strips.
- (2) 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 1 1/4" x 14" strips.

From the Packed Pumpkins and Flowers - Orange Multi (C), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Folio Basics - Off-White (D), cut:

- (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 7/8" squares.
- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 1/2" squares.

From the Folio Basics - Forest (E), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 1/2" squares.

From the Tossed Leaves and Acorn - Cream Multi (F), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Packed Leave - Burgundy Multi (G), cut:

- (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 7/8" squares.
- (5) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Tossed Apples - Burgundy Multi (H), cut:

- (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 7/8" squares.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 1/2" x 15 1/2" strips.
- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 56 1/2" strips.

From the Tossed Butterflies - Cream Multi (I), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 4 1/2" squares.
- (2) 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 1 1/4" x 14" strips.
- (2) 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 1 1/4" x 15 1/2" strips.

From the Border Stripe - Burgundy Multi (J), cut:

- (2) 6" x 32" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) 6" x 71" LOF strips.

From the Tossed Turkey - Taupe (K), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Tossed Pumpkin and Leave - Cream Multi (L), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Tossed Pumpkins and Acorn - Burgundy Multi (M), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 1/2" squares.

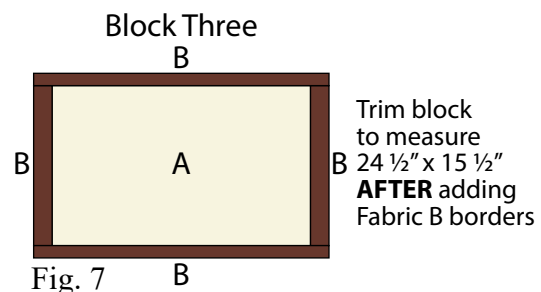
From the Tossed Turkey - Taupe (Backing), cut:

- (1) 75" x 36" WOF strip for the back.

Runner Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

15. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 13 1/2" Fabric B strip to each end of (1) 21 1/2" x 13 1/2" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 25 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Block Three rectangle (Fig. 2). Trim the block to measure 24 1/2" x 15 1/2".



16. Place (1) 2 ½" Fabric M square on the top left corner of (1) 4 ½" Fabric F square, right sides together (Fig. 8). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 8). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle ¼" away from the sewn seam (Fig. 9).

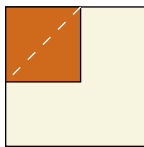

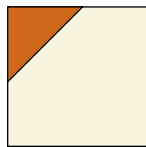

17. Follow Figure 10 for the seam direction to add a 2 ½" Fabric M square to the upper right corner and 2 ½" Fabric E squares to the lower left and lower right corners of the 4 ½" Fabric F square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 11).

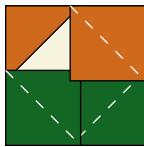

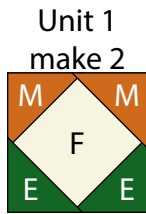

19. Repeat Steps 16-17 and refer to Figures 12-15 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (2) Unit 2 squares, (2) Unit 3 squares, (2) Unit 4 squares and (2) Unit 5 squares.

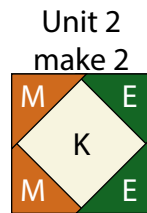

20. Place (1) 2 ⅞" Fabric G square on top of (1) 2 ⅞" Fabric D square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 16). Sew ¼" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 16). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 17) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 2 ½" square to make (2) Unit 6 squares (Fig. 18). Repeat to make (8) Unit 6 squares total.

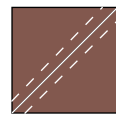

22. Sew (1) Unit 6 square to the left side of (1) Unit 7 square to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 7 square to the left side of (1) 2 ½" Fabric D square to make the bottom row. Sew the (2) rows together lengthwise to make (1) 4 ½" Unit 8 square (Fig. 20). Repeat to make (8) Unit 8 squares total.

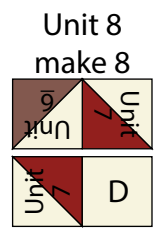

23. Sew (1) Unit 8 square to each side of (1) Unit 1 square to make the top row (Fig. 21).

24. Sew together (1) Unit 2 square, (1) Unit 5 square and (1) Unit 3 square, in that order from left to right, to make the middle row (Fig. 21).

25. Sew (1) Unit 8 square to each side of (1) Unit 4 square to make the bottom row (Fig. 21).

26. Sew together the (3) rows from Steps 23-25 lengthwise to make (1) 12 ½" Unit 9 square (Fig. 21).

27. Repeat Steps 23-26 to make a second Unit 9 square.

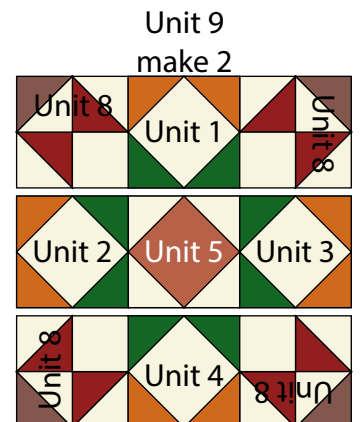

28. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of (1) Unit 9 square. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x 14" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 9 square to make (1) Unit 10 square (Fig. 22). Repeat to make a second Unit 10 square.

29. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x 14" Fabric I strip to each side of (1) Unit 10 square. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $15\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 10 square to make (1) $15\frac{1}{2}$ " Block Four square (Fig. 23). Repeat to make a second Block Four square.

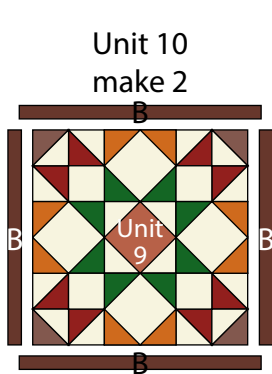

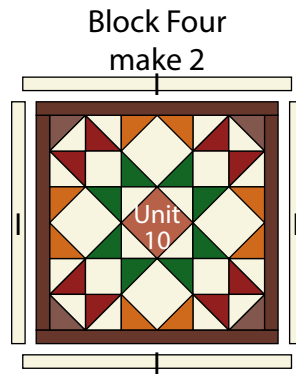

30. Sew (1) Block Four square to each end of (1) Block Three rectangle to make the $54\frac{1}{2}$ " x $15\frac{1}{2}$ " Runner Center Block (Fig. 24).

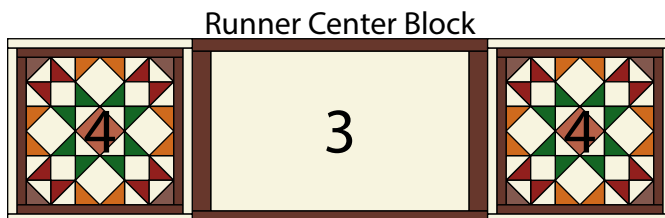

Runner Assembly

(Follow the Runner Layout in Figure 26 while assembling the runner.)

31. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $15\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to each end of the Runner Center Block. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $56\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Runner Center Block.

32. Center (1) 6" x 32" Fabric J strip on (1) side of the Runner Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the top edge of the block and stop a $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.

33. Repeat Step 32 to sew (1) 6" x 71" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Runner Center Block, making sure to stop and start $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Runner Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 25).

34. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 25), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the Runner top.

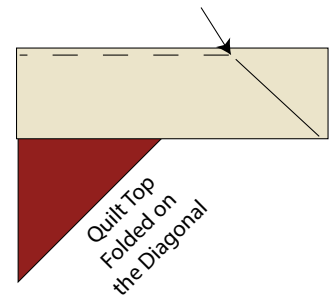

35. Layer and quilt as desired.

36. Sew the (5) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

37. Bind as desired.

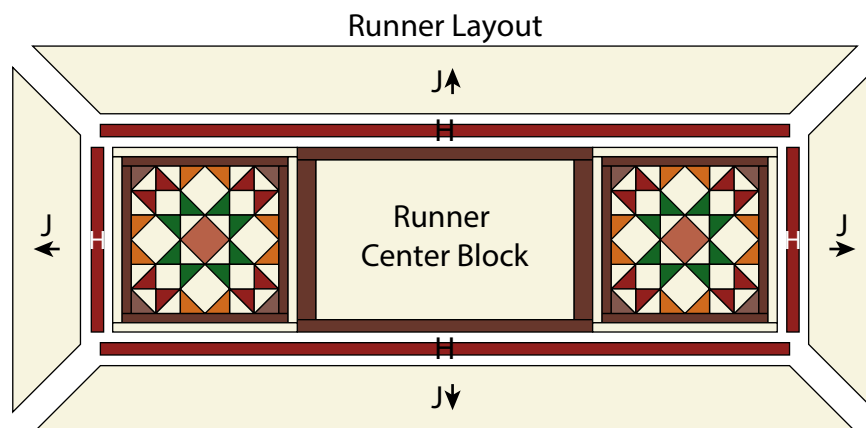

Place Mat Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 5 Block Panel 24 In x 44 In - Burgundy Multi (A):

- (4) 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, each centered on a block.

From the Packed Leave - Burgundy Multi (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2" x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2" x 13 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (7) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Tossed Leaves and Acorn - Cream Multi (C), cut:

- (3) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Tossed Apples - Burgundy Multi (D), cut:

- (3) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Tossed Pumpkin and Leave - Cream Multi (Backs), cut:

- (2) 22" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 22" x 16" strips for the backs.

Place Mat Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

38. Sew (1) 2" x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x 13 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Block Five square (Fig. 27). **Trim the block to measure 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Repeat to make (4) Block Five squares total.**

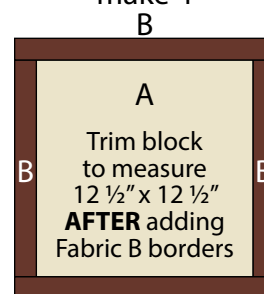

39. Place (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square on the top left corner of (1) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 28). Sew across the diagonal of the small square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 28). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the sewn seam (Fig. 29).

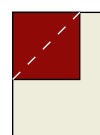

40. Follow Figure 30 for the seam direction to add a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square to the lower left corner of the 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to make (1) Unit 11 rectangle (Fig. 31).

41. Repeat Steps 39-40 to make (24) Unit 11 rectangles total.

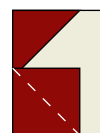

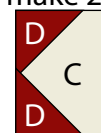

Place Mat Assembly

(Follow the Place Mat Layout in Figure 33 while assembling the place mats.)

43. Sew (1) Block Six strip to each side of (1) Block Five square lengthwise to make (1) Place Mat top (Fig. 33). Repeat to make (4) Place Mat tops total.

44. Layer and quilt as desired.

45. Sew the (7) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

46. Bind as desired.

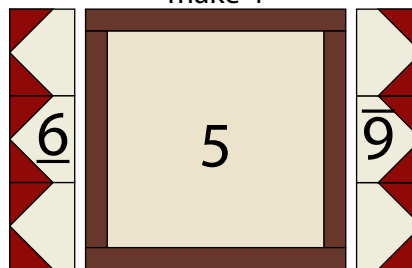
