Wall Hanging Block Assembly
Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2" $\times 301 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the $221 / 2 " \times 301 / 2 "$ Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x $251 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Wall Hanging Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure $241 / 2 " \times 321 / 2 "$.

## Wall Hanging Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Panel 24 In x 44 In - Burgundy Multi (A):

- Fussy cut (1) $22^{1 / 2 "} \times 30^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle, centered on the panel.

From the Packed Leave - Burgundy Multi (B), cut:

- (2) 2 " $\times 301 / 2 /$ " WOF strips.
-(2) 2 " $\times 25^{1 / 2 "}$ WOF strips.
- (3) 2 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " $\times 541 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) 2 " $\times 351 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
- (6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.

From the Tossed Butterflies - Cream Multi (C), cut:

- (2) $41 / 2 " \times 321 / 2$ " WOF strips.
- (4) 2 " $\times 321 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
- (2) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $11 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Tossed Pumpkins and Acorn - Burgundy Multi (D), cut:
-(1) $6^{1 / 2 " x}$ W WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $61 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Packed Pumpkins and Flowers - Orange Multi (E), cut:

- (1) $61 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $61 / 2 " \times 101 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Twinkle - Golden Yellow (F), cut:

- (2) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $11 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $11 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips Sub-cut (4) $11 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Border Stripe - Burgundy Multi (G), cut:

- (2) 6 " $\times 72$ " Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) $6 " \times 50 "$ LOF strips.


## From the Tossed Leaves and Acorn - Cream Multi

 (Backing), cut:- (2) $54 " \mathrm{x}$ WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 54 " $\times 76$ " back.

2. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip to each side of (1) $61 / 2 "$ Fabric D square. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric D square to make (1) $81 / 2 "$ Block One square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (4) Block One squares total.

3. Sew (1) $1 / 1 / 2 " \times 6^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric F strip to each end of (1) $61 / 2 " \times 101 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip. Sew (1) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric E strip to make (1) $121 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ Block Two rectangle (Fig. 3). Repeat to make a second Block Two rectangle.

4. Sew together (1) $11 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric $C$ strip, (1) Block One square, (1) $11 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip, (1) Block Two rectangle, (1) $11 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip, (1) Block One square and (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C strip, in that order from left to right, to make the Top Border (Fig. 4). Repeat to make the Bottom Border.

## Wall Hanging Assembly

(Follow the Wall Hanging Layout in Figure 6 while assembling the wall hanging top.)
5. Sew (1) $41 / 2 \times 321 / 2 "$ Fabric $C$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $2 " \times 321 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
6. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
7. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 321 / 2$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
8. Sew (1) 2" $\times 541 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x $351 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
9. Center (1) $6 " \times 72 "$ Fabric G strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a $1 / 4 "$ from the top edge of the block and stop a $1 / 4$ " from the bottom edge. DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS. Repeat with the opposite side.
10. Repeat Step 9 to sew (1) 6 " $\times 50$ " Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start $1 / 4 "$ away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 5).
11. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 5), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the Wall Hanging top.

12. Layer and quilt as desired.
13. Sew the (6) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
14. Bind as desired.

## Runner Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 5 Block Panel 24 In x 44 In - Burgundy Multi (A):

- Fussy cut (1) $211 / 2$ " $\times 131 / 2$ " rectangle, centered on the large block.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Brown (B), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $21 / 2 " \times 131 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) 2 " $\times 25^{1 / 2 "}$ WOF strips.
- (2) $11 / 4 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) $11 / 4 " \times 121 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $11 / 4 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) $11 / 4 " \times 14 "$ strips.

From the Packed Pumpkins and Flowers - Orange Multi (C), cut:

- (1) $41 / 2 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $41 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Folio Basics - Off-White (D), cut:
-(1) $27 / 8$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) $27 / s^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
-(1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Folio Basics - Forest (E), cut:
-(1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Tossed Leaves and Acorn - Cream Multi (F), cut: - (1) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $41 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Packed Leave - Burgundy Multi (G), cut:
-(1) $27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
-(5) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.

From the Tossed Apples - Burgundy Multi (H), cut:

- (1) $27 / 8 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $27 / 8 "$ squares.
- (1) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $11 / 2 " \times 151 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 2 " \times 561 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Tossed Butterflies - Cream Multi (I), cut:

- (1) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $41 / 2 "$ squares.
- (2) $11 / 4 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) $11 / 4 " \times 14 "$ strips.
- (2) $11 / 4 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) $11 / 4 " \times 151 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Border Stripe - Burgundy Multi (J), cut:

- (2) 6 " $\times 32$ " Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) $6 " \times 71 "$ LOF strips.

From the Tossed Turkey - Taupe (K), cut:

- (1) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $41 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Tossed Pumpkin and Leave - Cream Multi (L), cut:

- (1) $41 / 2 " \mathrm{x}$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $41 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Tossed Pumpkins and Acorn - Burgundy Multi (M), cut:
-(1) $21 / 2>\times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Tossed Turkey - Taupe (Backing), cut: - (1) 75 " $\times 36$ " WOF strip for the back.

## Runner Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.
15. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 131 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each end of (1) $211 / 2 " \times 131 / 2 "$ Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" $\times 251 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Block Three rectangle (Fig. 2).
Trim the block to measure $241 / 2 " \times 151 / 2 "$.

16. Place (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric M square on the top left corner of (1) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric F square, right sides together (Fig. 8). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 8). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4$ " away from the sewn seam (Fig. 9).

17. Follow Figure 10 for the seam direction to add a $21 / 2$ " Fabric M square to the upper right corner and $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E squares to the lower left and lower right corners of the $41 / 2$ " Fabric F square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 11).
18. Repeat Steps 16-17 to make a second Unit 1 square.

19. Repeat Steps 16-17 and refer to Figures 12-15 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (2) Unit 2 squares, (2) Unit 3 squares, (2) Unit 4 squares and (2) Unit 5 squares.

20. Place (1) $27 / 8$ " Fabric G square on top of (1) $27 / 8$ " Fabric D square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 16). Sew $1 / 4$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 16). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 17) to make (2) halfsquare triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure $21 / 2 "$ square to make (2) Unit 6 squares (Fig. 18). Repeat to make (8) Unit 6 squares total.
21. Repeat Step 20 and refer to Figure 19 for fabric identification and placement to make (16) Unit 7 squares.

22. Sew (1) Unit 6 square to the left side of (1) Unit 7 square to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 7 square to the left side of (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric D square to make the bottom row. Sew the (2) rows together lengthwise to make (1) $41 / 2 "$ Unit 8 square (Fig. 20). Repeat to make (8) Unit 8 squares total.

23. Sew (1) Unit 8 square to each side of (1) Unit 1 square to make the top row (Fig. 21).
24. Sew together (1) Unit 2 square, (1) Unit 5 square and (1) Unit 3 square, in that order from left to right, to make the middle row (Fig. 21).
25. Sew (1) Unit 8 square to each side of (1) Unit 4 square to make the bottom row (Fig. 21).
26. Sew together the (3) rows from Steps 23-25 lengthwise to make (1) 12 $1 / 2$ " Unit 9 square (Fig. 21).
27. Repeat Steps 23-26 to make a second Unit 9 square.

28. Sew (1) $11 / 4 " \times 121 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of (1) Unit 9 square. Sew (1) $11 / 4 " \times 14 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 9 square to make (1) Unit 10 square (Fig. 22). Repeat to make a second Unit 10 square.
29. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{4} " \times 14$ " Fabric I strip to each side of (1) Unit 10 square. Sew (1) $11 / 4 " \times 151 / 2 "$ Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 10 square to make (1) $15 \frac{1}{2}$ " Block Four square (Fig. 23). Repeat to make a second Block Four square.

30. Sew (1) Block Four square to each end of (1) Block Three rectangle to make the $541 / 2 " \times 151 / 2 "$ Runner Center Block (Fig. 24).

## Runner Assembly <br> (Follow the Runner Layout in Figure 26 while assembling the runner.)

31. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 15 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to each end of the Runner Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 561 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Runner Center Block.
32. Center (1) 6 " $\times 32$ " Fabric J strip on (1) side of the Runner Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a $1 / 4 "$ from the top edge of the block and stop a $1 / 4 "$ from the bottom edge. DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS. Repeat with the opposite side.
33. Repeat Step 32 to sew (1) 6" $\times 71$ " Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Runner Center Block, making sure to stop and start $1 / 4$ " away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Runner Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 25).
34. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 25), draw a 45 -degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the Runner top.

35. Layer and quilt as desired.
36. Sew the (5) $21 / 2$ " $x$ WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
37. Bind as desired.

From the 5 Block Panel 24 In x 44 In - Burgundy Multi (A): - (4) $101 / 2$ " squares, each centered on a block.

From the Packed Leave - Burgundy Multi (B), cut:

- (2) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2 " x $101 / 2$ " strips.
-(3) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2 " x $131 / 2 "$ strips.
-(7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Tossed Leaves and Acorn - Cream Multi (C), cut: - (3) $31 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $31 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Tossed Apples - Burgundy Multi (D), cut: -(3) $21 / 2$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) $21 / 2$ " squares.

From the Tossed Pumpkin and Leave - Cream Multi (Backs), cut:
-(2) 22 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 22 " x 16 " strips for the backs.

## Place Mat Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.
38. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 101 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $101 / 2 "$ Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x $131 / 2$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Block Five square (Fig. 27). Trim the block to measure $121 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$. Repeat to make (4) Block Five squares total.

39. Place (1) $21 / 2$ " Fabric D square on the top left corner of (1) $31 / 2 " \times 4 \frac{1}{2} "$ Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 28). Sew across the diagonal of the small square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 28). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4 "$ away from the sewn seam (Fig. 29).

40. Follow Figure 30 for the seam direction to add a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D square to the lower left corner of the $31 / 2$ " $\times 41 / 2$ " Fabric C strip to make (1) Unit 11 rectangle (Fig. 31).
41. Repeat Steps 39-40 to make (24) Unit 11 rectangles total.

43. Sew (1) Block Six strip to each side of (1) Block Five square lengthwise to make (1) Place Mat top (Fig. 33).

45. Sew the (7) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
