Block Assembly
Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 10 \frac{1}{1} 2$ " Fabric C strip to each side of (1) $10 \frac{1}{2} 2$ " Fabric A square. Sew (1) $2 "$ x $131 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure $121 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$. Repeat to make (6) Block One squares total.

2. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 51 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to each side of (1) $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D square. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $71 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric D square. Trim the block to measure $61 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (6) Unit 1 squares total.

3. Sew (1) $2^{1 / 2 " \times} 6^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric F strip to the top of (1) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric B strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 2 strip (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (24) Unit 2 strips total.

## From the Tossed Ferns - Cream (Backing), cut:

-(2) $59 " \mathrm{x}$ WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 59 " x 71 " back.

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4. Place (1) 2" Fabric B square on the bottom left corner of (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric G square, right sides together (Fig. 4). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 4). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4$ " away from the sewn seam (Fig. 5).
5. Follow Figure 6 for the seam direction to add a 2" Fabric B square to the upper right corner of the $31 / 2$ " Fabric G square to make (1) Unit 3 square (Fig. 7).
6. Repeat Steps $4-5$ to make (12) Unit 3 squares total.

8. Sew together (1) Unit 3 square, (1) Unit 2 strip and (1) Unit 4 square, in that order from left to right, to make the top row (Fig. 9).
9. Sew (1) Unit 2 strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square to make the middle row (Fig. 9).
10. Sew together (1) Unit 4 square, (1) Unit 2 strip and (1) Unit 3 square, in that order from left to right, to make the bottom row (Fig. 9).
11. Sew together the (3) rows from Steps 8-10 lengthwise to make (1) $121 / 2 "$ Block Two square (Fig. 9).
12. Repeat Steps $8-11$ to make (6) Block Two squares total.
13. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of (1) Block Two square to make Row One (Fig. 10). Repeat to make Row Three.
14. Sew (1) Block Two square to each side of (1) Block One square to make Row Two (Fig. 10). Repeat to make Row Four.
15. Sew together the (4) pieced Rows, in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the $361 / 2 " \times 481 / 2 "$ Center Block (Fig. 10).

Quilt Top Assembly
(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 16. Sew (1) 2" $\times 481 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x $391 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
17. Sew (1) $61 / 2 " \times 511 / 2$ " Fabric H LOF strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $61 / 2 "$ x $511 / 2 "$ Fabric H WOF strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
18. Layer and quilt as desired.
19. Sew the (6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric E strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
20. Bind as desired.
