

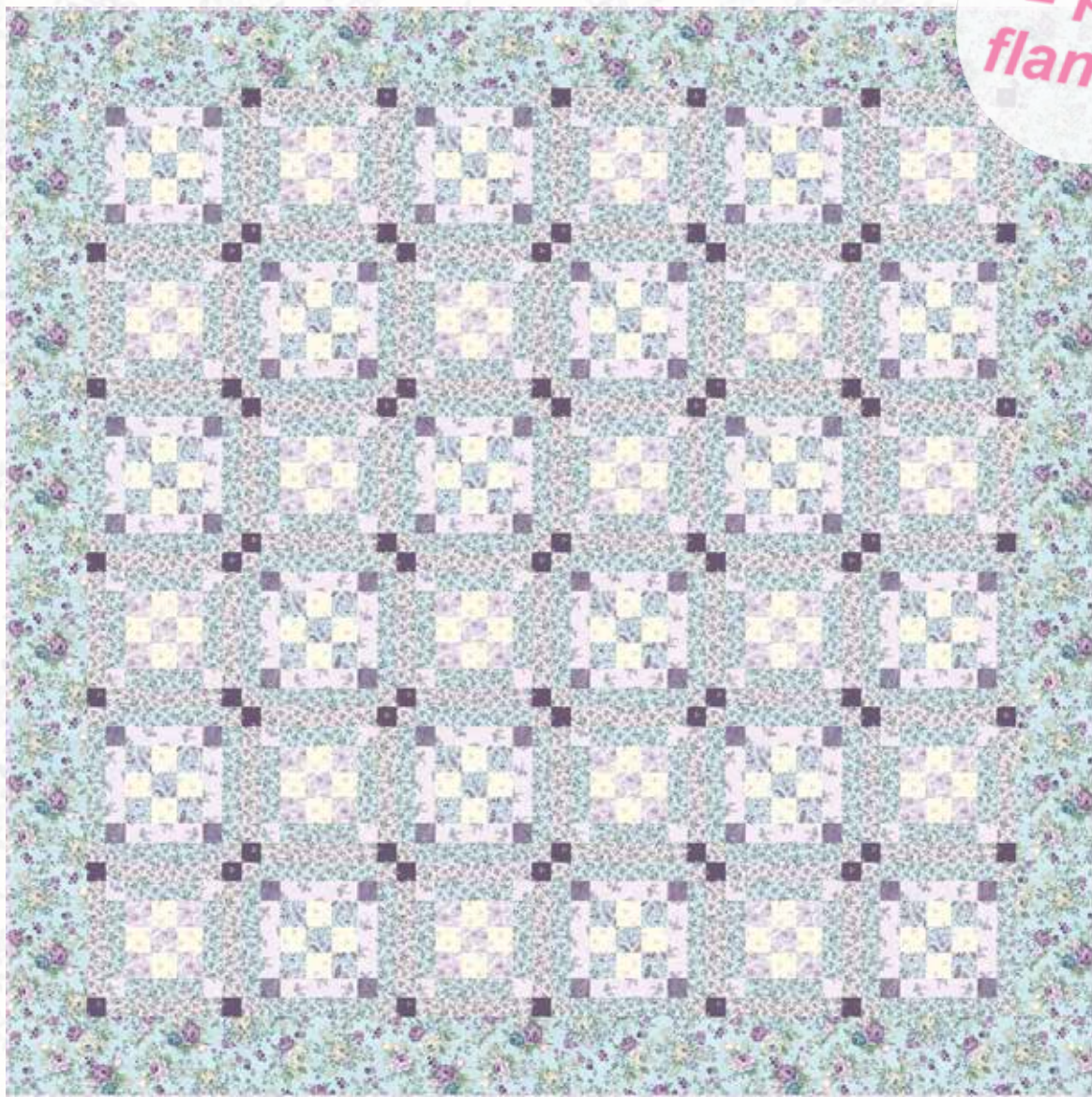

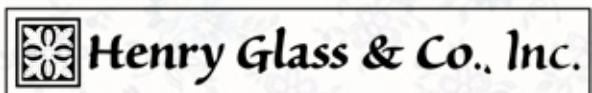

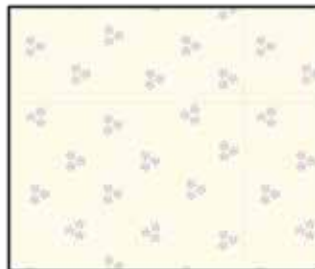

2/3 yard (0.61m)	Paisleys - Light Blue (A)	3193F-17
1 1/8 yard (1.03m)	Daisy Dots - Cream (B)	3196F-45
1 yard (0.92m)	Crescent Flowers - Lilac (C)	3194F-55
1/3 yard (0.31m)	Paisleys - Purple (D)	3193F-55
1 1/3 yards (1.22m)	Calico - Lilac (E)	3192F-55
1 3/4 yards (1.60m)	Calico - Light Blue (F)	3192F-17
1 1/4 yards (1.15m)	Lacy Flowers - Lilac (G)	3195F-55*
1/3 yard (0.31m)	Daisy Dots - Purple (H)	3196F-55
1 3/4 yards (1.60m)	Main Floral - Light Blue (I)	3191F-17
7 3/4 yards (7.08m)	Main Floral - Cream (Backing)	3191F-44

*Includes binding

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

From the Paisleys - Light Blue (A), cut:

- (8) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.

From the Daisy Dots - Cream (B), cut:

- (14) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.

From the Crescent Flowers - Lilac (C), cut:

- (12) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (72) 2" x 6 1/2" strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (72) 2" squares.

From the Paisleys - Purple (D), cut:

- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (72) 2" squares.

From the Calico - Lilac (E), cut:

- (18) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (72) 2" x 9 1/2" strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (72) 2" squares.

From the Calico - Light Blue (F), cut:

- (18) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (72) 2" x 9 1/2" strips.
- (12) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (72) 2" x 6 1/2" strips.

From the Lacy Flowers - Lilac (G), cut:

- (8) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.
- (9) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Daisy Dots - Purple (H), cut:

- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (72) 2" squares.

From the Main Floral - Light Blue (I), cut:

- (4) 6 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 6 1/2" x 72 1/2" strips.
- (5) 6 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 6 1/2" x 84 1/2" strips.

From the Main Floral - Cream (Backing), cut:

- (3) 92" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 92" x 92" back.

Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric A strip to each side of (1) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric B strip lengthwise to make (1) Strip Set 1 (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (3) Strip Set 1's total.

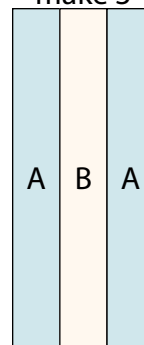

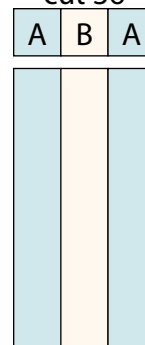

2. Cut (36) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" Unit 1 strips from the (3) Strip Set 1's (Fig. 2).

3. Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to Figures 3-8 for fabric identification and placement to make (18) Unit 2 strips, (36) Unit 3 strips and (18) Unit 4 strips.

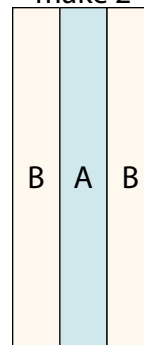

cut 18

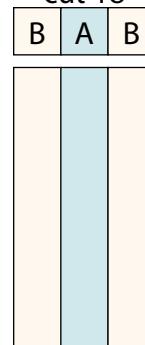

make 3

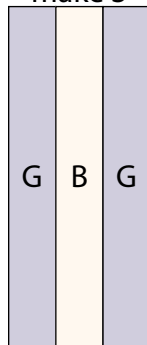

cut 36

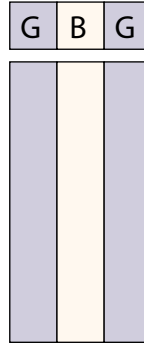

make 2

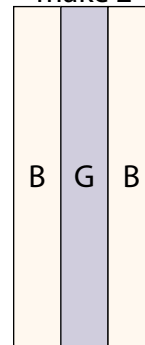

cut 18

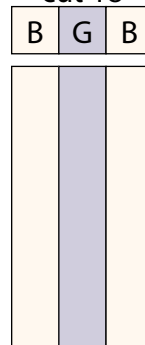

Quilt 1

4. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) Unit 2 strip lengthwise to make (1) 6 1/2" Unit 5 square (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (18) Unit 5 strips total.

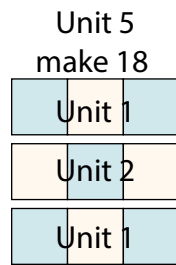

5. Sew (1) Unit 3 strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) Unit 4 strip lengthwise to make (1) 6 1/2" Unit 6 square (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (18) Unit 6 strips total.

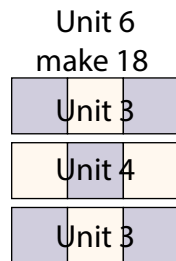

6. Sew (1) 2" Fabric D square to each end of (1) 2" x 6 1/2" Fabric C strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) 2" x 6 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 5 square to make the middle row. Sew together the rows lengthwise to make (1) 9 1/2" Unit 7 square (Fig 11). Repeat to make (18) Unit 7 squares total.

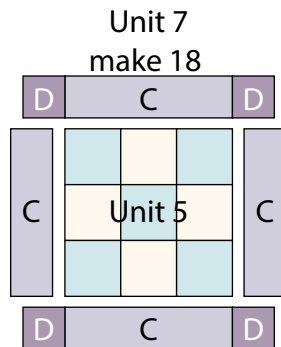

7. Sew (1) 2" Fabric C square to each end of (1) 2" x 6 1/2" Fabric F strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) 2" x 6 1/2" Fabric F strip to each side of (1) Unit 6 square to make the middle row. Sew together the rows lengthwise to make (1) 9 1/2" Unit 8 square (Fig 12). Repeat to make (18) Unit 8 squares total.

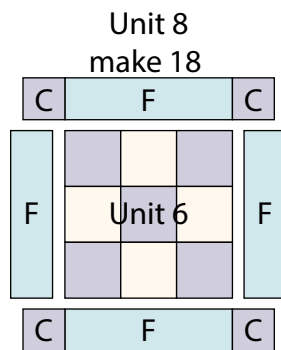

8. Sew (1) 2" Fabric E square to each end of (1) 2" x 9 1/2" Fabric F strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) 2" x 9 1/2" Fabric F strip to each side of (1) Unit 7 square to make the middle row. Sew together the rows lengthwise to make (1) 12 1/2" Block One square (Fig 13). Repeat to make (18) Block One squares total.

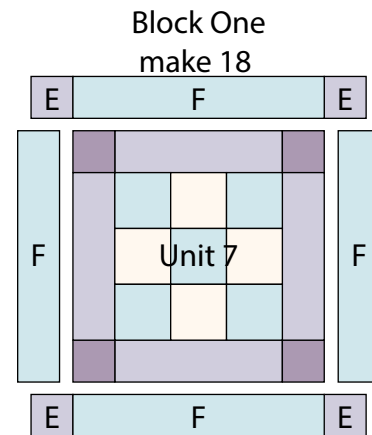

9. Sew (1) 2" Fabric H square to each end of (1) 2" x 9 1/2" Fabric E strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) 2" x 9 1/2" Fabric E strip to each side of (1) Unit 8 square to make the middle row. Sew together the rows lengthwise to make (1) 12 1/2" Block Two square (Fig 14). Repeat to make (18) Block Two squares total.

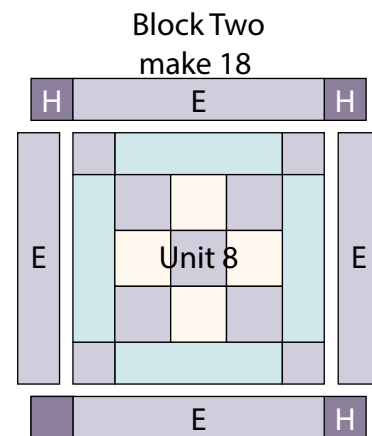

10. Sew Together (3) Block One squares and (3) Block Two squares, alternating them from left to right, to make Row One (Fig. 15). Repeat to make Row Three and Row Five.

11. Sew Together (3) Block Two squares and (3) Block One squares, alternating them from left to right, to make Row Two (Fig. 15). Repeat to make Row Four and Row Six.

12. Sew together the (6) Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 72 ½” x 72 ½” Center Block (Fig. 15).

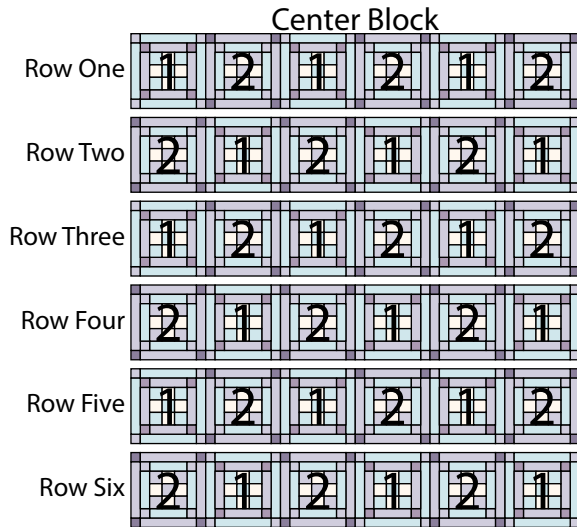

Quilt Top Assembly

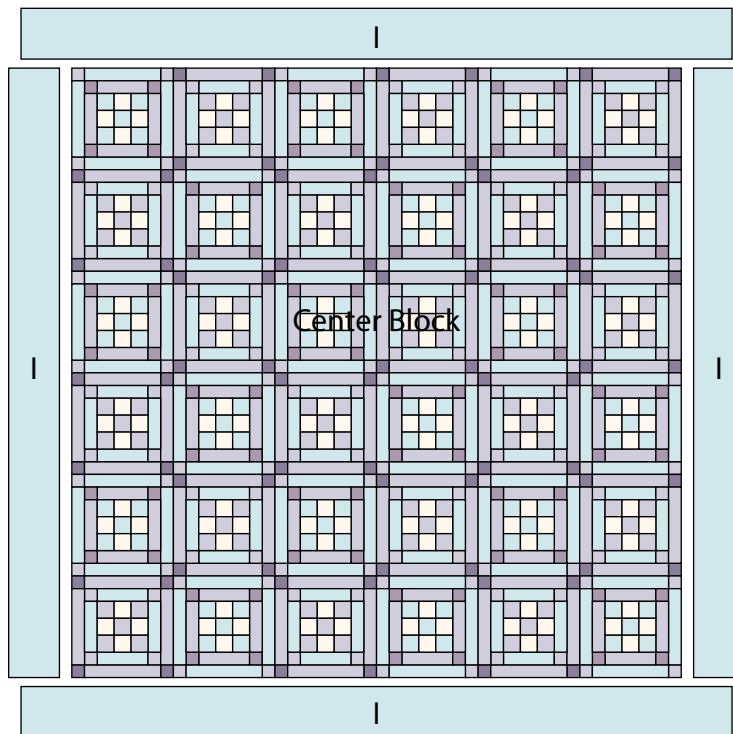
(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

11. Sew (1) 6 ½” x 72 ½” Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 6 ½” x 84 ½” Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

12. Layer and quilt as desired.

13. Sew the (9) 2 ½” x WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

14. Bind as desired.
