

### Materials

1 panel	Unicorn Panel - Royal (A)	2732P-77
1 ½ yards	Rainbow Stripe - Rainbow Multi (B)	2729-11*
1 ⅛ yards	Starry Night Texture - Royal (C)	2726-77
1 yard	Rainbow Hearts - Pink Multi (D)	2727-27
⅝ yard	Rainbow Cloud Texture - Green Multi (E)	2728-66
¼ yard	Modern Melody Basics - Fuchsia (F)	1063-52
¼ yard	Modern Melody Basics - True Blue (G)	1063-71
¼ yard	Modern Melody Basics - Lemon (H)	1063-44
¼ yard	Modern Melody Basics - Teal (I)	1063-61
2 yards	Unicorn Silhouette - Royal Multi (J)	2725-77
5 yards	Allover Unicorns - Blue Multi (Backing)	2724-17

\*Includes binding

### Cutting Instructions

*Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.*

#### From the Unicorn Panel - Royal (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 20 ½" x 38 ½" rectangle, centered on the panel

#### From the Rainbow Stripe - Rainbow Multi (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x 38 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x 23 ½" WOF strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 52 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 36 ½" WOF strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 66 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 50 ½" strips.
- (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.


#### From the Starry Night Texture - Royal (C), cut:

- (2) 4 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (17) 4 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (68) 4 ¼" triangles.
- (2) 6 ½" x 40 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 6 ½" x 34 ½" WOF strips.

#### From the Rainbow Hearts - Pink Multi (D), cut:

- (4) 3 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (34) 3 ⅞" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal from upper right to lower left to make (34) D1 3 ⅞" triangles and (34) D2 3 ⅞" triangles.
- (4) 3 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (34) 3 ⅞" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal from upper left to lower right to make (34) D3 3 ⅞" triangles and (34) D4 3 ⅞" triangles.

#### Fabric D Cutting Diagram



#### From the Rainbow Cloud Texture - Green Multi (E), cut:

- (4) 4 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (34) 4 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (136) 4 ¼" triangles.

#### From the Modern Melody Basics - Fuchsia (F), cut:

- (1) 4 ¼" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 4 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (20) 4 ¼" triangles.  
*Note: You will only use (17) 4 ¼" triangles.*

#### From the Modern Melody Basics - True Blue (G), cut:

- (1) 4 ¼" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 4 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (20) 4 ¼" triangles.  
*Note: You will only use (17) 4 ¼" triangles.*

#### From the Modern Melody Basics - Lemon (H), cut:

- (1) 4 ¼" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 4 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (20) 4 ¼" triangles.  
*Note: You will only use (17) 4 ¼" triangles.*

#### From the Modern Melody Basics - Teal (I), cut:

- (1) 4 ¼" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 4 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (20) 4 ¼" triangles.  
*Note: You will only use (17) 4 ¼" triangles.*

#### From the Unicorn Silhouette - Royal Multi (J), cut:

- (2) 6 ½" x 68 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- From the remaining fabric cut (2) 6 ½" x 62 ½" WOF strips, piece as needed.

#### From the Allover Unicorns - Blue Multi (Backing), cut:

- (2) 88" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 70" x 88" back.

### Block Assembly

*Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.*

1. Sew (1) 2" x 38 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the 20 ½" x 38 ½" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2" x 23 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure 22 ½" x 40 ½".





2. Sew (1) 4 1/4" Fabric E triangle and (1) 4 1/4" Fabric C triangle together along short sides. Sew (1) 3 7/8" Fabric D3 triangle to the long side of the newly sewn triangle to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 2). The unit should measure 3 1/2" x 3 1/2". Repeat to make (17) Unit 1 squares total.




3. Repeat Step 2 and refer to Figures 3-9 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (17) of each unit square for Unit 2 through Unit 8.



4. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to the left side of (1) Unit 2 square to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 3 square to the left side of (1) Unit 4 square to make the bottom row. Sew the (2) rows together lengthwise to make (1) 6 1/2" Block One square (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (17) Block One squares total.



5. Repeat Step 4 and refer to Figure 11 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (17) Block Two squares.



6. Sew (5) Block One squares and (4) Block Two squares together, alternating them from top to bottom, to make the Left Side Border (Fig. 12).



7. Sew (5) Block Two squares and (4) Block One squares together, alternating them from top to bottom, to make the Right Side Border (Fig. 13).

8. Sew (4) Block Two squares and (4) Block One squares together, alternating them from left to right, to make the Top Border (Fig. 14). Repeat to make the Bottom Border.

### Quilt 1

#### Quilt Top Assembly

*(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)*

9. Sew (1) 6 1/2" x 40 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 6 1/2" x 34 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

10. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 52 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 36 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

11. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and right sides of the Center Block.

12. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.


13. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 66 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 50 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

14. Sew (1) 6 1/2" x 68 1/2" Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 6 1/2" x 62 1/2" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

15. Layer and quilt as desired.

16. Sew the (8) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

17. Bind as desired.
