





Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Cupids and Hearts - Cream/Pink (A), cut:

• (2) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 4 ½" squares.

From the Buttermilk Blenders - Real Red (B), cut:

• (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Timeless Linen Basics - Cream (C), cut:

- (11) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (164) 2 ½" squares.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 46 ½" strips.
- (2) 2" x 37 ½" WOF strips.

From the Medium Floral Sprays - Pink (D), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 2 ½" squares.
- (5) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Tiny Vine and Hearts - Cream/Red (E), cut:

• (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (34) 2 ½" squares.

From the Paisley/Foulard - Cream/Red (F), cut:

• (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (34) 2 ½" squares.

From the Timeless Linen Basics - Light Pink (G), cut:

• (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (34) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Timeless Linen Basics - Dark Pink (H), cut:

- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 44 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 34 ½" WOF strips.

From the Tiny Vine and Hearts - Red (I), cut:

- (3) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3 ½" x 49 ½" strips.
- (3) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3 ½" x 43 ½" strips.

From the Medium Floral Sprays - Dark Pink (J), cut:

• (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 4 ½" squares.

From the Medium Floral Sprays - Dark Pink (Backing),

• (2) 51" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 51" x 63" back.

Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Place (1) 2 ½" Fabric C square on the left side of (1) 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric B strip, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance (Fig. 2).



- 2. Place another 2 ½" Fabric C square on the right side of the 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric B strip, right sides together (Fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 4).
- 3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (48) Unit 1 strips total.



4. Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to Figure 5 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (34) Unit 2 strips.



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5. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E square to the left side of (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F square to make the top row. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F square to the left side of (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E square to make the bottom row. Sew together (2) rows lengthwise to make (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 3 square (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (17) Unit 3 squares total.



6. Sew (1) 2 ½" Fabric D square to each end of (1) Unit 1 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to each side of (1) 4 ½" Fabric A square to make the middle row. Sew together (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 8 ½" Block One square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (12) Block One squares total.







7. Sew (1) Unit 2 strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) Unit 3 square lengthwise to make (1) 4 ½" x 8 ½" Block Two rectangle (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (17) Block Two rectangles total.



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- 8. Sew together (3) Block One squares and (2) Block Two rectangles, lengthwise and alternating them from left to right, to make Row One (Fig. 9). Repeat to make Row Three, Row Five and Row Seven.
- 9. Sew together (3) Block Two rectangles and (2) 4 ½" Fabric J squares, end to end and alternating them from left to right, to make Row Two (Fig. 9). Repeat to make Row Four and Row Six.
- 10. Sew together the (7) pieced Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from the top to the bottom, to make the 32 ½" x 44 ½" Center Block (Fig. 9).


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Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
11. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 44 ½" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 34 ½" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

- 12. Sew (1) 2" x 46 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 37 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 13. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 49 ½" Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 43 ½" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

- 14. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 15. Sew the (5) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric D strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 16. Bind as desired.
