$3 / 8$ yard Main Floral - Sage (H)
$7 / 8$ yard $\quad$ Stripe - Cream (I)
$1 / 4$ yard Calico - Tearose (J)
$1 / 4$ yard Calico - Cream (K)
$1 / 4$ yard Calico - Sage (L)
$11 / 8$ yards Paisley - Dark Tearose (M)
$1 / 4$ yard Paisley - Cream (N)
$1 / 4$ yard Fern - Cream/Sage (O)
1/4 yard Paisley - Sage (P)
$1 / 4$ yard $\quad$ Stripe - Tearose (Q)

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Tossed Sprig - Cream/Sage (A), cut:

- (3) $73 / 8 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $73 / 8 "$ squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (24) $73 / 8 "$ triangles.
- (2) $33 / 4$ " WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (24) $33 / 4$ " squares and (12) $27 / 8$ " squares.
- (8) $23 / 8$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (126) $23 / 8$ " squares. Cut (36) of the squares across (1) diagonal to make (72) $23 / 8$ " triangles.
- (2) $21 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $21 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $21 / 4 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $21 / 4 " \times 33 / 4 "$ strips.
-(2) $2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) $2 "$ x $41 / 2 "$ strips.
-(4) $7 / 8 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $7 / 8 " \times 121 / 2 "$ strips.


## From the Main Floral - Tearose (B), cut:

- (1) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $41 / 2 "$ squares.
- (1) $27 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $27 / 8 "$ squares and
(4) $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ squares.
- (1) 3 3/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $33 / 4 " x 9 "$ strips.

From the Fern - Sage (C), cut:

- (2) $2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) $2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $23 / 8 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $23 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Tossed Sprig - Tearose (D), cut:
-(2) $2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) $2 "$ x $41 / 2 "$ strips.

- (2) $23 / 8 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (22) $23 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Tossed Sprig - Sage (E), cut:

- (2) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) $2 "$ x $41 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $23 / 8 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (18) $23 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Fern - Tearose (F), cut:

- (2) $2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) $2 "$ x $41 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $23 / 8 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (26) $23 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Main Floral - Cream (G), cut:

- (1) $33 / 4 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $33 / 4 " x 9 "$ strips.
- (1) $27 / 8 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $27 / 8 "$ squares and
(4) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
- (2) $2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) $2 " x 41 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Main Floral - Sage (H), cut:

- (1) $33 / 4 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $33 / 4 " x 9 "$ strips.
- (1) $27 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $27 / 8 "$ squares and
(4) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
- (2) $2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) $2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Stripe - Cream (I):

- Fussy cut (2) 12 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (17) 3" x $121 / 2 "$ strips centered on double stripe.

From the Calico - Tearose (J), cut:
-(2) $2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) $2 "$ x $41 / 2 "$ strips.
From the Calico - Cream (K), cut:

- (2) $2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) $2 "$ x $41 / 2 "$ strips.
- (1) $13 / 4 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) $13 / 4 "$ squares.

From the Calico - Sage (L), cut:

- (2) $2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) $2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.
-(1) $13 / 4 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) $13 / 4 "$ squares.
From the Paisley - Dark Tearose (M), cut:
- (3) $23 / 4$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $23 / 4 " \times 451 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $21 / 2 " \times 56 "$ strips.
- (7) WOF strips for the binding.

From the Paisley - Cream (N), cut:
-(2) $2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) $2 "$ x $41 / 2 "$ strips.
From the Fern - Cream/Sage (O), cut:

- (2) $2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) $2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Paisley - Sage ( P ), cut:
-(2) $2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) $2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.
From the Stripe - Tearose (Q), cut:
-(1) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) $2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.
From the Main Floral - Sage (Backing), cut:
-(2) $61 " \times$ WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $61 " \times 76 "$ back.

## Block Assembly

1. Place (1) $23 / 8 "$ Fabric C square on top of (1) $23 / 8$ " Fabric A square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 1). Sew $1 / 4$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2) to make (2) halfsquare triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 2 " square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (48) Unit 1 squares total.

2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figures $4-6$ for fabric identification and placement to make (44) Unit 2 blocks, (36) Unit 3 blocks and (52) Unit 4 blocks.

7. Place (1) $33 / 4$ " Fabric A square on the left side of (1) $33 / 4 " \times 9$ " Fabric B strip, right sides together (Fig. 13).
Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 13). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 14).

8. Place another $33 / 4$ " Fabric A square on the right side of the $33 / 4 " \times 9$ " Fabric B strip, right sides together (Fig. 15). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 15). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. Flip open the triangle formed and press to make (1) Unit 11 strip (Fig. 16).
9. Repeat Steps 7-8 to make (4) Unit 11 strips total.

11. Place (1) $27 / 8$ " Fabric B square on top of (1) $27 / 8 "$ Fabric A square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 19). Sew $1 / 4$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 19). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 20) to make (2) halfsquare triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure $21 / 2 "$ square to make (2) Unit 14 squares (Fig. 21). Repeat to make (8) Unit 14 squares total.

12. Repeat Step 11 and refer to Figures $22-23$ for fabric identification and placement to make (8) $21 / 2$ " Unit 15 squares and (8) $21 / 2 "$ Unit 16 squares.

13. Sew (1) $21 / 4 " \times 3 / 4 / 4$ Fabric A strip to each end of (1) Unit 11 strip to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 14 block to each side of (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric B square. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric A strip to each end of the Fabric B strip to make the bottom row. Sew the (2) rows together lengthwise. Sew (1) $7 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A strip to the bottom of the new strip to make (1) Unit 17 rectangle (Fig. 24). Repeat to make (4) Unit 17 rectangles total.

20. Sew (1) 3 " $\times 121 / 2 "$ Fabric I strip, (1) Unit 20 block, (1) $3 " \times 121 / 2 "$ Fabric I strip, (1) Unit 21 block and (1) $3 " \times 121 / 2 "$ Fabric I strip together in that order to make (1) Sashing Row (Fig. 32). Repeat to make (3) Sashing Rows total.

23. Sew (1) Block One square, (1) $3 " \times 121 / 2 "$ Fabric I strip, (1) Block Two square, (1) $3 " \times 121 / 2 "$ Fabric I strip and (1)

Block Three square together in that order to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Four.

24. Sew (1) Block Three square, (1) 3 " $\times 121 / 2 "$ Fabric I strip, (1) Block One square, (1) $3 " \times 121 / 2 "$ Fabric I strip and (1) Block Two square together in that order to make Row Two.
25. Sew (1) Block Two square, (1) 3 " $\times 121 / 2 "$ Fabric I strip, (1) Block Three square, (1) 3 " x $121 / 2 "$ Fabric I strip and (1) Block One square together in that order to make Row Three.
26. Sew the (4) pieced rows and (3) Sashing Rows together lengthwise and alternating them to make the Center Block.
27. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 56 "$ Fabric M strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $23 / 4$ " x $451 / 2 "$ Fabric M strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
28. Sew the Pieced Left, Right, Top and Bottom Borders to the Center Block to make the quilt top.
29. Layer and quilt as desired.
30. Sew the (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric M strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
31. Bind as desired.
22. Sew (30) assorted 2 " $\times 41 / 2 "$ strips together. Sew (1) $41 / 2$ " Fabric B square to each end of the sewn strip to make the Pieced Top Border (Fig. 35). Repeat to make the Pieced Bottom Border (Fig. 36).
