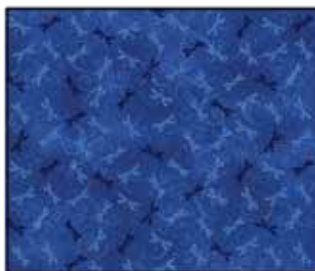

1 panel	Waterlily Magic Blocks Panel 24" x 44" - Indigo (A)	2894P-77
1 yard	Folio - Early Green (B)	7755-62
$\frac{3}{4}$ yard	Folio - Christmas Green (C)	7755-66
$\frac{5}{8}$ yard	Swirly Texture - Blue (D)	2892-77
1 $\frac{3}{4}$ yard	Waterlily Flower Allover - Indigo (Large Back)	2886-77
1 yard	Dragonfly and Swirl Toss - Yellow (Small Backs)	2888-33

You will also need:

- (2) 20" Pillow Forms
- 1 Bag of fiber fill

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Waterlily Magic Blocks Panel 24" x 44" - Indigo (A), fussy cut:

- (1) 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 13" rectangle, centered on the large block.
- (4) 11" x 13 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, each centered on a small block.

From the Folio - Early Green (B), cut:

- (2) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 3" x 13 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) 2" x 25 $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) 2" x 13 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 2" x 14" strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2" squares.
- (4) 1 $\frac{5}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 $\frac{5}{8}$ " x 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 16" strips.

From the Folio - Christmas Green (C), cut:

- (5) 1 $\frac{5}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) 1 $\frac{5}{8}$ " x 48" strips.
- (2) 1 $\frac{5}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 1 $\frac{5}{8}$ " x 15" strips.
- (4) 1 $\frac{5}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 $\frac{5}{8}$ " x 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Swirly Texture - Blue (D), cut:

- (3) 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 48" strips.
- (2) 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 2" strips.
- (2) 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (1) 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 15" strips.
- (4) 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Waterlily Flower Allover - Indigo (Large Back), cut:

- (1) 54" x 21" WOF strip for the large back.

From the Dragonfly and Swirl Toss - Yellow (Small Backs), cut:

- (2) 14" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 14" x 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips for the small backs.

Large Pillow Assembly

Note: Use a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2" x 13 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 11" x 13 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 14" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make (1) Block One rectangle (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 15"**. Repeat to make a second Block One rectangle.

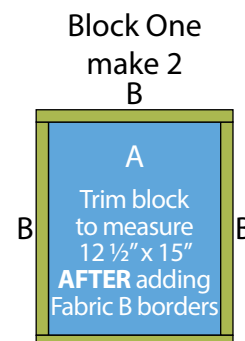

2. Sew (1) 2" x 13 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 13 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 25 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make (1) Block Two rectangle (Fig. 2). **Trim the block to measure 24" x 15"**.

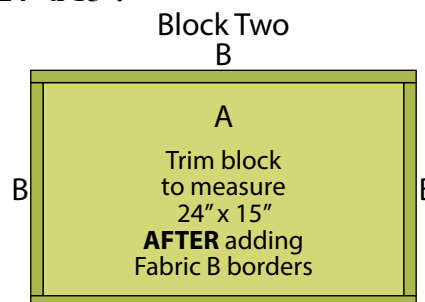

3. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 2" Fabric D strip to each side of (1) 2" Fabric B square. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric B square to make (1) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 1 square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (4) Unit 1 squares total.

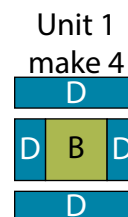

4. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{5}{8}$ " x 15" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 15" Fabric D strip lengthwise to make (1) Side Border (Fig. 4). Repeat to make a second Side Border.

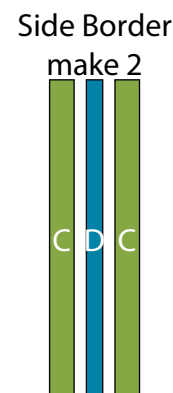


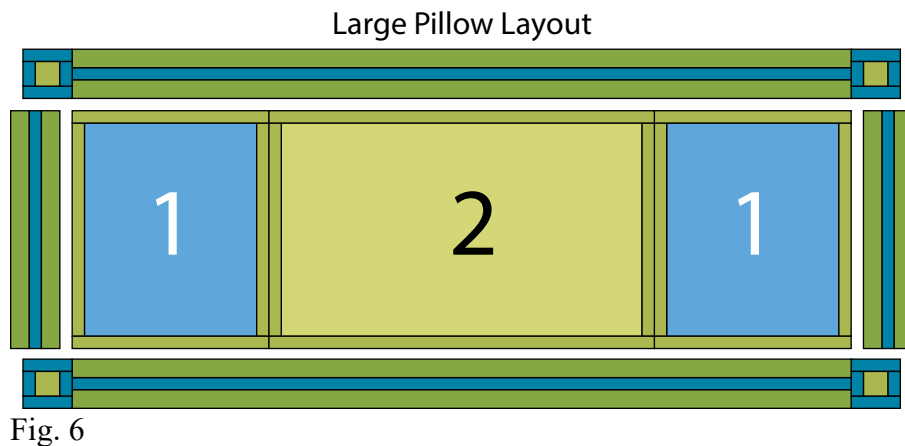
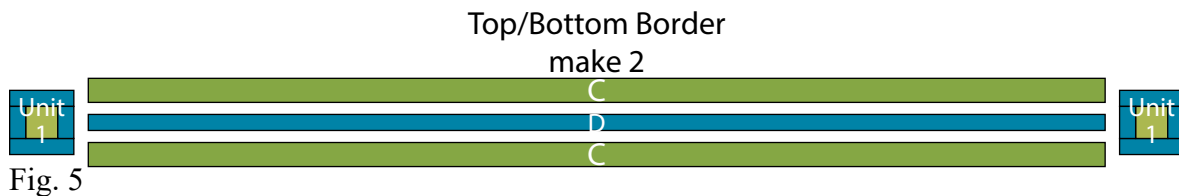

5. Sew (1) $1 \frac{5}{8}$ " x 48" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x 48" Fabric D strip lengthwise. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Top Border (Fig. 5 below). Repeat to make the Bottom Border.

6. Sew (1) Block One rectangle to each side of the Block Two rectangle. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the newly sewn strip. Sew the Top and Bottom Borders to the top and bottom of the newly sewn strip lengthwise to make the Large Pillow top (Fig. 7 below).

7. Place the Large Pillow Top, right sides together with the (1) 54" x 21" Waterlily Flower Allover – Indigo piece. Pin the two layers together and sew around the two pieces, leaving a 4" opening for turning to make the large pillow.

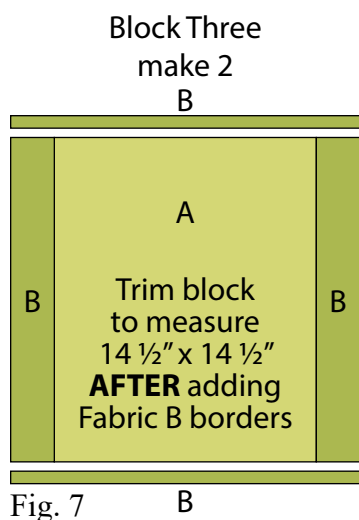
8. Turn the large pillow right sides out through the opening. Stuff the pillow with fiber fill. Hand sew the opening closed.



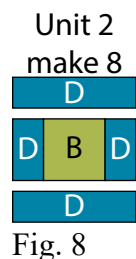
Small Pillow Assembly

Note: Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

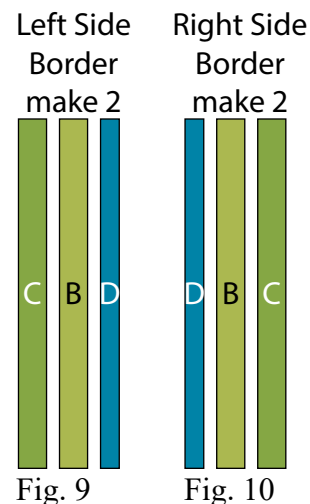
9. Sew (1) 3" x 13 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 11" x 13 1/2" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 16" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make (1) Block Three square (Fig. 7). **Trim the block to measure 14 1/2" x 14 1/2"**. Repeat to make a second Block Three square.



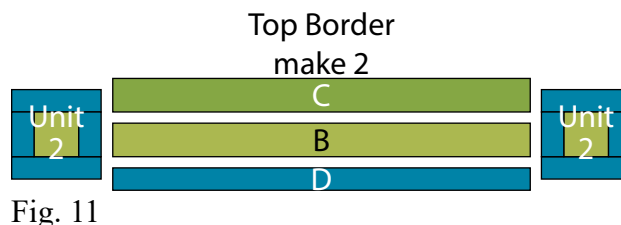
10. Sew (1) 1 1/4" x 2" Fabric D strip to each side of (1) 2" Fabric B square. Sew (1) 1 1/4" x 3 1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric B square to make (1) 3 1/2" Unit 2 square (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (8) Unit 2 squares total.



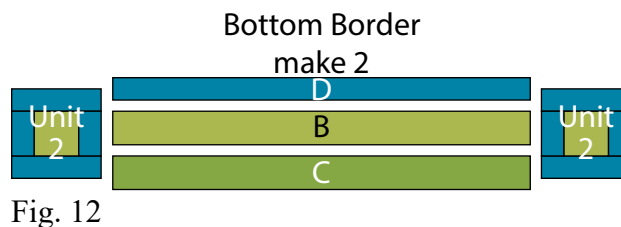
11. Sew (1) 1 5/8" x 14 1/2" Fabric C strip, (1) 1 5/8" x 14 1/2" Fabric B strip and (1) 1 1/4" x 14 1/2" Fabric D strip together lengthwise and in that order from left to right to make the Left Side Border (Fig. 9). Repeat to make a second Left Side Border.



13. Sew (1) 1 5/8" x 14 1/2" Fabric C strip, (1) 1 5/8" x 14 1/2" Fabric B strip and (1) 1 1/4" x 14 1/2" Fabric D strip together lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom. Sew (1) Unit 2 square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Top Border (Fig. 11). Repeat to make a second Top Border.



14. Sew (1) 1 1/4" x 14 1/2" Fabric D strip, (1) 1 5/8" x 14 1/2" Fabric B strip and (1) 1 5/8" x 14 1/2" Fabric C strip together lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom. Sew (1) Unit 2 strip to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Bottom Border (Fig. 12). Repeat to make a second Bottom Border.



15. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of (1) Block Three square. Sew the Top and Bottom Borders to the top and to the bottom of the Block Three square to make (1) Small Pillow top (Fig. 13). Repeat to make a second Small Pillow top.

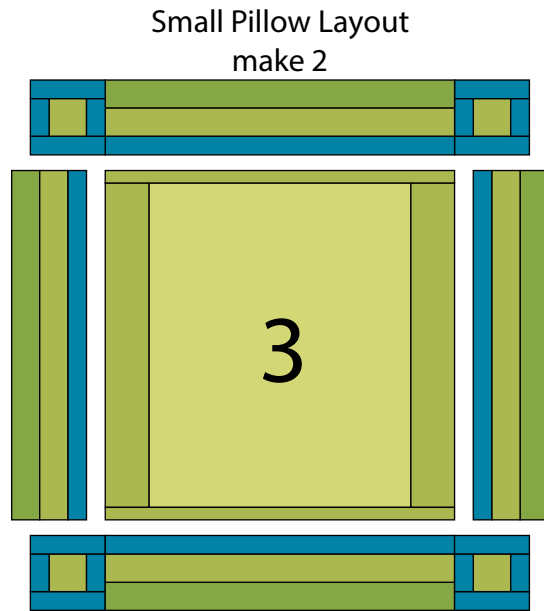

16. Turn under the 20 ½" edge of (1) 14" x 20 ½" Backing strip approximately ¼", press and repeat to make a finished edge on one edge of the 14" x 20 ½" backing piece. Repeat with the second 14" x 20 ½" backing piece.

17. Position and pin the each back envelope flap, right sides together with the pillow front, overlapping the finished edges in the middle and aligning the raw edges with the pillow front (Fig. 14). Stitch around the pillow front and back to complete the pillow.

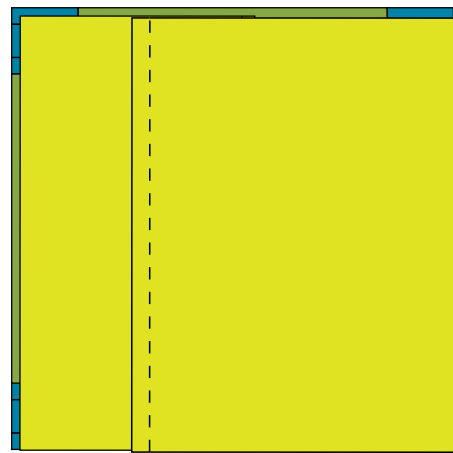

18. Turn the pillow right side out.

19. Repeat Steps 16-17 to make a second pillow.

20. Insert a pillow form to complete each pillow.
