





Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 24" Snowman Panel - Multi (A):

• Fussy cut (1) 20" x 28" rectangle, centered on the panel.

From the Swirling Snow - Red (B), cut:

(2) 2" x 28" WOF strips.
(2) 2" x 23" WOF strips.

From the Hot Cocoa Toss - Blue (C), cut:

(2) 2" x 29 ¹/₂" WOF strips.
(2) 2" x 24 ¹/₂" WOF strips.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Pigment White (D), cut:

• (1) 4 ⁷/₈" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 4 ⁷/₈" squares.

• (4) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (56) 2 ¹/₂" squares.

• (4) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (28) 2 ¹/₂" x 4 ¹/₂" strips.

From the Snowflake - Gray (E), cut:

(4) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (60) 2 ¹/₂" squares.
(4) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (28) 2 ¹/₂" x 4 ¹/₂" strips.

From the Snowflake - Blue (F), cut:

• (1) 4 ⁷/₈" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 4 ⁷/₈" squares.

From the Diagonal Candy Cane Stripe - Red/White (G), cut:

• (2) 2" x 40 ¹/₂" WOF strips.

- (2) 2" x 35 ½" WOF strips.
- (6) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Swirling Snow - Blue (H), cut:

- (3) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ¹/₂" x 43 ¹/₂" strips.
- (2) 1 ¹/₂" x 37 ¹/₂" WOF strips.

From the Fuzzy Dot on Knit Ground - Gray (I), cut:

- (3) 5 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 ¹/₂" x 45 ¹/₂" strips.
- (3) 5 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 ¹/₂" x 47 ¹/₂" strips.


From the Snowman and Animal Allover - Gray (Backing), cut:

• (2) 63" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 55" x 63" back.

Block Assembly


Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2" x 28" Fabric B strip to each side of the 20" x 28" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2" x 23" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure** 21 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 29 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".




2. Place (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square on the left side of (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal

of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¹/₄" seam allowance (Fig. 3).



3. Place another 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square on the right side of the 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip, right sides together (Fig. 4). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 4). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 5).

4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (28) Unit 1 strips total.








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5. Repeat Steps 2-3 and refer to Figure 6 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (28) Unit 2 strips.


6. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to the top of (1) Unit 2 strip lengthwise to make (1) 4 ¹/₂" Unit 3 square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (28) Unit 3 squares total.



7. Place (1) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric D square on top of (1) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric F square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 8). Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 8). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 9) to make (2) halfsquare triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square to make (2) Unit 4 squares (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (4) Unit 4 squares total.



8. Place (1) 2 ¹/₂" Fabric E square on the bottom right corner of (1) Unit 4 square, right sides together (Fig. 11). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 11). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle ¹/₄" away from the sewn seam to make (1) Unit 5 square (Fig. 12). Repeat to make (4) Unit 5 squares total.



9. Sew together (8) Unit 3 squares to make (1) Side Border (Fig. 13 below). Repeat to make a second Side Border.


10. Sew together (6) Unit 3 squares. Sew (1) Unit 5 square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Top Border (Fig. 14 below). Repeat to make the Bottom Border.


Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 11. Sew (1) 2" x 29 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

12. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

13. Sew (1) 2" x 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 35 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.





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
14. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 43 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 37 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

15. Sew (1) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 45 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 47 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

16. Layer and quilt as desired.

17. Sew the (6) $2\frac{1}{2}$ x WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

18. Bind as desired.
