### Quilt Materials

2/3 yard	Large Blocks - Gray (A)	9569-91
1/2 yard	Modern Melody Basics - Silver Gray (B)	1063-90
3/4 yard	Tossed Animals - Multi (C)	9563-91
1/4 yard	Giraffe Skin - Tan (D)	9562-33
1/4 yard	Tossed Glasses - Gray (E)	9565-91
3/4 yard	Mini Dots - Orange (F)	9568-34*
1/4 yard	Small Set Dots - Orange (G)	9567-43
3 yards	Stripe - Multi (Backing)	9561-90

\*Includes binding

### Quilt Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Large Blocks - Gray (A):

- Fussy cut (4) 9" x 10 3/4" rectangles, centered on the rabbit, the fox, the deer and the elephant.

#### From the Modern Melody Basics - Silver Gray (B), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2" x 10 3/4" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2" x 12" strips.

#### From the Tossed Animals - Multi (C), cut:

- (2) 4 1/2" x 33" WOF strips.
- (2) 4 1/2" x 37" WOF strips.
- (1) 5 1/2" square.

#### From the Giraffe Skin - Tan (D), cut:

- (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3 1/2" squares and (4) 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" strips.

#### From the Tossed Glasses - Gray (E), cut:

- (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3 1/2" squares.

#### From the Mini Dots - Orange (F), cut:

- (2) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" strips.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips.
- (2) 1 1/4" x 31 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 1/4" x 29" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 1 1/4" x 3 1/2" strips.
- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Small Set Dots - Orange (G), cut:

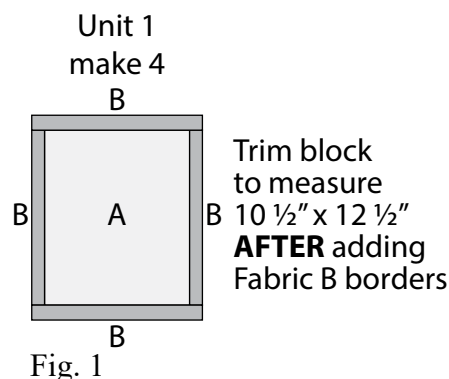
- (2) 1 1/2" x 29 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 1/2" x 27 1/2" WOF strips.

#### From the Stripe - Multi (Backing), cut:

- (2) 49" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 45" x 49" back.

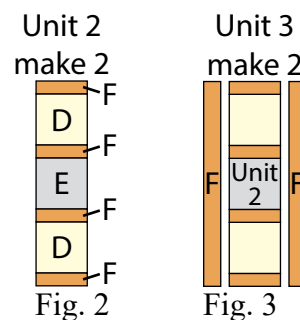
### Block Assembly

- Sew (1) 2" x 10 3/4" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 9" x 10 3/4" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 12" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make (1) Unit 1 rectangle (Fig. 1). **Trim the unit to measure 10 1/2" x 12 1/2"**. Repeat to make (4) Unit 1 rectangles total.



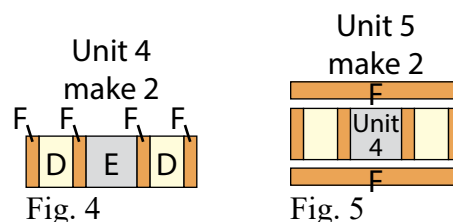
- Sew together (1) 1 1/4" x 3 1/2" Fabric F strip, (1) 3 1/2" Fabric D square, (1) 1 1/4" x 3 1/2" Fabric F strip, (1) 3 1/2" Fabric E square, (1) 1 1/4" x 3 1/2" Fabric F strip, (1) 3 1/2" Fabric D square and (1) 1 1/4" x 3 1/2" Fabric F strip, in that order from top to bottom, to make (1) Unit 2 strip (Fig. 2). Repeat to make a second Unit 2 strip.

- Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric F strip to each side of (1) Unit 2 strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 3 strip (Fig. 3). Repeat to make a second Unit 3 strip.



- Sew together (1) 1 1/4" x 3 1/2" Fabric F strip, (1) 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" Fabric D strip, (1) 1 1/4" x 3 1/2" Fabric F strip, (1) 3 1/2" Fabric E square, (1) 1 1/4" x 3 1/2" Fabric F strip, (1) 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" Fabric D strip and (1) 1 1/4" x 3 1/2" Fabric F strip, in that order from left to right, to make (1) Unit 4 strip (Fig. 4). Repeat to make a second Unit 4 strip.

- Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) Unit 4 strip to make (1) Unit 5 strip (Fig. 5). Repeat to make a second Unit 5 strip.



6. Sew (1) Unit 1 rectangle to each side of (1) Unit 3 strip to make (1) Block One rectangle (Fig. 6). Repeat to make a second Block One rectangle.

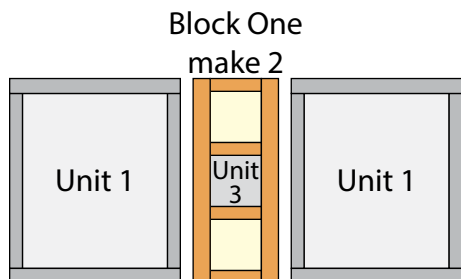

7. Sew (1) Unit 5 strip to each side of (1) 5 1/2" Fabric C square to make (1) Block Two strip (Fig. 7).

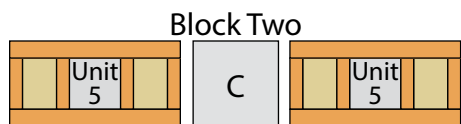

### Quilt Top Assembly

*(Follow the Quilt Layout [Fig. 8] while assembling the quilt top.)*

8. Sew (1) Block One rectangle to the top and to the bottom of the Block Two strip to make the Center Block.
9. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 29 1/2" Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 27 1/2" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
10. Sew (1) 1 1/4" x 31 1/2" Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 1/4" x 29" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
11. Sew (1) 4 1/2" x 33" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 4 1/2" x 37" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
12. Layer and quilt as desired.
13. Sew the (4) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric F strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
14. Bind as desired.

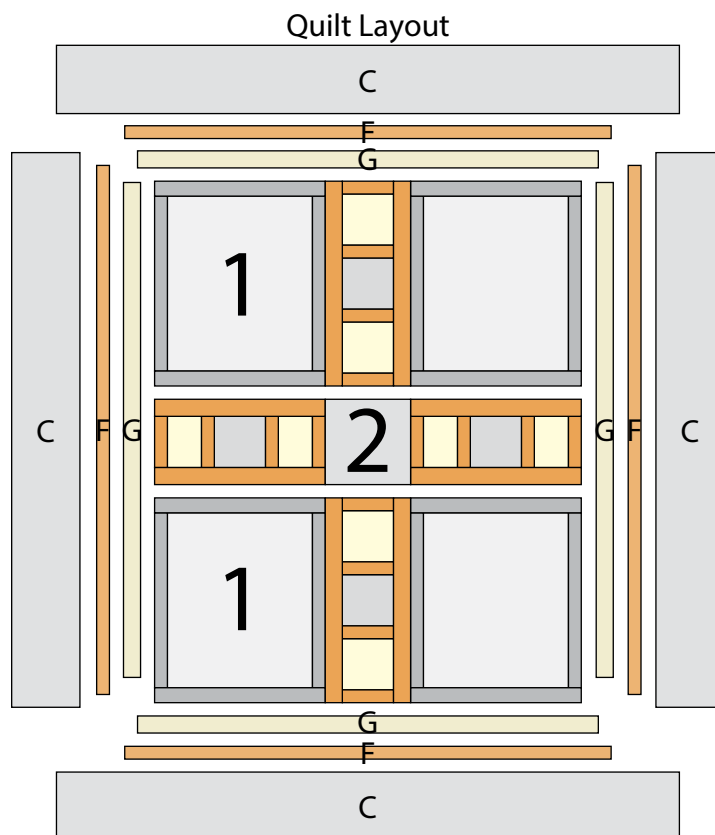

### Pillow Materials (makes 2)

2/3 yard	Large Blocks - Gray (A)	9569-91
3/8 yard	Modern Melody Basics - Silver Gray (B)	1063-90
1/4 yard	Mini Dots - Orange (C)	9568-34
1/4 yard	Tossed Hedgehog - Gray (D)	9566-91
1/4 yard	Tossed Giraffes - Black (E)	9564-93
5/8 yard	Tossed Hedgehog - Gray (Backing #1)	9566-91
5/8 yard	Tossed Giraffes - Black (Backing #2)	

### You will also need:

- Fiber fill

### Pillow Cutting Instructions

*Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.*

#### From the Large Blocks - Gray (A):

- Fussy cut (2) 9" x 10 3/4" rectangles, (1) centered on the hedgehog and (1) centered on the giraffe.

#### From the Modern Melody Basics - Silver Gray (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 2" x 10 3/4" strips.
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 2" x 12" strips.

#### From the Mini Dots - Orange (C)

- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" strips.

#### Tossed Hedgehog - Gray (D)

- (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 3 1/2" x 14 1/2" strips.
- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 1/2" x 18 1/2" strips.

#### Tossed Giraffes - Black (E)

- (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 3 1/2" x 14 1/2" strips.
- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 1/2" x 18 1/2" strips.

#### Tossed Hedgehog - Gray (Back #1)

- (1) 18 1/2" square.

#### Tossed Giraffes - Black (Back #2)

- (1) 18 1/2" square.

### Pillows Assembly

15. Sew (1) 2" x 10 3/4" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 9" x 10 3/4" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 12" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make (1) Unit 6 rectangle (Fig. 9). **Trim the unit to measure 10 1/2" x 12 1/2".** Repeat to make a second Unit 6 rectangle.

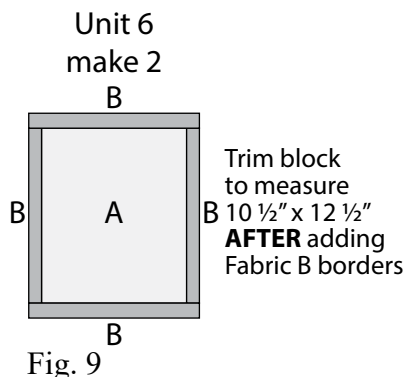

16. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 6 rectangle. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 6 rectangle to make (1) Unit 7 rectangle (Fig. 10). Repeat to make a second Unit 7 rectangle.

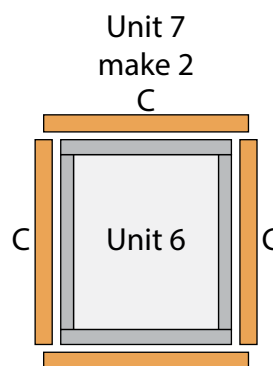

18. Sew (1) 3 1/2" x 14 1/2" Fabric E strip to each side of (1) Unit 7 rectangle. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 18 1/2" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 7 rectangle to make the 18 1/2" square Pillow #2 top (Fig. 12).

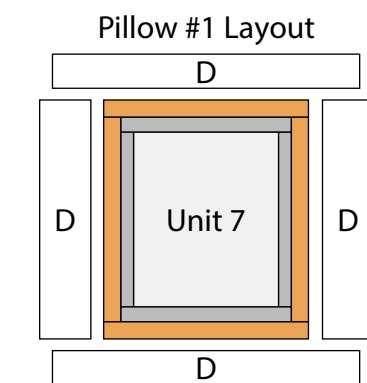

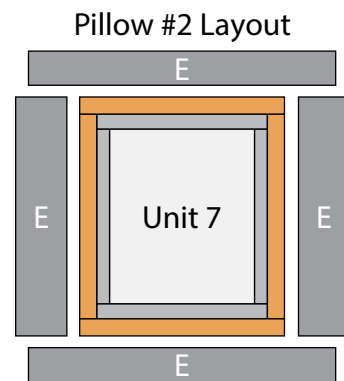

19. Place the 18 1/2" back for Pillow #1 and the Pillow #1 top right sides together and sew around the perimeter, leaving an opening.

20. Turn the pillow top right side out and fill with fiber fill. Sew the opening closed to complete the Pillow #1.

21. Repeat Steps 19-20 to complete Pillow #2.

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
