2/3 yard	24" Repeat of 8 Blocks - Red/Black (A) F9526-89
1 3/8 yards	Textured Chevron - Green (B) F9529-66
1 1/4 yards	Textured Vine Allover - Light Gray (C) F9530-90
1/2 yard	Snowflakes - Red (D) F9527-88
1/4 yard	Vines and Berries - Black (E) F9532-99
1 1/4 yards	Poinsettias - Red/Black (F) F9528-98
1/4 yard	Colored Trees on Gray Check - Multi (G) F9533-98
5/8 yard	Textured Chevron - Red (H) F9529-88*
3/8 yard	White Textured Motifs on Black Background - Black/White (I) F9531-99
4 1/3 yards	White Textured Motifs on Black Background - Black/White (Backing) F9531-99

*Includes binding

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 24" Repeat of 8 Blocks - Red/Black (A):

- Fussy cut (8) 9 1/2" x 11 1/2" rectangles, each centered on a block.

From the Textured Chevron - Green (B), cut:

- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 2 1/2" x 11 1/2" strips.
- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 2 1/2" x 13 1/2" strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2" x 11 1/2" strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2" x 12 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 54 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 51 1/2" strips.

From the Textured Vine Allover - Light Gray (C), cut:

- (4) 3 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 3 1/2" x 12 1/2" strips.
- (6) 3 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 3 1/2" x 14 1/2" strips.

From the Snowflakes - Red (D), cut:

- (4) 3 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 3 1/2" squares.

From the Vines and Berries - Black (E), cut:

- (2) 3 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 3 1/2" squares.

From the Poinsettias - Red/Black (F), cut:

- (3) 6 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 6 1/2" x 57 1/2" strips.
- (3) 6 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 6 1/2" x 51 1/2" strips.

From the Colored Trees on Gray Check - Multi (G), cut:

- (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6 1/2" squares.

From the Textured Chevron - Red (H), cut:

- (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the White Textured Motifs on Black Background - Black/White (I), cut:

- (1) 11 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangle.

From the White Textured Motifs on Black Background - Black/White (Back), cut:

- (2) 77" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 71" x 77" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 11 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 9 1/2" x 11 1/2" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 13 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make (1) Block One rectangle (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 12 1/2" x 14 1/2"**. Repeat to make (8) Block One rectangles total.

2. Sew (1) 2" x 11 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the 9 1/2" x 11 1/2" Fabric I rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 12 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric I rectangle to make (1) Block Two rectangle (Fig. 2).

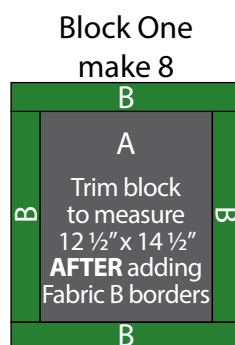

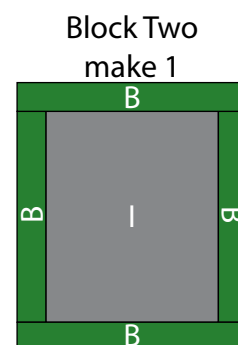

3. Place (1) 3 1/2" Fabric D square on the left side of (1) 3 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance (Fig. 4).

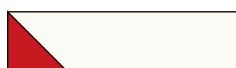

4. Place another 3 1/2" Fabric D square on the right side of the 3 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 5). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 5). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 6).

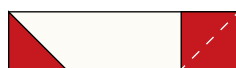

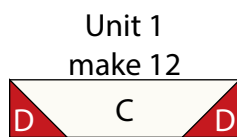

6. Repeat Steps 3-4 using (12) 3 1/2" x 14 1/2" Fabric C strips and (24) 3 1/2" Fabric D squares to make (12) Unit 2 strips total (Fig. 7).

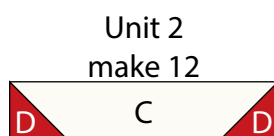

7. Sew (4) 3 1/2" Fabric E squares and (3) Unit 1 strips together end to end and alternating them from left to right to make (1) Unit 3 strip (Fig. 8 below). Repeat to make (4) Unit 3 strips total.

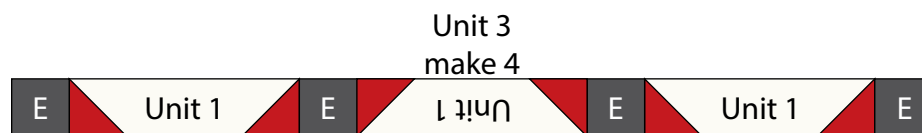

8. Sew together (4) Unit 2 strips and (3) Block One rectangles, alternating them from left to right, to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three.

9. Sew together (1) Unit 2 strip, (1) Block One rectangle, (1) Unit 2 strip, (1) Block Two rectangle, (1) Unit 2 strip, (1) Block One rectangle and (1) Unit 2 strip, in that order from left to right, to make Row Two.

10. Sew the (4) Unit 3 strips and (3) pieced Rows, in numerical order, together alternating them from top to bottom to make the Center Block (Fig. 9).

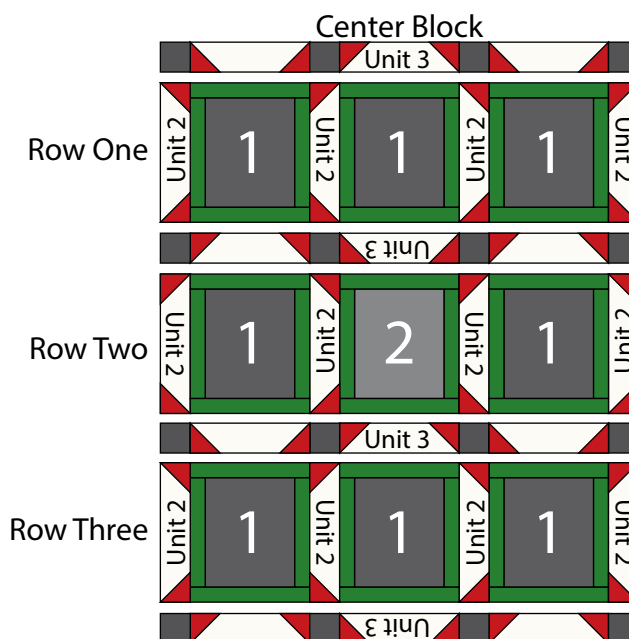

Quilt 1

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Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

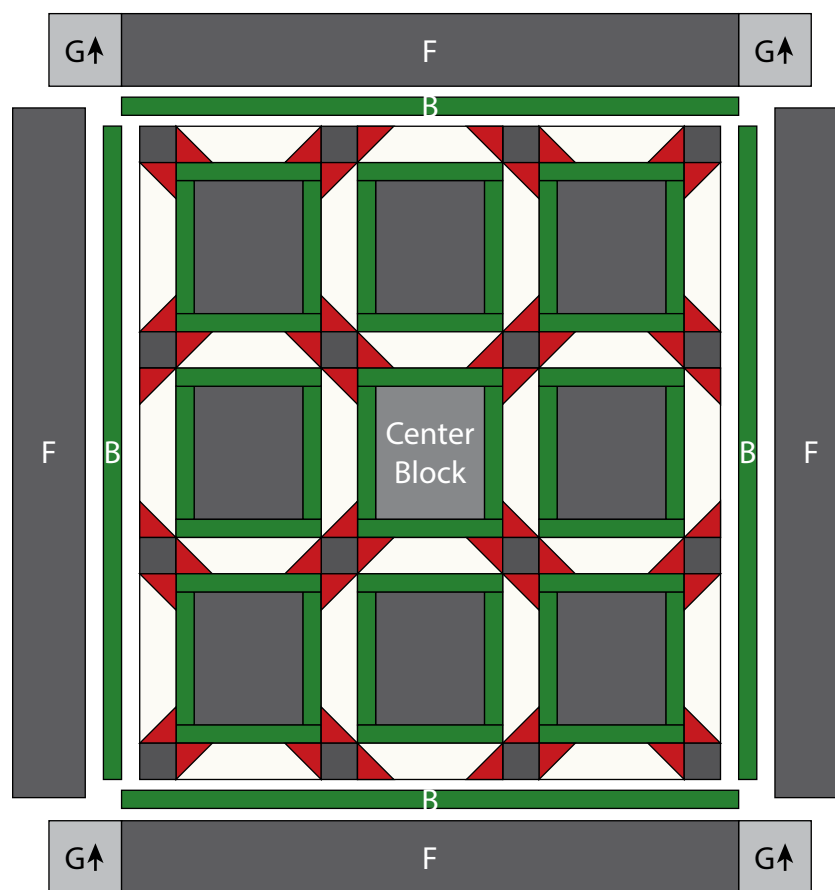
11. Sew (1) 2" X 54 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 51 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

12. Sew (1) 6 ½" x 57 ½" Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 6 ½" Fabric G square to each end of (1) 6 ½" x 51 ½" Fabric F strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

13. Layer and quilt as desired.

14. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric H strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

15. Bind as desired.
