$\frac{5}{8}$ yard	Snowflakes - Red (B)	2831-88
$\frac{1}{2}$ yard	Plaid - Cream (C)	2827-33
$\frac{3}{8}$ yard	Holly & Mistletoe - Green (D)	2829-66
$\frac{1}{4}$ yard	Birds and Branches - Black (E)	2830-99
$\frac{1}{4}$ yard	Large Flower Allover - Black (F)	2826-99
1 $\frac{2}{3}$ yards	Border Stripe - Black (G)	2832-99
$\frac{1}{4}$ yard	Winter Paisley - Red (H)	2828-88
$\frac{1}{2}$ yard	Folio Basics Forest (I)	7755-68*
3 $\frac{1}{4}$ yards	Snowflakes - Cream (Backing)	2831-33

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Centerpiece Panel 24 x 44 Inch - Cream (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 41 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle, centered on the panel.

From the Snowflakes - Red (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x 41 $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x 25 $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
- (3) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 55 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 38 $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.

From the Plaid - Cream (C), cut:

- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2" x 19" strips.
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2" x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Holly & Mistletoe - Green (D), cut:

- (2) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 19" strips.
- (1) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Birds and Branches - Black (E), cut:

- (1) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Large Flower Allover - Black (F), cut:

- (1) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Border Stripe - Black (G), cut:

- (2) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 57 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 38 $\frac{1}{2}$ " LOF strips.

From the Winter Paisley - Red (H), cut:

- (1) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Folio Basics - Forest (I), cut:

- (6) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Snowflakes - Cream (Backing), cut:

- (2) 56" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 56" x 75" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

- Sew (1) 2" x 41 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 41 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 25 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 43 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

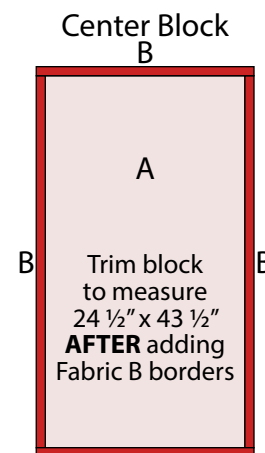

- Sew (1) 2" x 19" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) 3" x 19" Fabric D strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (4) Unit 1 strips total.

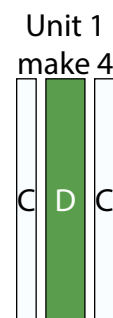

- Sew (1) 2" x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 2 strip (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (4) Unit 2 strips total.

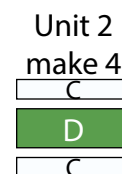

4. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) 6 ½" Fabric F square to make (1) Side Border (Fig. 4). Repeat to make a second Side Border.

5. Sew together (1) 6 ½" Fabric E square, (1) Unit 2 strip, (1) 6 ½" Fabric F square, (1) Unit 2 strip and (1) 6 ½" Fabric E square, in that order from left to right, to make the Top Border (Fig. 5). Repeat to make the Bottom Border.

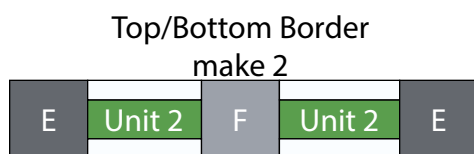

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

6. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block.

7. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

8. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 55 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 38 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

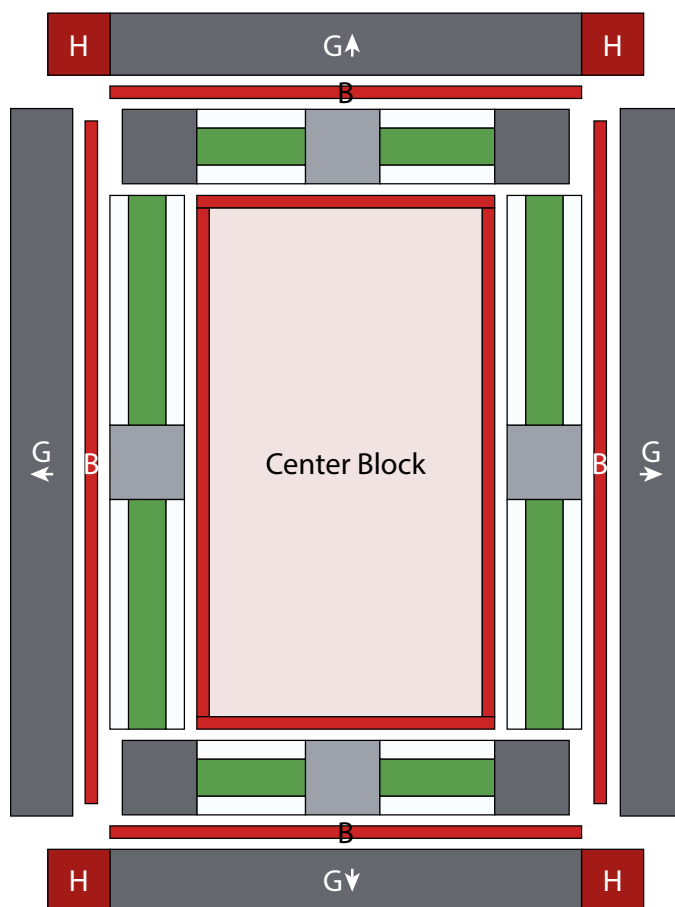
9. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 57 ½" Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block.

10. Sew (1) 5 ½" Fabric H square to each end of (1) 5 ½" x 38 ½" Fabric G strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

11. Layer and quilt as desired.

12. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric I strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

13. Bind as desired.
