## Materials

1 panel Gnomes Panel - Red/Gray (A)
$3 / 8$ yard Stripe - Red/White (B)
$1 / 3$ yard Snowflakes - White/Gray (C)
7/8 yard Snowflakes - Red (D)
1 yard Groups of Gnomes - Gray/Red (E)
$3 / 8$ yard Tossed Gnomes - White/Red (F)
$11 / 8$ yards Plaid Set on Bias - Red/Gray (G)
$11 / 3$ yards Tossed Gnomes - Gray (H)
$41 / 2$ yards Gnome Patch Allover - Red/Gray (Backing)

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Gnomes Panel - Red/Gray (A):

- Fussy cut (1) $201 / 2 " \times 241 / 2 "$ panel.

From the Stripe - Red/White (B), cut:
-(4) $21 / 2 " \times 24^{1 / 2 "}$ WOF strips.
From the Snowflakes - White/Gray (C), cut:

- (2) 2 " x $271 / 2$ " WOF strips.
-(2) 2 " x $261 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
From the Snowflakes - Red (D), cut:
-(3) 2 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " $\times 55^{1 / 2 "}$ strips.
-(3) 2 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " $\times 541 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) 2 " $\times 271 / 2$ " WOF strips.
-(2) 2 " $\times 231 / 1 / 2$ WOF strips.
-(2) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2 " x $101 / 2 "$ strips.


## From the Groups of Gnomes - Gray/Red (E), cut:

-(2) 9 " $\times 271 / 2 "$ LOF strips.
-(2) 9 " $\times 23 \frac{112 "}{2}$ WOF strips from the remaining fabric, piece as needed.

From the Tossed Gnomes - White/Red (F), cut:

- (1) $101 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $101 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Plaid Set on Bias - Red/Gray (G), cut:

- (3) 3 " $x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3 " $\times 501 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) 3" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3 " $\times 511 / 2 "$ strips.
-(7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.

From the Tossed Gnomes - Gray (H), cut:

- (4) $61 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $61 / 2 " \times 66^{1 / 2}$ " strips.
- (3) $61 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $61 / 2 " \times 581 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Gnome Patch Allover - Red/Gray (Backing), cut: - (2) $78 \times$ WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 74 " x 78 " back.

## Block Assembly

1. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 241 / 2$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the $20 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $24 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A panel. Sew (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 24^{1 / 2 "}$
Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure $231 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 271 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).

Note: The arrows in Figures 2-5 represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric orientations while assembling the units.
2. Sew (1) $2 " \times 231 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the bottom of (1) 9" $\times 231 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E strip. Sew (1) 2" x $101 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to each side of the Fabric E strip to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 2).

3. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 231 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the top of (1) $9 " \times 231 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip. Sew (1) 2" x $101 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to each side of the Fabric E strip to make (1) Unit 2 strip (Fig. 3).

4. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 27^{1 / 2 "}$

Fabric D strip to the right side of (1) 9 " $\times 271 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip. Sew (1) $2 " \times 101 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric E strip to make the Left Side Border (Fig. 4).
5. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 27^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric D strip to the left side of (1) 9" $\times 271 / 2$ " Fabric E strip. Sew (1) $2 " \times 101 / 2$ " Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric E strip to make the Right

6. Sew (1) $101 / 2 "$ Fabric F square to each end of (1) Unit 1 strip to the make the Top Border (Fig. 6).

7. Sew (1) $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F square to each end of (1) Unit 2 strip to the make the Bottom Border (Fig. 7).

Quilt Top Assembly
(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 8. Sew (1) 2" $\times 27^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x $261 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
9. Sew the Side, Top and Bottom Borders to the Center Block.
10. Sew (1) $3 " \times 501 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3" x $511 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
11. Sew (1) $2 " \times 55^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x $541 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
12. Sew (1) $61 / 2 " \times 581 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $61 / 2 " \times 661 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
13. Layer and quilt as desired.
14. Sew the (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
15. Bind as desired.
