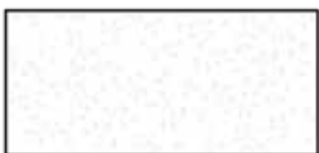

Materials

1 panel	Bunny Farm Panel - Pink (A)	1843P-22
5/8 yard	Folio Basics - Butter (B)	7755-03
1 1/8 yards	Bias Plaid - Multi (C)	1842-21*
2/3 yard	Animals in Squares - Pink (D)	1840-22
1/2 yard	Folio Basics - White on White (E)	7755-01
1/4 yard	Modern Melody Basics - Orange (F)	1063-34
1/8 yard	Folio Basics - Jade (G)	7755-61
1 yard	Bunny Barn and Truck Toss - Green (H)	1844-66
1/4 yard	Chicken Toss - Yellow (I)	1845-44
3 1/4 yards	Tossed Bunnies - Blue (Backing)	1841-11

*Includes binding

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Bunny Farm Panel - Pink (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 22 3/4" x 33 3/4" strip.

From the Folio Basics - Butter (B), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x 33 3/4" WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x 26 3/4" WOF strips.
- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 48 1/2" strips.
- (2) 1 1/2" x 40 1/2" WOF strips.

From the Bias Plaid - Multi (C), cut:

- (3) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 3" x 5 1/2" strips.
- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 45 1/2" strips.
- (2) 2" x 38 1/2" WOF strips.

From the Animals in Squares - Pink (D):

- Fussy cut (6) 3 3/4" Green squares, (6) 3 3/4" Yellow squares and (6) 3 3/4" Pink squares.

From the Folio Basics - White on White (E), cut:

- (4) 1 3/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (36) 1 3/8" x 3 3/4" strips.
- (6) 1 3/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (36) 1 3/8" x 5 1/2" strips.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Orange (F), cut:

- (20) Carrots.

From the Folio Basics - Jade (G), cut:

- (20) Carrot Tops.

From the Bunny Barn and Truck Toss - Green (H), cut:

- (3) 5 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 1/2" x 50 1/2" strips.
- (2) 5 1/2" x 40 1/2" WOF strips.

From the Chicken Toss - Yellow (I), cut:

- (1) 5 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 5 1/2" squares.

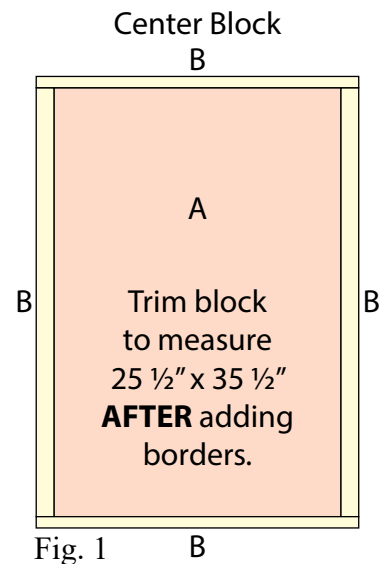
From the Tossed Bunnies - Blue (Backing), cut:

- (2) 58" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 58" x 68" back.

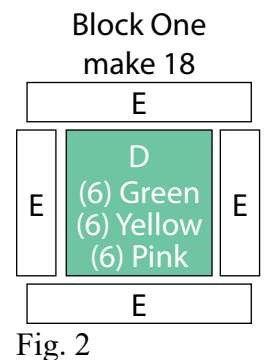
Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the components.

1. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 33 3/4" Fabric B strip to each side of the 22 3/4" x 33 3/4" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2" x 26 3/4" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure 25 1/2" x 35 1/2" to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).



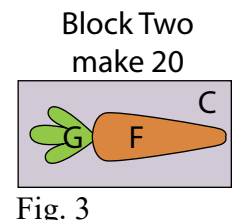
2. Sew (1) 1 3/8" x 3 3/4" Fabric E strip to each side (1) 3 3/4" Fabric D Green square. Sew (1) 1 3/8" x 5 1/2" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric D square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (18) Block One squares total: (6) Green, (6) Yellow and (6) Pink.



3. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.

4. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.

5. Refer to Figure 3 to arrange and press (1) Fabric G Carrot Top and (1) Fabric F Carrot onto (1) 3" x 5 1/2" Fabric C strip.



6. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make (1) Block Two strip.

7. Repeat Steps 5-6 to make (20) Block Two strips total.

8. Sew (1) Block Two strip, (1) Block One square, (1) Block Two strip, (1) Block square, (1) Block Two strip, (1) Block One square, (1) Block Two strip, (1) Block One square and (1) Block Two strip together, in that order and from top to bottom, to make the Left Side Border (Fig. 4).

9. Repeat Step 8 and refer to Figures 5-7 for component identification, placement and orientation to make the Right Side Border, the Top Border and the Bottom Border.

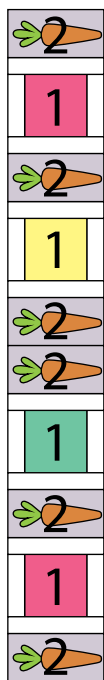

Right Side Border

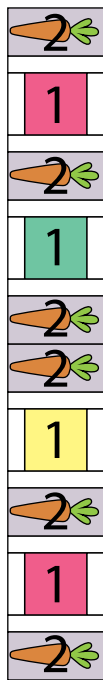

Top Border

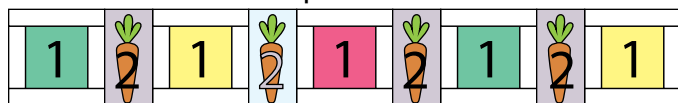

Bottom Border

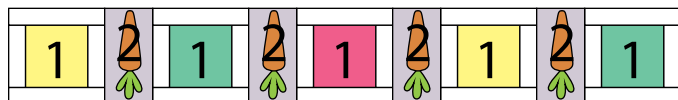

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

10. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left side and to the right side of the Center Block. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

11. Sew (1) 2" x 45 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 38 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

12. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 48 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 40 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

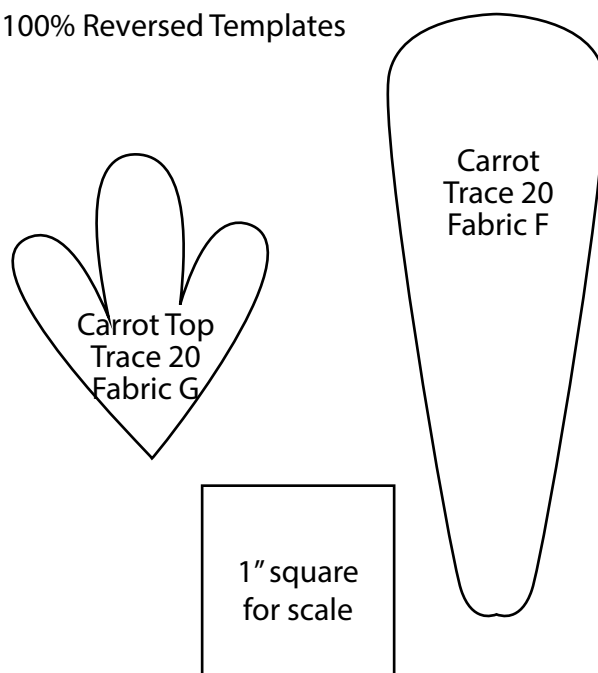
13. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 50 1/2" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 1/2" Fabric I square to each end of (1) 5 1/2" x 40 1/2" Fabric H strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

14. Layer and quilt as desired.

15. Sew the (6) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

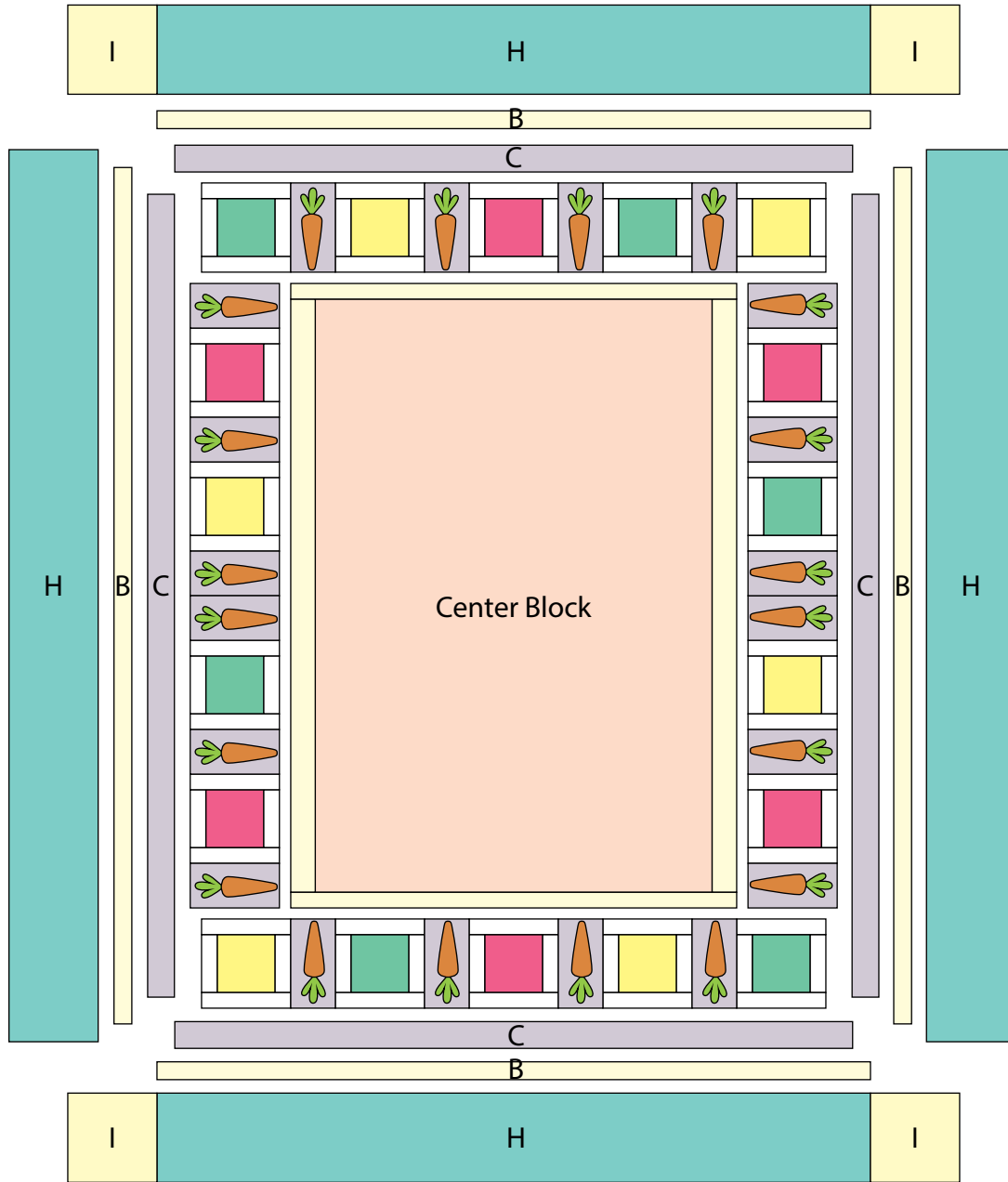
16. Bind as desired.
