## Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Bunny Farm Panel - Pink (A):

- Fussy cut (1) $223 / 4$ " x 33 3/4" strip.

From the Folio Basics - Butter (B), cut:

- (2) $21 / 2 " \times 333 / 4 "$ WOF strips.
- (2) $2 " \times 263 / 4 "$ WOF strips.
- (3) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 481 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 401 / 2 "$ WOF strips.


## From the Bias Plaid - Multi (C), cut:

- (3) 3 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 3 " x $51 / 2 "$ strips.
- (6) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " $\times 451 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) 2 " $\times 381 / 2 "$ WOF strips.

From the Animals in Squares - Pink (D):

- Fussy cut (6) 3 3/4" Green squares, (6) 3 3/4" Yellow squares and (6) $33 / 4$ " Pink squares.

From the Folio Basics - White on White (E), cut:

- (4) $13 / 8 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (36) $13 / 8 " \times 3 / 4 / 4$ strips.
- (6) $13 / 8 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (36) $13 / 8 " \times 51 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Orange (F), cut:

- (20) Carrots.

From the Folio Basics - Jade (G), cut:

- (20) Carrot Tops.

From the Bunny Barn and Truck Toss - Green (H), cut:
-(3) $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $51 / 2 " \times 501 / 2 "$ strips.
-(2) $51 / 2 " \times 401 / 2 "$ WOF strips.

From the Chicken Toss - Yellow (I), cut:

- (1) $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) $51 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Tossed Bunnies - Blue (Backing), cut:

- (2) 58 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 58 " $\times 68^{\prime \prime}$ back.


## Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the components.

1. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 333 / 4$ "

Fabric B strip to each side of the $223 / 4 " \times 333 / 4$ " Fabric A panel. Sew (1) $2 " \times 26^{3 / 4}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure $25^{1 / 2 "} \times 35^{1 / 2 "}$ to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).

3. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about $1 / 8$ " outside the drawn lines.
4. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
5. Refer to Figure 3 to arrange and press (1) Fabric G Carrot Top and (1) Fabric F Carrot onto (1) 3 " x $51 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip.

 Page 2 Quilt 1)6. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make (1) Block Two strip.
7. Repeat Steps 5-6 to make (20) Block Two strips total.
8. Sew (1) Block Two strip, (1) Block One square, (1) Block Two strip, (1) Block square, (1) Block Two strip, (1) Block Two strip, (1) Block One square, (1) Block Two strip, (1) Block One square and (1) Block Two strip together, in that order and from top to bottom, to make the Left Side Border (Fig. 4).
9. Repeat Step 8 and refer to Figures 5-7 for component identification, placement and orientation to make the Right Side Border, the Top Border and the Bottom Border.

Quilt Top Assembly
(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
10. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left side and to the right side of the Center Block. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
11. Sew (1) $2 " \times 45^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x $381 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
12. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 481 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
13. Sew (1) $51 / 2 " \times 501 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $51 / 2$ " Fabric I square to each end of (1) $51 / 2 " \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric H strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
14. Layer and quilt as desired.
15. Sew the (6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
16. Bind as desired.
