#### **Cutting Instructions**

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Happy Easter Panel - Aqua (A):

• Fussy cut (1) 21 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 41 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" rectangle, centered on the panel.

#### From the Modern Melody Basics - True Blue (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x 41 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x 24 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" WOF strips.
- (5)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Fun Block Panel - Pink Multi (C):

• Fussy cut (4)  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, each centered on a block.

#### From the Modern Melody Basics - Purple (D), cut:

- (2) 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 6 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.
- (2) 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 8 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.
- (2) 1" x 29 ½" WOF strips.
- See instructions to cut (2) Flowers.

#### From the Modern Melody Basics - Pink (E), cut: • (2) 7" x 29 1/2" WOF string

• (2) 7" x 29 ½" WOF strips.

#### From the Modern Melody Basics - Fuchsia (F), cut:

- See instructions to cut (2) Flowers.
- See instructions to cut (2) Flowers Centers.
- See instructions to cut (24) Flower Detail #3.

#### From the Small Flower Toss - Pink (G), cut:

- See instructions to cut (12) Flower Detail #1.
- See instructions to cut (2) Flower Centers.

#### From the Carrot Toss - Yellow (H), cut:

• See instructions to cut (2) Flower Centers.

#### From the Modern Melody Basics - Lemon (I), cut: • See instructions to cut (12) Flower Detail #2.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Orange (J), cut: • See instructions to cut (2) Flowers.

#### From the Modern Melody Basics - Teal (K), cut:

- See instructions to cut (12) Flower Detail #2.
- From the Small Flower Toss Aqua (L), cut: • See instructions to cut (2) Flowers.
- From the Modern Melody Basics Marigold (M), cut: • See instructions to cut (2) Flowers.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Pigment White (N), cut: • See instructions to cut (12) Flower Detail #2.

#### From the Carrot Toss - Aqua (O), cut:

• See instructions to cut (12) Flower Detail #1.

#### From the Easter Pastel Plaid - Pink Multi (P), cut:

- (2) 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 41 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" WOF strips.
- (3) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 43 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.

#### From the Bunny Toss - Pink (Backing), cut:

• (2) 49" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 49" x 57" back.

#### **Block Assembly**

1. Sew (1) 2" x 41  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the 21  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 41  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2" x 24  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure 23  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 43  $\frac{1}{2}$ " to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).

2. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of (1) 6 ½" Fabric C square. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric C square. **Trim the block to measure 7 ½" square** to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (4) Block One squares total.



3. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.





4. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.

5. Refer to Figure 3 to arrange and press the (5) indicated flowers, (12) assorted Flower Detail #1's and (18) assorted Flower Detail #2's onto (1) 7" x 29 ½" Fabric E strip.

6. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make (1) Unit 1 strip.

7. Repeat Steps 5-6 to make a second Unit 1 strip.

8. Refer to Figure 4 for fabric identification, placement and orientation while adding the (3) assorted Flower Centers and (12) Fabric F Flower Detail #3's to the (2) Unit 1 strips to make (2) Unit 2 strips.

9. Sew (1) 1" x 29 ½" Fabric D strip to the left side of (1) Unit 2 strip to make (1) Block Two strip (Fig. 5).

10. Sew (1) 1" x 29 ½" Fabric D strip to the right side of (1) Unit 2 strip to make (1) Block Three strip (Fig. 6).



### Page 2

#### **Quilt Top Assembly**

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 11. Sew (1) Block One square to the top and to the bottom of the Block Two strip. Sew the newly sewn strip to the left side of the Center Block.

12. Sew (1) Block One square to the top and to the bottom of the Block Three strip. Sew the newly sewn strip to the right side of the Center Block.


13. Sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 43  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric P strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 41  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric P strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.


14. Layer and quilt as desired.

15. Sew the (5)  $2\frac{1}{2}$  x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

16. Bind as desired.
