Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 24 Inch Panel - Multi (A):

• Fussy cut (1) 22 ½" x 40 ½" rectangle, centered on the panel.

From the Bias Plaid - Multi (B), cut:

- (2) 3" x 40 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 3" x 27 ½" WOF strips.

From the Folio Basics - True Red (C), cut:

- (3) 2 1/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) 2 1/8" squares.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 44 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 28 ½" WOF strips.

From the Stars - Navy (D), cut:

• (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (15) 2 ½" squares.

From the Folio - White on White (E), cut:

- (3) 2 1/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) 2 1/8" squares.
- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (60) 2 ½" squares.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 46 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 30 ½" WOF strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 60 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 44 ½" strips.

From the Eagle Flag Toss - Red (F), cut:

• (2) 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 6 ½" squares.

From the Tossed Gnomes and Flags - Blue (G), cut:

• (2) 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (7) 6 ½" squares.

From the Novelty Gnome Stripe - Multi (H), fussy cut:

- (2) 7 1/4" x 62 1/2" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips, centered on white and red stripes.
- (2) 7 ½" x 44 ½" LOF strips, centered on white and red stripes.

From the Flag Hearts - Navy (I), cut:

• (1) 7 ¹/₄" x OF strip. Sub-cut (4) 7 ¹/₄" squares.

From the Diagonal Stripe - Multi (J), cut:

• (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.


From the Patriotic Gnome Patchwork - Multi (Backing), cut:

• (2) 84" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 66" x 84" back.

Block Assembly


Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 3" x 40 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the 22 ½" x 40 ½" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 3" x 27 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure 26 ½" x 44 ½".



Unit 1

2. Place (1) 2 %" Fabric E square on top of (1) 2 %" Fabric C square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 2). Sew ¼" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 3) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 2 ½" (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (60) Unit 1 squares total.



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3. Sew (1) 2 ½" Fabric E square to each side of (1) Unit 1 square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to each side of (1) 2 ½" Fabric D square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 6 ½" Block One square (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (15) Block One squares total.





- 4. Refer to Figure 6 and sew together (2) 6 ½" Fabric F squares, (4) Block One squares and (2) 6 ½" Fabric G squares to make the Left Side Border.
- 5. Refer to Figure 7 and sew together (2) 6 ½" Fabric G squares, (4) Block One squares and (2) 6 ½" Fabric F squares to make the Right Side Border.



6. Refer to Figure 8 and sew together (4) Block One squares, (2) 6 ½" Fabric F squares and (1) 6 ½" Fabric G square to make the Top Border.



7. Refer to Figure 9 and sew together (2) 6 ½" Fabric F squares, (3) Block One squares and (2) 6 ½" Fabric G squares to make the Bottom Border.


Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
8. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 44 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 28 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

- 9. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 46 ½" Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 30 ½" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 10. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.
- 11. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 12. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 60 ½" Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 44 ½" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 13. Sew (1) 7 ¹/₄" x 62 ¹/₂" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block.
- 14. Sew (1) 7 1/4" Fabric I square to each end of (1) 7 1/4" x 44 1/2" Fabric H strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the guilt top.
- 15. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 16. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric J strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 17. Bind as desired.

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
