## Runner Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Gnomes on Rockets - White (A), cut:

- (1) $31 / 2 " \mathrm{x}$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) $31 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Bias Plaid - Multi (B), cut:

- (2) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (40) 2 " squares.

From the Folio Basics - Medium Blue (C), cut:
-(2) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 2 " x $31 / 2 "$ strips.

- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (20) 2" squares.

From the Eagle Flag Toss - Red (D), cut:

- (4) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (40) $31 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Folio Basics - White on White (E), cut:

- (1) $37 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) $37 / 8 "$ squares.
- (4) $31 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) $31 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Stars - Navy (F), cut:

- (1) $37 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) $37 / 8 "$ squares.


## From the Novelty Gnome Stripe - Multi (G):

- Fussy cut (5) $121 / 2 " \times 71 / 4 "$ strips, each centered on white and red stripes.

From the Flag Hearts - Navy (H), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $21 / 2 " \times 191 / 4$ " strips.
- (4) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $21 / 2 " \times 641 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Diagonal Stripe - Multi (I), cut:

- (5) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.

From the Patriotic Gnome Patchwork - Multi (Backing), cut: - (1) 31 " $\times 72$ " strip for the backing.

Runner Block Assembly
Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Place (1) 2" Fabric B square on the left side of (1) 2 " $\times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press.
Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance (Fig. 2).

2. Place another 2" Fabric B square on the right side of the $2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 4).
3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (20) Unit 1 strips total.

4. Sew (1) 2" Fabric C square to each end of (1) Unit 1 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to each side of (1) $31 / 2$ " Fabric A square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) $6 \frac{1 / 2 "}{}$ Unit 2 square (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (5) Unit 2 squares total.

 (5) Unit 6 strips.5. Place (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric D square on the left side of (1) 3 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2$ " Fabric E strip, right sides together (Fig. 6). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 6). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4 "$ seam allowance (Fig. 7).

6. Place another $31 / 2$ " Fabric D square on the right side of the $31 / 2 " \times 1 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip, right sides together (Fig. 8). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 8). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 3 strip (Fig. 9).
7. Repeat Steps 5-6 to make (5) Unit 3 strips total.

8. Repeat Steps 5-6 and refer to Figures $10-12$ for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (5) Unit 4 strips, (5) Unit 5 strips and

9. Place $37 / 8 "$ Fabric E square on top of (1) $37 / 8 "$ Fabric F square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 13). Sew $1 / 4$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 13). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 14) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure $31 / 2$ " square to make (2) Unit 7 squares (Fig. 15). Repeat to make (20) Unit 7 squares total.

10. Sew (1) Unit 7 square to each end of (1) Unit 4 strip to make the top row (Fig. 16).
11. Sew (1) Unit 5 strip, (1) Unit 2 square and (1) Unit 6 strip together in that order from left to right to make the middle row (Fig. 16).
12. Sew (1) Unit 7 square to each end of (1) Unit 3 strip to make the bottom row (Fig. 16).
13. Sew the (3) rows from Steps 10-12 together lengthwise to make (1) $121 / 2 "$ Unit 8 square (Fig. 16).
14. Repeat Steps 10-13 to make (5) Unit 8 squares total.

15. Sew (1) $71 / 4 " \times 121 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip to the top of (1) Unit 8 square to make (1) Block One rectangle (Fig. 17). Repeat to make (3) Block One rectangles total.

## Runner Assembly <br> (Follow the Runner Layout in Figure 19 while assembling the runner.)

17. Sew the (3) Block One rectangles and (2) Block Two rectangles together lengthwise and alternating them from left to right to make the Runner Center Block (Fig. 19).
18. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 19 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to each side of the Runner Center Block. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 641 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Runner Center Block to make the Runner Top (Fig. 19).
19. Layer and quilt as desired.
20. Sew the (5) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric I strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
21. Bind as desired.

## Place Mat Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Gnomes on Rockets - White (A), cut: - (1) $31 / 2 " \mathrm{x}$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $31 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Bias Plaid - Multi (B), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $21 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 2" squares.

From the Folio Basics - Medium Blue (C), cut:
-(2) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 2 " x $31 / 2 "$ strips.

- (1) 2 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 " squares.

From the Eagle Flag Toss - Red (D), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $21 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Diagonal Stripe - Multi (E), cut:

- (2) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) $21 / 2 " \times 141 / 2 "$ strips.
- (8) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.

From the Folio Basics - White on White (F), cut:
-(1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $21 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ strips.

- (2) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) $21 / 2 " \times 141 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Flag Hearts - Navy (G), cut:

- (2) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $11 / 2 " \times 101 / 2 "$ strips.
- (4) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $11 / 2 " \times 161 / 2 "$ strips.


## From the Folio Basics - True Red (H), cut:

- (3) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $11 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$ strips.
- (4) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $11 / 2 " \times 181 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Patriotic Gnome Patchwork - Multi (Backing), cut: - (2) 22 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 18 " x $22^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles for the backs.

Place Mat Block Assembly
Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.
22. Place (1) 2" Fabric B square on the left side of (1) $2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 20). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 20). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance (Fig. 21).

23. Place another 2" Fabric B square on the right side of the $2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 22). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 22). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 9 strip (Fig. 23).
24. Repeat Steps 22-23 to make (16) Unit 9 strips total.

25. Sew (1) 2" Fabric C square to each end of (1) Unit 9 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 9 strip to each side of (1) $31 / 2$ " Fabric A square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) $61 / 2 "$ Unit 10 square (Fig. 24). Repeat to make (4) Unit 10 squares total.

26. Sew together (1) $21 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip, (1) $21 / 2 "$ x $81 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip and (1) $21 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make (1) Unit 11 rectangle (Fig. 25). Repeat to make (4) Unit 11 rectangles total.

27. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 141 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip to the top of (1) $21 / 2 " \times 141 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 12 strip (Fig. 26). Repeat to make (4) Unit 12 strips total.

28. Sew (1) Unit 10 square to the left end of (1) Unit 11 rectangle. Sew (1) Unit 12 strip to the bottom of the newly sewn strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 13 rectangle (Fig. 27). Repeat to make (4) Unit 13 rectangles.

29. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 101 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip to each side of (1) Unit 13 rectangle. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 161 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 13 rectangle to make (1) Unit 14 rectangle (Fig. 28). Repeat to make (4) Unit 14 rectangles total.

30. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip to each side of (1) Unit 14 rectangle. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $181 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 14 rectangle to make (1) Place Mat Top (Fig. 29). Repeat to make (4) Place Mat Tops total.

31. Layer and quilt as desired.
32. Sew the (8) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric E strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press. Cut the strip into (4) equal pieces.
33. Bind as desired.
