5/8 yard	Bud Stripe - Cream (C)	2695-33
²⁄₃ yard	Three Dots - Red (D)	2694-88
1 1/8 yards	Three Dots - Cream (E)	2694-33
⅓ yard	Oak Leaf - Squash (F)	2692-35
½ yard	Circle Flower - Green (G)	2691-66
⅓ yard	Five Petal Flower - Red (H)	2690-88
⅓ yard	Circle Flower - Pumpkin (I)	2691-35
1 1/8 yards	Allover Novelty - Cream (J)	2689-33
⅔ yard	Bud Stripe - Brown (K)	2695-38*
4 ½ yards	Oak Leaf - Cream (Backing)	2692-33

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Hello Fall Panel - Red (A):

• Fussy cut (1) 40" x 36" rectangle, centered on the panel.

From the Sprigs - Brown (B), cut:

- (1) 3 %" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3 %" squares.
- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 3 ½" squares.
- (2) 3" x 36" WOF strips.
- (3) 3" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3" x 45" strips.

From the Bud Stripe - Cream (C), cut:

- (2) 5" x 39 ½" WOF strips.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 52 ½" strips.

From the Three Dots - Red (D), cut:

- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 66 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 59 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 54 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 43 ½" strips.

From the Three Dots - Cream (E), cut:

- (3) 3 1/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 3 1/8" squares.
- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 3 ½" squares.
- (2) 2 ³/₄" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 ³/₄" squares.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 63 ½" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 57 ½" strips.

From the Oak Leaf - Squash (F), cut:

- (1) 3 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3 1/8" squares.
- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 3 ½" squares.

From the Circle Flower - Green (G), cut:

- (1) 3 %" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 3 %" squares.
- (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 3 ½" squares.

From the Five Petal Flower - Red (H), cut:

- (1) 3 %" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3 %" squares.
- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 3 ½" squares.

From the Circle Flower - Pumpkin (I), cut:

- (1) 3 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3 1/8" squares.
- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 3 ½" squares.

From the Allover Novelty - Cream (J), cut:

- (4) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ½" x 68 ½" strips.
- (4) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ½" x 67 ½" strips.

From the Bud Stripe - Brown (K), cut:

• (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.


From the Oak Leaf - Cream (Backing), cut:

• (2) 75" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 75" x 84" back.

Block Assembly


Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Sew (1) 3" x 36" Fabric B strip to each side of the 40" x 36" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 3" x 45" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure 43 ½" x 39 ½".




2. Place (1) 3 %" Fabric F square on top of (1) 3 %" Fabric E square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 2). Sew ¼" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 3) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 3 ½" square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (8) Unit 1 squares total.



3. Repeat Step 2 and refer to Figures 5-8 for fabric identification and location to make (16) Unit 2 squares, (8) Unit 3 squares, (8) Unit 4 squares and (8) Unit 5 squares.




- 4. Place (1) 2 ¾" Fabric E square on the bottom left corner of (1) 3 ½" Fabric F square, right sides together (Fig. 9). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 9). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle ¼" away from the sewn seam (Fig. 10).
- 5. Follow Figure 11 for the seam direction to add a 2 ³/₄" Fabric E square to the upper right corner of the 3 ¹/₂" Fabric F square to make (1) Unit 6 square (Fig. 12).
- 6. Repeat Steps 4-5 to make a second Unit 6 square.




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7. Repeat Steps 4-5 and refer to Figures 13-16 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (4) Unit 7 squares, (2) Unit 8 squares, (2) Unit 9 squares and (2) Unit 10 squares.



- 8. Sew together (1) 3 ½" Fabric E square and (2) Unit 1 squares, in that order from left to right, to make the top row (Fig. 17).
- 9. Sew together (1) Unit 1 square and (2) 3 ½" Fabric F squares, in that order from left to right, to make the middle row (Fig. 17).
- 10. Sew together (1) Unit 1 square, (1) 3 ½" Fabric F square and (1) Unit 6 square, in that order from left to right, to make the bottom row (Fig. 17).
- 11. Sew the (3) rows from Steps 8-10 together lengthwise to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 17).

- 12. Repeat Steps 8-11 to make a second Block One square.

13. Repeat Steps 8-11 and refer to Figures 18-21 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (4) Block Two squares,(2) Block Three squares, (2) Block Four squares and (2) Block Five squares.




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14. Follow Figure 22 and sew together (6) assorted Blocks to make the Top Border.

15. Follow Figure 23 and sew together (6) assorted Blocks to make the Bottom Border.





Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 16. Sew (1) 5" x 39 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 52 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

- 17. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 43 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 54 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 18. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 19. Sew (1) 2" x 63 ½" Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 57 ½" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 20. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 66 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 59 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 21. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 68 ½" Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 67 ½" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

- 22. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 23. Sew the (8) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric K strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 24. Bind as desired.
