Runner Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Holly - Cream (A), cut:

• (1) 6 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 6 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Damask - Black (B), cut:

(1) 3 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 3 ¹/₂" squares.
(1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2" squares.

From the Cardinals and Winter Flowers - Cream (C), cut: • (1) 6 ¹/₂" square.

From the Snowflake Plaid - Red (D), cut:

• (1) 4 ¹/₄" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 4 ¹/₄" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (24) 4 ¹/₄" triangles.

From the Folio - Off White (E), cut:

(1) 4 ¹/₄" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 4 ¹/₄" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (24) 4 ¹/₄" triangles.
(1) 3 ⁷/₈" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 3 ⁷/₈" squares.

From the Damask - Green (F), cut:

• (1) 3 ⁷/₈" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 3 ⁷/₈" squares.

From the Folio - Kelly (G), cut:

• (1) 4 ¹/₄" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 4 ¹/₄" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (24) 4 ¹/₄" triangles.

From the Holly - Black (H), cut:

• (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2" squares.

From the Paisley - Cream (I), cut:

• (1) 3 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 3 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Folio - Red (J), cut:

- (1) 1 ¹/₂" X WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 ¹/₂" x 12 ¹/₂" strips.
- (2) 1 ¹/₂" x 38 ¹/₂" WOF strips.
- (4) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Cardinals and Winter Flowers - Black (K), cut: • (2) 4 ¹/₂" x 26" WOF strips.


• (3) 4 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ¹/₂" x 50" strips.

From the Paisley - Black (Backing), cut:

• (1) 54" x 30" WOF strip for the backing.

Runner Block Assembly *Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.*


1. Place (1) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B square on the top left corner of (1) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A square, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the sewn seam.



2. Follow Figure 3 for the seam direction to add a 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B square to each of the remaining corners of the 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 4).


3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make a second Unit 1 square.

4. Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to Figure 5 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (1) Unit 2 square.




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5. Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to Figure 6 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction while using (12) 3 ¹/₂" Fabric I squares, (12) 2" Fabric B squares and (12) 2" Fabric H squares to make (12) Unit 3 squares.



6. Place (1) 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric E square on top of (1) 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric F square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 7). Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 7). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 8) to make (2) halfsquare triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 2 $\frac{5}{8}$ " square to make (2) Unit 4 squares (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (12) Unit 4 squares total.



7. Sew (1) 4 ¹/₄" Fabric E triangle to the Fabric F side of (1) Unit 4 square. Sew (1) 4 ¹/₄" Fabric D triangle to the Fabric E side to make (1) Unit 5 strip (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (12) Unit 5 strips total.






8. Sew (1) 4 ¹/₄" Fabric G triangle and (1) 4 ¹/₄" Fabric D triangle together. Sew the newly sewn strip to the left side of (1) Unit 5 strip. Sew (1) 4 ¹/₄" Fabric E triangle and (1) 4 ¹/₄" Fabric G triangle together. Sew the newly sewn strip to the right side of the Unit 5 strip to make (1) Unit 6 strip (Fig. 11). Repeat to make (12) Unit 6 strips total.



9. Sew (1) Unit 3 square to each end of (1) Unit 6 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 6 strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 12). Repeat to make a second Block One square.



10. Repeat Step 9 and refer to Figure 13 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (1) Block Two square.



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Runner Assembly

(Follow the Runner Layout (Fig. 15) while assembling the runner top.)


11. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of the Block Two square to make the Center Block.

12. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 38 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

13. Center (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 26" Fabric K strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the top edge of the block and stop a $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.

14. Repeat Step 13 to sew (1) $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 50" Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 14).

14. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 14), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the runner top.



16. Layer and quilt as desired.

17. Sew the (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ x WOF Fabric J strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

18. Bind as desired.



Place Mat Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Holly - Cream (A), cut:

(1) 6 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 6 ¹/₂" squares.
(1) 3 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 3 ¹/₂" x 12 ¹/₂" strips.

From the Damask - Black (B), cut:

(2) 3 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 3 ¹/₂" squares.
(1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2" squares.

From the Cardinals and Winter Flowers - Cream (C), cut: • (1) 6 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 6 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Snowflake Plaid - Red (D), cut:

• (1) 4 ¹/₄" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 4 ¹/₄" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (32) 4 ¹/₄" triangles.

From the Folio - Off White (E), cut:

(1) 4 ¹/₄" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 4 ¹/₄" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (32) 4 ¹/₄" triangles.
(1) 3 ⁷/₈" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 3 ⁷/₈" squares.

From the Damask - Green (F), cut:

• (1) 3 ⁷/₈" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 3 ⁷/₈" squares.

From the Folio - Kelly (G), cut:

• (1) 4 ¹/₄" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 4 ¹/₄" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (32) 4 ¹/₄" triangles.

From the Holly - Black (H), cut:

• (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2" squares.

From the Paisley - Cream (I), cut:

• (2) 3 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 3 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Folio - Red (J), cut:

- (1) 1 ¹/₂" X WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 1 ¹/₂" x 12 ¹/₂" strips.
- (7) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.


From the Cardinals and Winter Flowers - Black (K), cut: • (1) 3 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 3 ¹/₂" x 12 ¹/₂" strips.

From the Paisley - Black (Backing), cut:

• (2) 16" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 20" x 16" strips for the backing.

Place Mat Block Assembly


19. Place (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B square on the top left corner of (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A square, right sides together (Fig. 16). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 16). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 17). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the sewn seam.



20. Follow Figure 18 for the seam direction to add a 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B square to each of the remaining corners of the 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 7 square (Fig. 19).

21. Repeat Steps 19-20 to make a second Unit 7 square.

22. Repeat Steps 19-20 and refer to Figure 20 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (2) Unit 8 squares.



23. Repeat Steps 19-20 and refer to Figure 21 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction while using (12) 3 ¹/₂" Fabric I squares, (12) 2" Fabric B squares and (12) 2" Fabric H squares to make (16) Unit 9 squares.








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
24. Place (1) 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric E square on top of (1) 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric F square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 22). Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 22). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 23) to make (2) halfsquare triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 2 $\frac{5}{8}$ " square to make (2) Unit 10 squares (Fig. 24). Repeat to make (16) Unit 10 squares total.









26. Sew (1) 4 ¹/₄" Fabric G triangle and (1) 4 ¹/₄" Fabric D triangle together. Sew the newly sewn strip to the left side of (1) Unit 11 strip. Sew (1) 4 ¹/₄" Fabric E triangle and (1) 4 ¹/₄" Fabric G triangle together. Sew the newly sewn strip to the right side of the Unit 11 strip to make (1) Unit 12 strip (Fig. 26). Repeat to make (16) Unit 12 strips total.



27. Sew (1) Unit 9 square to each end of (1) Unit 12 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 12 strip to each side of (1) Unit 7 square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together to make (1) Block Three square (Fig. 27). Repeat to make a second Block Three square.



28. Repeat Step 27 and refer to Figure 28 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (2) Block Four squares.



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Place Mat Assembly

(Follow the Place Mat Layouts (Figures 29 & 30) while assembling the place mat tops.)

29. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J strip to the right side of (1) Block Four square. Sew (1) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A strip to the right side of the Fabric J strip to make (1) Place Mat #1 top (Fig. 29). Repeat to make a second Place Mat #1 top.

30. Sew (1) 1 ¹/₂" x 12 ¹/₂" Fabric J strip to the right side of (1) Block Three square. Sew (1) 3 ¹/₂ x 12 ¹/₂" Fabric K strip to the right side of the Fabric J strip to make (1) Place Mat #2 top (Fig. 30). Repeat to make a second Place Mat #2 top.

31. Layer and quilt as desired.

32. Sew the (7) $2\frac{1}{2}$ x WOF Fabric J strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

33. Cut the strip into (4) equal strips.

34. Bind as desired.


