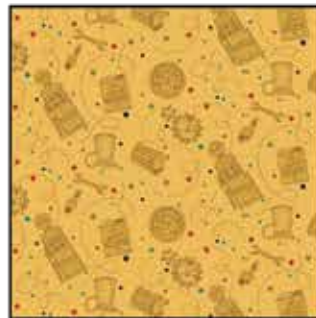

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Book Panel - Teal (A):

- Fussy cut (12) 7" squares, each centered on a panel.

From the Tonal Tools - Red (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 7" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 10" strips.

From the Tonal Tools - Yellow (C), cut:

- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 7" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 10" strips.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Black (D), cut:

- (4) 1 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (78) 1 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.
- (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 38 $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
- (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 28 $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
- (5) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Word and Tire - Stone (E), cut:

- (4) 1 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (78) 1 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

From the Small Stripe - Stone (F), cut:

- (2) 2" x 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x 31 $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.

From the Houndstooth Basics - New Teal (G), cut:

- (3) 1" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1" x 43 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) 1" x 32 $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.

From the Truck Allover - Red (H), cut:

- (3) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 44 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 38 $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.

From the Truck Allover - Red (Backing), cut:

- (2) 46" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 46" x 58" back.

Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Sew (1) 2" x 7" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 7" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x 10" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square. **Trim the block to measure 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square** to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (6) Block One squares total.

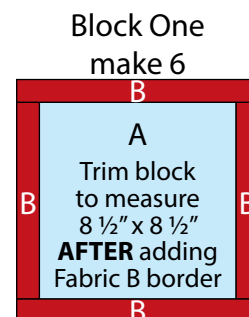

2. Sew (1) 2" x 7" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) 7" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x 10" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square. **Trim the block to measure 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square** to make (1) Block Two square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (6) Block Two squares total.

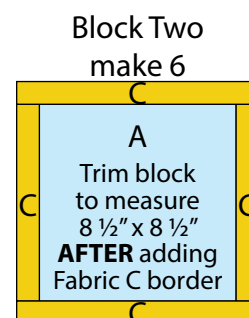

3. Place (1) 1 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric E square on top of (1) 1 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric D square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 3). Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 3). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 4) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (156) Unit 1 squares total.

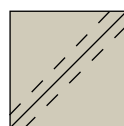

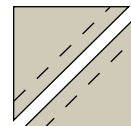

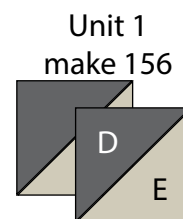

4. Sew (4) Unit 1 squares together into a 2 x 2 matrix to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 6). The block should measure 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Repeat to make (39) Unit 2 squares total.

5. Sew (13) Unit 2 squares together to make (1) Sashing Strip (Fig. 7 below). Repeat to make (3) Sashing Strips total.

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

6. Sew together (1) Block One square, (1) 1 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric D strip, (1) Block Two square, (1) 1 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric D strip and (1) Block One square, in that order from left to right, to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three.

7. Sew together (1) Block Two square, (1) 1 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric D strip, (1) Block One square, (1) 1 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric D strip and (1) Block Two square, in that order from left to right, to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Four.

8. Sew the (4) pieced rows, in numerical order, and (3) Sashing Strips together lengthwise and alternating them to make the Center Block.

9. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 38 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 28 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

10. Sew (1) 2" x 40 ½" Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 31 ½" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

11. Sew (1) 1" x 43 ½" Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1" x 32 ½" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

12. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 44 ½" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 38 ½" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

13. Layer and quilt as desired.

14. Sew the (5) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric D strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

15. Bind as desired.

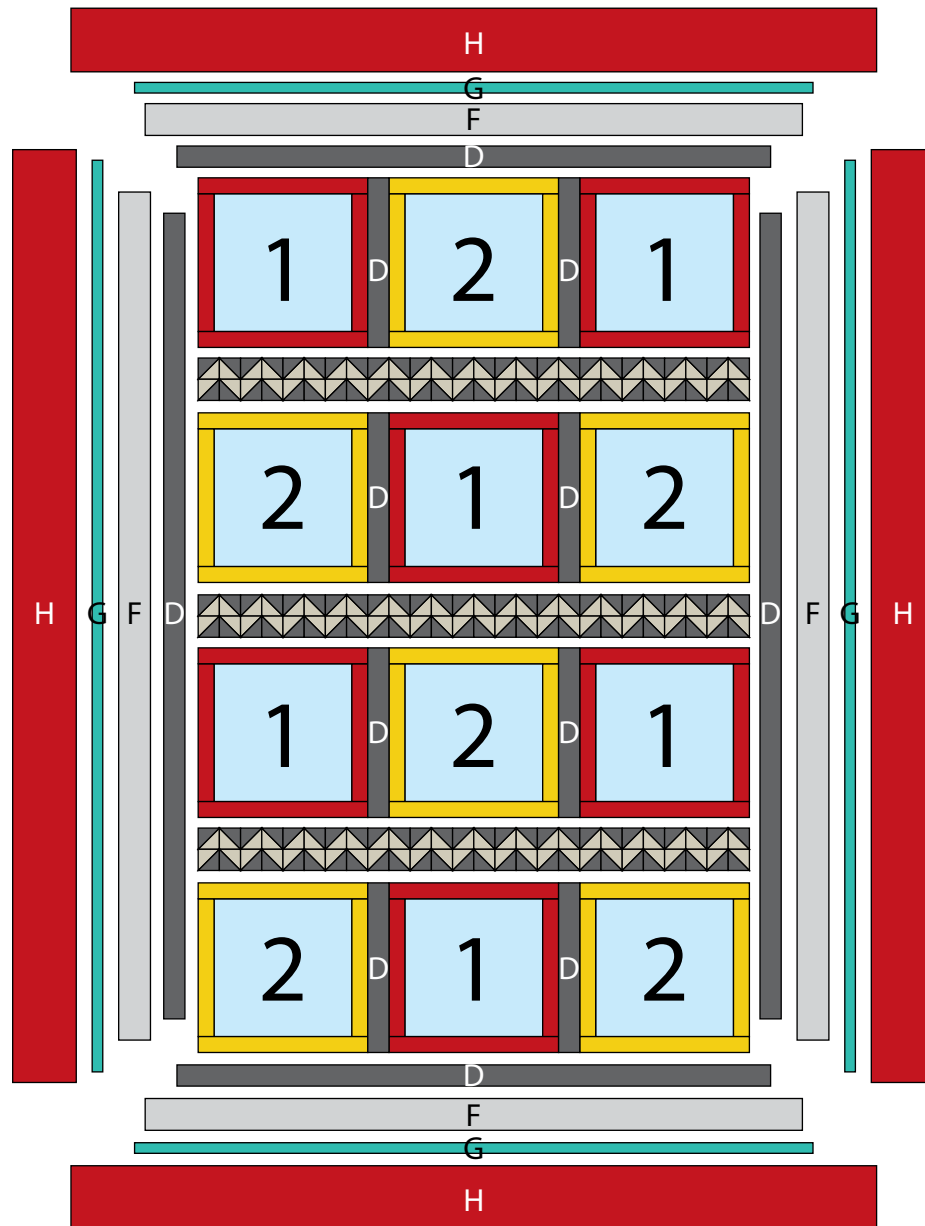
