$11 / 2$ yards Gnome Novelty Stripe - Multi (A) F9645-13 $13 / 4$ yards Fluffy Solid - Mocha (B) Fluffy Mocha*
$2 / 3$ yard $\quad$ Swirl - Aqua (C) F9638-11
$1 / 4$ yard Hot Cocoa Cup Gnomes - Cream (D) F9640-44
$1 / 4$ yard Gnome Snow Angels - Cream (E) F9643-44
$1 / 4$ yard $\quad$ Skiing Gnomes - Beige (F) F9641-33
$1 / 4$ yard Tossed Snowmen - Dark Aqua (G) F9644-11
1/4 yard Polar Bear/Gnome Allover - Aqua (H) F9637-11
$11 / 2$ yards Skiing Gnomes - Aqua (I)
F9641-11
$1 / 2$ yard $\quad$ Snowflake Allover - Aqua (J) F9636-11
2/3 yard $\quad$ Snowflake Allover - Beige (K) F9636-33
4 yards Hexi Snowflakes - Multi (Backing) F9642-13

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Gnome Novelty Stripe - Multi (A), cut:
-(2) $8 \frac{1}{2 \prime} \times 481 / 2 "$ Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
From the Fluffy Solid - Mocha (B), cut:

- (4) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) $31 / 2 "$ squares.
- (5) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) $21 / 2 " \times 481 / 2 "$ strips.
-(3) 2 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $2 " \times 601 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) 2 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " $\times 511 / 2 "$ strips.
-(7) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Swirl - Aqua (C), cut:
- (4) $31 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $31 / 2 " \times 1 / 2 "$ strips.
-(2) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $31 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Hot Cocoa Cup Gnomes - Cream (D), cut: -(1) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $6 \frac{1}{2} \prime \prime$ squares.

From the Gnome Snow Angels - Cream (E), cut:
-(1) $6 \frac{1}{2} \prime \prime$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $61 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Skiing Gnomes - Beige (F), cut:
-(1) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " $x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $61 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Tossed Snowmen - Dark Aqua (G), cut: -(1) $61 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $61 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Polar Bear/Gnome Allover - Aqua (H), cut: - (1) $61 / 2 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $61 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Skiing Gnomes - Aqua (I), cut:

- (1) $61 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $61 / 2 "$ squares.
- (4) $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $51 / 2 " \times 631 / 2 "$ strips.
- (4) $51 / 2 " \mathrm{x}$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $51 / 2 " \times 611 / 2 "$ strips.

Snowflake Allover - Aqua (J), cut:

- (4) $31 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) $31 / 2 / 2$ squares.

Snowflake Allover - Beige (K), cut:

- (4) $31 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $31 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $31 / 2 / 2$ squares.

From the Hexi Snowflakes - Multi (Backing), cut:

- (2) 69 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 69 " x 81 " back.


## Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Place (1) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B square on the left side of (1) $31 / 2 " \times 6 \frac{1}{2} "$ Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance (Fig. 2).

2. Place another $31 / 2 "$ Fabric B square on the right side of the $31 / 2 " \times 1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 4).
3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (24) Unit 1 strips total.
4. Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to Figure 5 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (24) Unit 2 strips.


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Quilt 2
5. Sew (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric C square to each end of (1) Unit 1 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to each side of (1) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together lengthwise to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 6). Repeat to make a second Block One square.
6. Repeat Step 5 and refer to Figures 7-11 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (2) of each block square for Block Two through Block Six.

7. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 481 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) $81 / 2 " \times 481 / 2 "$ Fabric A strip lengthwise to make (1) Block Seven strip (Fig. 12). Repeat to make a second Block Seven strip.

## Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
8. Sew together (1) Block One square, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Three square and (1) Block Four square, in that order from left to right, to make Row One.
9. Sew together (1) Block Five square, (1) Block Six square, (1) Block Two square and (1) Block One square, in that order from left to right, to make Row Two.
10. Sew together (1) Block Three square, (1) Block Four square, (1) Block Six square and (1) Block Five square, in that order from left to right, to make Row Three.
11. Sew together Row One, (1) Block Seven strip, Row Two, (1) Block Seven strip and Row Three, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make the Center Block.
12. Sew (1) $2 " \times 601 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x $511 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
13. Sew (1) $51 / 2 " \times 631 / 2 "$ Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $51 / 2 " \times 611 / 2 "$ Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
14. Layer and quilt as desired.
15. Sew the (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
16. Bind as desired.
