



Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 4 Block Panel 36 in - Blue (A):

• Fussy cut (4) 15 ½" squares, each centered on a block.

From the Folio Basics - Pale Gray (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 2" x 15 ½" strips.
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 2" x 18 ½" strips.

From the Folio Basics - Charcoal (C), cut:

- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 2" x 15 ½" strips.
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 2" x 18 ½" strips.
- (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Folio Basics - Silver (D), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3" x 8" strips.
- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3" x 5 ½" strips.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 51 ½" strips.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 47 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 42 ½" WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (2) 1 ½" x 40 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 35 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 33 ½" WOF strips.

From the Tonal Floral - Blue (E), cut:

- (2) 3" x 30 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 3" x 33" WOF strips.

From the Kittens in Circles - Blue (F), cut:

- (2) 3" x 37 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 3" x 40" WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Kittens in a Barrow - Sage (G), cut:

- (2) 5 ½" x 51 ½" LOF strips.
- From the remaining fabric cut (2) 5 ½" x 61 ½" strips, piece as needed.


From the Plaid - White (Backing), cut:

• (2) 69" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 69" x 69" back.


Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2" x 15 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 15 ½" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x 18 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure 17" x 17". Repeat to make a second Block One square.



2. Sew (1) 2" x 15 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) 15 ½" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x 18 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Block Two square (Fig. 2). Trim the block to measure 17" x 17". Repeat to make a second Block Two square.



3. Sew (1) Block One square to the left side of (1) Block Two square to make the top row. Sew (1) Block Two square to the left side of (1) Block One square to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make the Center Block (Fig. 3).








- 4. Sew (1) 3" x 5 ½" Fabric D strip to the top of (1) 3" x 30 ½" Fabric E strip to the Inner Left Side Border (Fig. 4).
- 5. Sew (1) 3" x 5 ½" Fabric D strip to the bottom of (1) 3" x 30 ½" Fabric E strip to the Inner Right Side Border (Fig. 5).




6. Sew (1) 3" x 8" Fabric D strip to the left end of (1) 3" x 33" Fabric E strip to the Inner Top Border (Fig. 6).




7.Sew (1) 3" x 8" Fabric D strip to the right end of (1) 3" x 33" Fabric E strip to the Inner Bottom Border (Fig. 7).



- 8. Sew (1) 3" x 5 ½" Fabric D strip to the top of (1) 3" x 37 ½" Fabric F strip to the Outer Left Side Border (Fig. 8).
- 9. Sew (1) 3" x 5 ½" Fabric D strip to the bottom of (1) 3" x 37 ½" Fabric F strip to the Outer Right Side Border (Fig. 5).



10. Sew (1) 3" x 8" Fabric D strip to the left end of (1) 3" x 40" Fabric F strip to the Outer Top Border (Fig. 10).



11. Sew (1) 3" x 8" Fabric D strip to the right end of (1) 3" x 40" Fabric F strip to the Outer Bottom Border (Fig. 11).




Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
12. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 33 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 35 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

13. Sew the Inner Left Side Border and Inner Right Side Border to the left and right sides of the Center Block.

- 14. Sew the Inner Top Border and Inner Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 15. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 40 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 42 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 16. Sew the Outer Left Side Border and Outer Right Side Border to the left and right sides of the Center Block.
- 17. Sew the Outer Top Border and Outer Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 18. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 47 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 51 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

- 19. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 51 ½" Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 61 ½" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 20. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 21. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 22. Bind as desired.
