## Table Set

From the Words and Campers - Dark Blue (Backing), cut:

- (2) 48 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 48 " $\times 60$ " back.

Wall Hanging Block Assembly
Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) $21 / 2$ " $\times 9$ " Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $20^{\prime \prime} \times 9$ " Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 24$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make (1) Unit 1 rectangle (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure $221 / 2 " \times 111 / 2 "$.

2. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 11^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric C strip to each side of the Unit 1 rectangle. Sew (1) $3 " \times 301 / 2 "$ Fabric C strips to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 rectangle to make (1) Unit 2 rectangle (Fig. 2).

3. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 301 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 2 rectangle to make the $301 / 2$ x $181 / 2$ " Center Block (Fig. 3).

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4. Place (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric I square on the top left corner of (1) $6 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ Fabric G square, right sides together (Fig. 4). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 4). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4$ " away from the sewn seam (Fig. 5).

5. Follow Figure 6 for the seam direction to add a $31 / 2 "$ Fabric I square to each of the remaining corners of the $61 / 2$ " Fabric G square to make (1) Unit 3 square (Fig. 7).
6. Repeat Steps 4-5 to make (4) Unit 3 squares total.

7. Repeat Steps $4-5$ and refer to Figure 8 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (6) Unit 4 squares.

8. Sew together (3) $6 \frac{1}{2} /$ " Fabric E squares and (2) Unit 3 squares, alternating them from left to right, to make the top row. Sew together (3) Unit 4 squares and (2) $61 / 2$ " Fabric F squares, alternating them from left to right, to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make (1) $121 / 2 " \times 301 / 2 "$ Block One rectangle (Fig. 9).

9. Repeat Step 8 and refer to Figure 10 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (1) Block Two rectangle.

## Wall Hanging Assembly <br> (Follow the Wall Hanging Layout in Figure 11 while assembling the wall hanging top.)

10. Sew together the Block One rectangle, the Center Block and the Block Two rectangle, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make the quilt top.
11. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side the quilt top. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 321 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
12. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 441 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 401 / 2$ " Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top to finish the Wall Hanging top.
13. Layer and quilt as desired.
14. Sew the (5) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric D strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
15. Bind as desired.

1 panel 24 inch Lake Panel - Red (A) 187P-88
$1 / 4$ yard Folio Basics - Dark Olive (B) 7755-65
$1 / 4$ yard Fish - Light Blue (C) 185-11
$1 / 2$ yard $\quad$ Fish - Light Blue (Backing) 185-11

You will also need:

- (1) Poly-fill


## Pillow Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 24 inch Lake Panel - Red (A):
-Fussy cut (1) $20 "$ x 9" strip, centered on a large panel.
From the Folio Basics - Dark Olive (B), cut:
-(1) 2 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $2 " x 9 "$ strips.
-(2) $2 " \times 23 "$ WOF strips.
From the Fish - Light Blue (C), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $21 / 2 " \times 101 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $21 / 2 " \times 251 / 2 "$ WOF strips.

From the Fish - Light Blue (Backing), cut:

- (1) $251 / 2 " \times 14 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle for the backing.


## Pillow Assembly

Note: Use a $1 / 40$ seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.
16. Sew (1) $2 " x 9 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the $20 " x 9 "$ Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x $23 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make (1) Unit 5 rectangle (Fig. 12). Trim the unit to measure $21 \underline{1 / 2 "}$ x $101 / 2$ ".

17. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 10 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to each side of the Unit 5 rectangle. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 251 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 5 rectangle to make the Pillow top (Fig. 13).

18. Place the Pillow top and Pillow Backing right sides together. Stitch around the perimeter of the pillow, leaving a space for turning.
19. Turn the pillow inside out.
20. Stuff the pillow with poly-fill to the desired firmness. Sew the opening closed.

$1 / 4$ yard $\quad$ Fishing Lures - Green (F) 186-66
$1 / 4$ yard Animal Faces - Gold (G) 181-44
1 yard Canoes and Camp Motifs - Beige (Backing) 177-40
*Includes binding

## Place Mat Cutting Instructions

From the 24 inch Lake Panel - Red (A):

- Fussy cut (4) 9" squares, each centered on a small block.

From the Folio Basics - Brown (B), cut:

- (2) $2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $2 " \times 9 "$ strips.
-(3) $2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $2 " \times 12 "$ strips.
From the Plaid - Red (C), cut:
- (2) $11 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $11 / 2 " \times 101 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $11 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$ strips.
-(7) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Campers - Light Blue (D), cut:
-(1) $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strip.
From the Words and Campers - Brown (E), cut:
- (1) $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 121 / 2 "$ WOF strip.

From the Fishing Lures - Green (F), cut:
-(1) $41 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$ WOF strip.
From the Animal Faces - Gold (G), cut:
-(1) $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 121 / 2 "$ WOF strip.
From the Canoes and Camp Motifs - Beige (Backings) -(2) $16 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) $16 " \times 20 "$ rectangles.

Place Mat Assembly
Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ "seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.
21. Sew (1) $2 " \times 9 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the $9 "$ Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x $12 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 6 square (Fig. 14). Trim the unit to measure $101 / 2 " \times 101 / 2 \gg$. Repeat to make (4) Unit 6 squares total.

22. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 10 \frac{1}{2} "$ Fabric C strip to each side of the Unit 6 square. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 6 square to make (1) Unit 7 square (Fig. 15). Repeat to make (4) Unit 7 squares total.

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23. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$ Fabric $D$ strip to the right side of (1) Unit 7 square to make (1) $16 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 121 / 2 "$ Place Mat \#1 top (Fig. 16).

## Place Mat \#1 Layout

24. Repeat Steps 23 and refer to Figures 17-19 for component identification and placement to make (1) Place Mat \#2 top, (1) Place Mat \#3 top and (1) Place Mat \#4 top.

25. Layer and quilt as desired.
26. Sew the (8) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press. Cut the strip into (4) equal pieces.
27. Bind as desired.
