1/4 yard	Plaid - Tobacco (F)	F8632-39
1/8 yard	Multi Dot - Gold (G)	F8631-33
1/8 yard	Diamond Texture - Gold (H)	F8634-33
1/3 yard	Character Toss - Teal (I)	F8629-17
1/8 yard	Sprig Toss - Tobacco (J)	F8630-39
1/8 yard	Plaid - Red (K)	F8632-88
1/2 yard	Diamond Texture - Navy (L)	F8634-79
3 yards	Character Toss - Tobacco (Backing)	F8629-39

Quilt Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Panel Print - Tobacco (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 23" x 41" panel.

From the Sprig Toss - Green (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x 41" WOF strips.
- (2) 3" x 26" WOF strips.

From the Multi Dot - Black (C), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 45 1/2" strips.
- (2) 2" x 28 1/2" WOF strips.

From the Border Stripe - Tobacco (D):

- Fussy cut (2) 3 1/2" x 60 1/2" length of fabric (LOF) strips, each centered on a row of scallops.
- Fussy cut (2) 3 1/2" x 40 1/2" LOF strips, each centered on a row of scallops.
- From the remaining fabric, fussy cut (11) 4 1/2" squares, each centered on a star.

From the Diamond Texture - Red (E), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.
- (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (4) 3 1/2" squares.
- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Plaid - Tobacco (F), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.

From the Multi Dot - Gold (G), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip.

From the Diamond Texture - Gold (H), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip.

From the Character Toss - Teal (I), cut:

- (2) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (10) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Sprig Toss - Tobacco (J), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip.

From the Plaid - Red (K), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip.

From the Diamond Texture - Navy (L), cut:

- (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 1/2" x 56 1/2" strips.
- (2) 2 1/2" x 40 1/2" WOF strips.

From the Character Toss - Tobacco (Backing), cut:

- (2) 54" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 54" x 74" back.

Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) 2" x 41" Fabric B strip to each side of the 23" x 41" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 3" x 26" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure 25 1/2" x 45 1/2" to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).

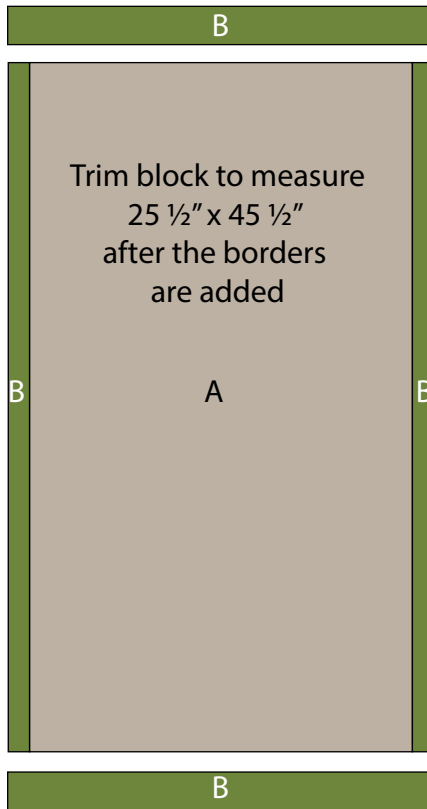

2. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric F strip and (1) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric H strip together lengthwise to make (1) FH strip set (Fig. 2).

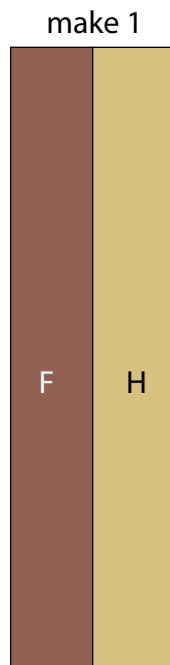

3. Cut the FH strip set into (11) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" FH strips (Fig. 3).

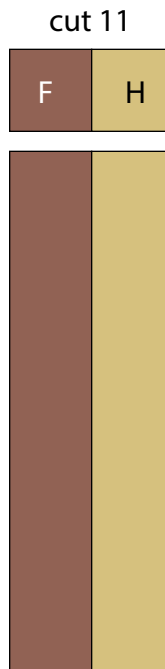

4. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric G strip and (1) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric E strip together lengthwise to make (1) GE strip set (Fig. 4).

5. Cut the GE strip set into (11) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" GE strips (Fig. 5).

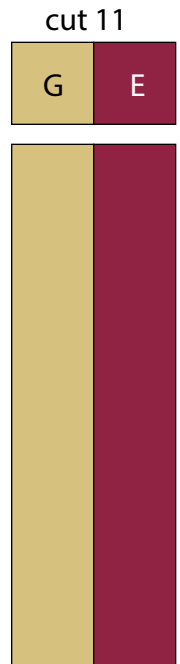

6. Sew (1) FH strip and (1) GE strip together to make (1) Block One (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (11) Block Ones total.

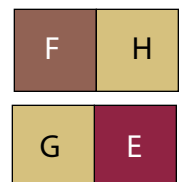

7. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric J strip and (1) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric E strip together lengthwise to make (1) JE strip set (Fig. 7).

8. Cut the JE strip set into (10) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" JE strips (Fig. 8).

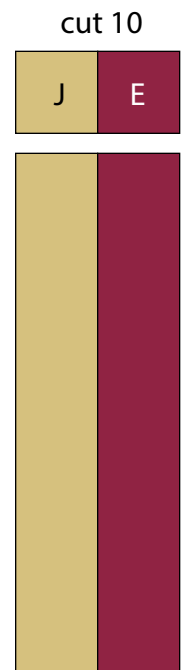

9. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric K strip and (1) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric F strip together lengthwise to make (1) KF strip set (Fig. 9).

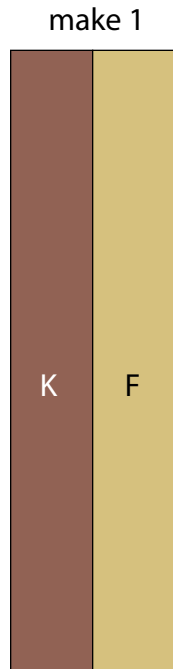

10. Cut the KF strip set into (10) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" KF strips (Fig. 10).

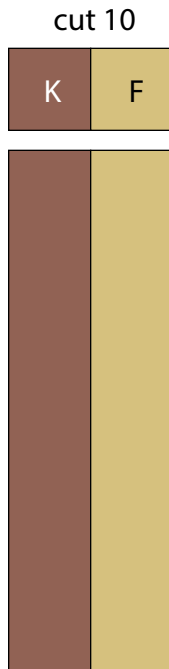

11. Sew (1) JE strip and (1) KF strip together lengthwise to make (1) Block Two (Fig. 11). Repeat to make (10) Block Twos total.

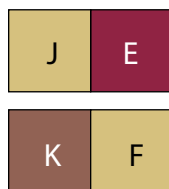

Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the *Quilt Layout while assembling.*)

12. Sew (1) 2" x 45 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 28 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

13. Sew (3) Block Ones, (3) Block Twos, (3) 4 1/2" Fabric I squares and (3) 4 1/2" Fabric D squares to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Pay attention to the order of the squares. Sew (1) strip to each side of the Center Block.

14. Sew (3) 4 1/2" Fabric D squares, (2) Block Ones, (2) 4 1/2" Fabric I squares and (2) Block Twos to make (1) strip. Sew this strip to the top of the Center Block.

15. Sew (3) Block Ones, (2) 4 1/2" Fabric I squares, (2) Block Twos and (2) 4 1/2" Fabric D squares to make (1) strip. Sew the strip to the bottom of the Center Block.

16. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 56 1/2" Fabric L strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 40 1/2" Fabric L strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

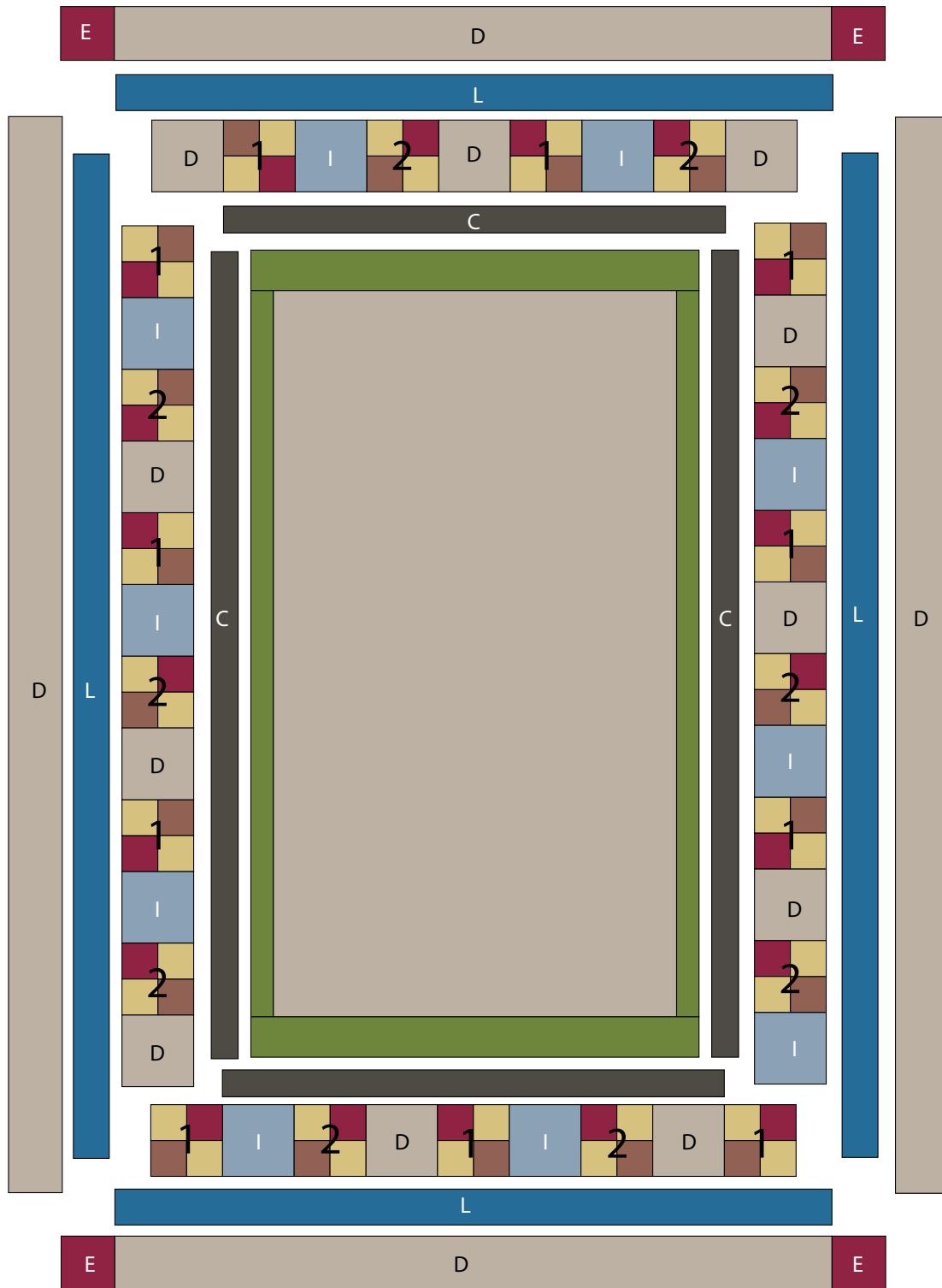
17. Sew (1) 3 1/2" x 60 1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3 1/2" Fabric E square to each end of (1) 3 1/2" x 40 1/2" Fabric D strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

18. Layer and quilt as desired.

19. Sew the (6) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric E strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

20. Bind as desired.
