## Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Geometric - Olive (A), cut:

- (4) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (50) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the All Over Flower - Red (B), cut:
-(2) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (18) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Dandelion Toss - Lt. Blue (C), cut:
-(2) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the All Over Flower - Black (D), cut:
-(2) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (18) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Geometric - Gold (E), cut:
-(1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Pinstripe - Olive ( $F$ ), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Dash Texture - Teal (G), cut:
-(2) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Dobbie Plaid - Pumpkin (H), cut:
-(2) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Textured Dots - Black (I), cut:

- (3) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (36) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
-(6) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.

From the Small Plaid - Cream (J), cut:

- (3) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $10 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " strips.
- (6) $11 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $11 / 2 "$ x $81 / 2 "$ strips.
-(2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $11 / 2 "$ x $61 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Small Plaid - Teal (K), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Wavy Stripe - Red (L), cut:

- (2) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Wavy Stripe - Teal (M), cut:
-(2) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (18) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Small Plaid - Red (N), cut:
-(2) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (18) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Lattice - Cream (O), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Geometric - Red ( P ), cut:

- (2) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Tiles - Slate (Q), cut:

- (2) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Stars - Dk. Blue (R), cut:
-(2) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (18) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Textured Dots - Olive (S), cut:
-(1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Stars - Red (T), cut:
-(1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
From the All Over Flower - Cream (U), cut:

- (6) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 141 / 2 "$ strips.
- (4) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $11 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Stars - Gold (V), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Dobbie Plaid - Gold (W), cut:
-(1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Lattice - Black (X), cut:
-(1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

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## Cutting Instructions - Continued

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Large Plaid - Pumpkin (Y), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Dash Texture - Olive (Z), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $21 / 2 "$ squares.


## From the Small Plaid - Purple (AA), cut:

- (16) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (31) $21 / 2 " \times 141 / 2 "$ strips.


## From the Dandelion Toss - Khaki (Backing), cut:

- (2) 58 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 58 " x 74 " back.


## Sewing Instructions

1. Follow Figure 1 and sew (9) assorted $21 / 2$ " squares together to make (1) Unit 1 block. Repeat to make (6) Unit 1 blocks total.
2. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 block to make (1) Unit 2 block (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (6) Unit 2 blocks total.

3. Follow Figure 3 and sew (4) assorted $21 / 2 "$ squares together. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of (1) Unit 2 block. Sew (6) assorted $21 / 2$ " squares together. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 2 block to make (1) Unit 3 block. Repeat to make (6) Unit 3 blocks total.

4. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 121 / 2 "$ Fabric U strip to each side of (1) Unit 3 block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 14^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric U strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 3 block to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (6) Block One squares total.
5. Repeat Steps 1-3 and use Figures 5-7 for fabric identification and location to make (6) Block Two squares.

6. Sew (4) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric A squares and (3) $21 / 2 " \times 141 / 2 "$ Fabric AA strips together end to end and alternating them to make (1) Sashing Strip (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (5) Sashing Strips total.

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Quilt Top Assembly (Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)
7. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 141 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric AA strip, (1) Block One square, (1) $21 /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ " $\times 141 / 2 "$ Fabric AA strip, (1) Block Two square, (1) $21 / 2 " \times 141 / 2 "$ Fabric AA strip, (1) Block One square and (1) $21 / 2 " \times 14 \frac{1}{2} / "$ Fabric AA strip together lengthwise and in that order to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three.
8. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 141 / 2 "$ Fabric AA strip, (1) Block Two square, (1) $21 / 2 " \times 141 / 2 "$ Fabric AA strip, (1) Block One square, (1) $21 / 2 " \times 141 / 2 "$ Fabric AA strip, (1) Block Two square and (1) $21 / 2 " \times 141 / 2 "$ Fabric AA strip together lengthwise and in that order to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Four.
9. Sew the (5) Sashing Strips and (4) pieced rows, in numerical order, together, alternating them, to make the quilt top.
10. Layer and quilt as desired.
11. Sew the (6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric I strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
12. Bind as desired.
