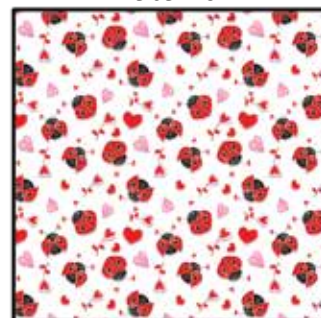

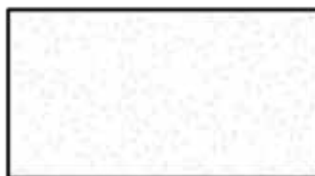

¼ yard	Cupids - Red (A)	1364-88
¼ yard	Ladybugs - White/Red (B)	1366-8
⅜ yard	Lips - Pink (C)	1365-22
½ yard	Tossed Hearts - Red (D)	1362-88
⅓ yard	Folio - Pigment White (E)	7755-01
¼ yard	Folio - Powder Pink (F)	7755-20
1 ½ yards	Novelty Stripe - Red/Pink (G)	1367-28
⅜ yard	Modern Melody Basics - Crimson Red (H)	1063-88*
1 ½ yards	Words - White/Red (Backing)	1363-28

Runner Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

From the Cupids - Red (A), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 4 ½" squares.

From the Ladybugs - White/Red (B), cut:

- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Lips - Pink (C), cut:

- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 ½" squares.

From the Tossed Hearts - Red (D), cut:

- (2) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 4 ½" squares.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 ½" squares.

From the Folio - Pigment White (E), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (36) 2 ½" squares.

From the Folio - Powder Pink (F), cut:

- (2) 1 ½" x 38 ½" WOF strips.
- (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 ½" x 12 ½" strips.

From the Novelty Stripe - Red/Pink (G):

- Fussy cut (2) 4" x 49" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- Fussy cut (2) 4" x 25" LOF strips.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Crimson Red (H), cut:

- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Words - White/Red (Backing), cut:

- (1) 29" x 53" WOF strip to make the back.

Runner Sewing Instructions

1. Place (1) 2 ½" Fabric E square on the top left corner of (1) 4 ½" Fabric D square, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the

triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle ¼" away from the sewn seam (Fig. 2). Follow Figure 3 for the seam direction to add another 2 ½" Fabric E square to the lower right corner of the 4 ½" Fabric D square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (12) Unit 1 squares total.

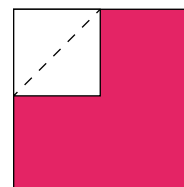

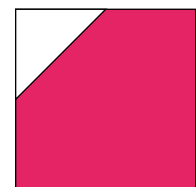

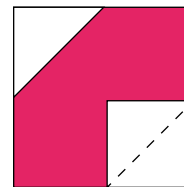

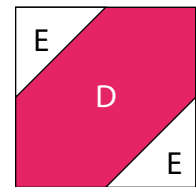

2. Place (1) 2 ½" Fabric E square on the left side of (1) 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 5). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 5). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 6). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle leaving a ¼" seam allowance.

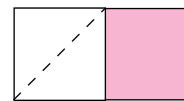

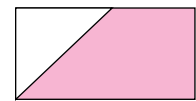

3. Place 2 ½" Fabric E square on the right side of the 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 7). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 7). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle leaving a ¼" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 2 strip (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (6) Unit 2 strips total.

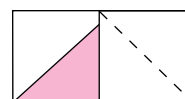

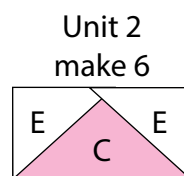

4. Repeat Steps 2-3 and use Figures 9 & 10 for fabric identification, location and seam directions to make (12) Unit 3 strips and (6) Unit 4 strips.

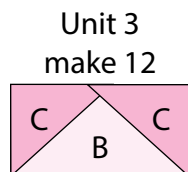

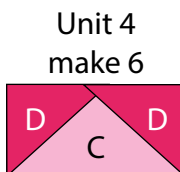

5. Sew (1) Unit 2 strip to the top of (1) Unit 3 strip to make (1) Unit 5 square (Fig. 11). Repeat to make (6) Unit 5 strips total.

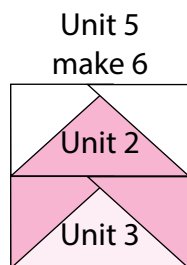

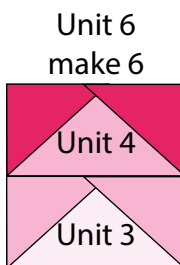

6. Sew (1) Unit 4 strip to the top of (1) Unit 3 strip to make (1) Unit 6 square (Fig. 12). Repeat to make (6) Unit 6 strips total.

7. Sew (1) Unit 6 square to each side of (1) 4 1/2" Fabric A square, paying attention to the unit orientations. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to each side of (1) Unit 5 square to make (1) top unit strip. Pay attention to the unit orientations. Repeat to make (1) bottom unit strip. Sew the top and bottom unit strips to the top and to the bottom of the 4 1/2" Fabric A square to make (1) Block One (Fig. 13). Repeat to make (3) Block Ones total.

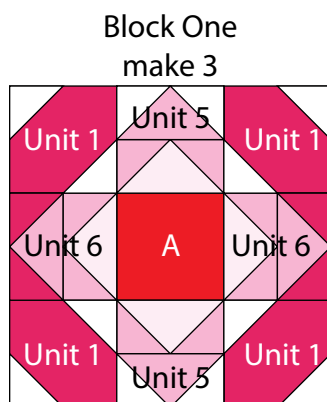

Runner Top Assembly

(Refer to Figure 15 while assembling.)

8. Sew (3) Block Ones together to make the Center Block.

9. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 38 1/2" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

10. Center (1) 4" x 25" Fabric G strip on one side of the runner top. Start sewing the strip a 1/4" from the top edge of the runner top and stop a 1/4" from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.

11. Repeat Step 10 to sew (1) 4" x 49" Fabric G strip to the top and (1) 4" x 49" Fabric G strip to the bottom of the runner top, making sure to stop and start 1/4" away from each end of the runner top.

12. To miter each corner, fold the runner top on a diagonal wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 14).

13. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 14) draw a 45-degree line out to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a 1/4" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners.

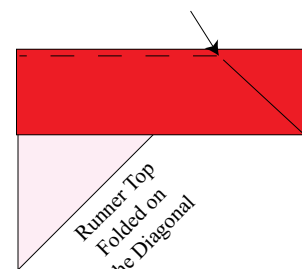

14. Layer and quilt as desired.

15. Sew the (4) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric H strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

16. Bind as desired.

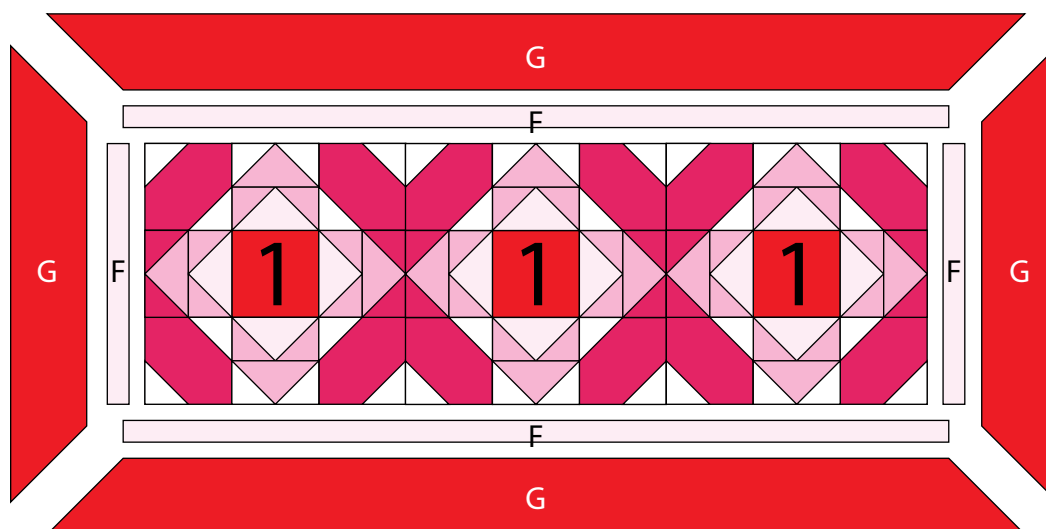
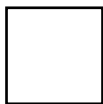

1 ¼ yards	Novelty Stripe - Red/Pink (A)	1367-28
½ yard	Ladybugs - White/Red (B)	1366-8
¾ yard	Cupids - Pink (C)	1364-22
¼ yard	Tossed Hearts - Red (D)	1362-88
1 ⅓ yards	Valentine Tossed Patch - Pink/Red (Backing)	1361-22

Place Mat Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Novelty Stripe - Red/Pink (A), cut:

- (2) 5" x 42" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.

From the Ladybugs - White/Red (B), cut:

- (8) 1 ½" x WOF strips.

From the Cupids - Pink (C), cut:

- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips.

From the Tossed Hearts - Red (D), cut:

- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips.

From the Valentine Tossed Patch - Pink/Red (Backing), cut:

- See Instructions to cut four hearts

Place Mat Sewing Instructions

17. Refer to Figure 16 and sew together lengthwise (2) 1 ½" x WOF Fabric D strips, (4) 1 ½" x WOF Fabric B strips, (2) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric C strips and (1) 5" x 42" Fabric A strip to make (1) Unit 7 strip. Repeat to make a second Unit 7 strip.

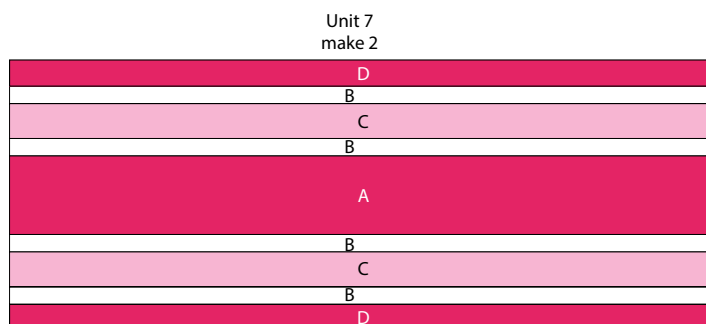

18. Enlarge the Heart Template 200%.

19. Trace two hearts on top of each Unit 7 strip (Fig. 17). Cut out each heart on the drawn line to make (4) place mats fronts.

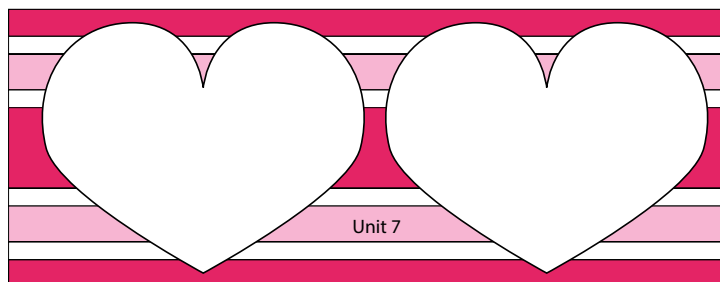

20. Trace (4) hearts onto the backing fabric. Cut out each heart on the drawn lines (Fig. 18).

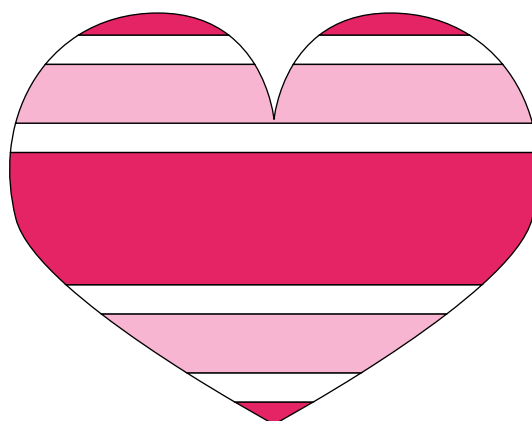

21. Trace (4) hearts onto the batting. Cut out each heart on the drawn lines.

22. Place the place mat front and place mat back right sides together. Place the layered hearts on top of one batting heart. Sew around the layered pieces, leaving a 3" opening for turning. Turn the place mat right-side out and stitch the opening closed.

23. Quilt as desired to complete.
